

# Princess "Elsa" Tu-Tu Gown

*Designed for a Princess with a 24" chest*

## Materials:

2/3 yd. Stretch Mesh

¼ yd. Stretch Lining fabric for bodice

10 – 15 yds. 54" wide Solid Tulle

3-1/2 yd. Polka Dot Tulle (or another design that will add interest or sparkle)

¼ yd. each White & Silver Snowflake Trim

## Making the Bodice:

1. Sew the Stretch Mesh into a tube by stitching the ends together with a ½" seam.
2. From Stretch Lining, cut a 8" x 24" piece, and stitch it into a tube with a ½" seam.
3. Put the lining inside the mesh bodice with wrong sides together.
4. Pin so that the lining is ¼" from the top of the mesh and ½" above the bottom of the mesh.
5. Stitch the lining to the mesh as pinned using a stretch stitch or large, long zigzag to preserve the stretch of the fabrics.

## Making the Skirt:

1. Cut as many 3" x width of fabric strips of Solid Tulle as you can from the yardage purchased.
2. Cut as many 2" x width of fabric strips from the Polka Dot (or Sparkle) Tulle as you can from the yardage purchased.
3. Put two 3" strips of Solid Tulle and one 2" strip of Polka Dot Tulle together.
4. Fold in half lengthwise and insert the middle through one of the holes on the bottom of the bodice.
5. Pull the fold through until you have a loop about 2" long. Insert the ends of the strips through the loop and pull to tighten up against the bottom of the bodice.
6. Repeat steps 3 - 5 until all holes are filled are your Tu-Tu Skirt is luscious and beautifully full.

*Dress your Princess, take pictures and let her wear it all day long, every day.*
