



Feathery Fascinator

This pretty piece is flashy on the tree or gorgeous on your lapel – and a great excuse to explore our jewelry aisle!

WHAT YOU NEED:

1 Black Felt Square

Fabri-Tac Glue

One Peacock or other fancy feather

One stunning jewelry piece – a pendant or pin

HOW TO MAKE YOUR ORNAMENT:

1. Cut a 1” circle of black felt. Clip off the top 6” of your peacock feather, including the eye. Set the eye end aside.
2. Lightly cover the bottom half of the felt circle with Fabri-Tac.
3. Cut the fringe off the peacock feather spine and fan it out onto the glue on your felt circle.
5. Apply a line of glue along the center of the felt and glue the eye feather to the center of the circle over the peacock fringe.
6. Cover the felt circle on the feathered side with Fabri-Tac, then center it on the back of your jewelry piece and press to glue.
7. Now you have choices – you can attach a ribbon or ornament hook and hang this on your tree, OR you can attach a pinback or barrette to your felt, make an accessory out of it, and enjoy the compliments!
