

Really Easy Knit or Crochet Dish or Face Cloth

Materials:

1 ball Lily Sugar 'n Cream 4 Ply OR
1 skein Vanna's Choice
(2 balls or skeins will make three cloths)

Size 8 (5mm) straight knitting needles OR
Size G or 6 (4mm) crochet hook



We love 100% Cotton Sugar 'n Cream for dishes, but we know other knitters who like Acrylic Vanna's Choice because it "scrubs" a little better. Cotton/Acrylic blend Baby's First has a plush chenille feel and is great for a face cloth. Pair it with a scented soap or shower gel and you've got a great little "spa style" gift!

Knitted Cloth:

Cast on 40 stitches. Knit in garter stitch or stitch of your choice until dishcloth is "square". Cast off loosely.

Crocheted Cloth:

Chain 40 stitches. Turn and work double or triple crochet across chain to end. Turn and continue in chosen stitch until cloth is "square". Fasten off.

But don't stop there:

- Two cloths make a cute bag or placemat
- Three cloths make a yummy table runner
- Four cloths make a cushy bolster pillow
- Lots of cloths make a cozy throw, baby blanket, vest or jacket
