

A Star for All Seasons

Each Design uses an 18" wide Paper Mache Star that can be purchased at Pacific Fabrics & Crafts along with all other materials needed.

Snowman Star

Materials:

White Acrylic Paint

Small amount of black and orange acrylic paint

2 Felt Squares – 1 red, 1 black

Trim for the hat band

Small Gold Bells for the boots

Aleene's Quick Dry Tacky Glue



Directions:

1. Paint the front and back of your star with the white acrylic paint and allow to dry.
2. Using the patterns on page 3, Cut the hat and boots from black felt and the mittens from red felt. Glue one hat piece to the front side of the top point of the star, then glue the other hat piece to the back of the point so that the top of the point is covered. Repeat the above instructions for the boots and mittens to create the hands and feet.
3. Cut 2 pieces, 1-1/2" x 12" from the red felt square for the scarf. Overlap the short ends of the cut pieces about 1/4" and glue them together to make a 24" long scarf. Cut fringe on each end and wrap it around your snowman's neck.
4. Trace the face pattern onto the point under the hat, then paint the eyes and mouth with black acrylic paint and the nose with orange acrylic paint.
Optional: Glue buttons, pom-poms or wiggly eyes onto the face instead of 5. painting the features on.
5. Embellish your snowman's hat with trims and glue the gold bells to the boots.

Hang and enjoy!

New Year's Eve Sparkle Star

Materials:

Silver Acrylic Paint

Aleene's Quick Dry Tacky Glue

Assorted glitter, jewels and sequins of your choice



Directions:

1. Paint the star with the silver acrylic paint and allow to dry.
2. Use your glue to create swirls, dots or other designs then embellish these with glitter, jewels and sequins.

Hint: You may want to trace your star onto paper and design your embellishments before you start gluing.

Hang and admire!

Patriotic Button Star**Materials:**

Red, White & Blue Acrylic Paint
Buttons Galore button packs in red, white & blue
Aleene's Quick Dry Tacky Glue

Directions:

1. Using a pencil, make the following paint guideline markings on your star.
 - A. Draw a line horizontally across the star, at the middle (approximately 10" from the top). This line will slope to the outside edge rather than following the ridge of the two middle points.
 - B. Draw a second line horizontally across the star approximately 3" under line A.
 - C. Draw a third line horizontally across the star approximately 3" under line B.
 - D. On the right side of the star only, draw a line horizontally across the star approximately 3" above line A.
 - E. Draw another line on the right point only approximately 3" above line D.
 - F. Finish by drawing another line on the right point only approximately 3" above line E.
2. Paint the star as shown in the picture using your pencil lines as guidelines. Allow to dry.
3. Glue random sizes of buttons onto the star matching colors to your painted star.
