## **Basic Crocheted Scarf**

## **Materials:**

5 - 7oz. Worsted Weight Yarn - 1 to 2 skeins of Cascade 220 or Vanna works well

Small amount of contrasting, coordinating or same yarn for fringe

Size I hook

Finished Size: 6 inches wide, length is up to you

Gauge: 9 sc rows/2 in & 7 sc/2 in

## **Instructions:**

Chain 23.

Row 1: Single crochet in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each remaining stitch of ch. Ch 1 to turn (22sc)

Row 2: Sc in each sc across. Ch 1 to turn. (22sc)

Remaining Rows: Repeat Row 2 until scarf is desired length.

Final Row: Sc in each sc across. End off, leaving a length of yarn long enough to weave in.

Weave in yarn end and add fringe if desired.

## To Make Fringe:

Cut 3 pieces of yarn each for 12 – 24 sections of fringe. Each length of yarn should be the desired finished length, plus one inch.

Using your hook, pull 3 pieces of yarn through end of scarf beginning on edges and continuing every  $\frac{1}{2}$ " (12) to  $\frac{1}{4}$ " (24) across end of scarf.

Knot fringe with a single knot.

Trim ends evenly. A ruler and rotary cutter are great for trimming!
