

First Pitch Poncho

Worn by Jackie McInnes, "First Pitcher" at the First Annual Seattle Mariners Stitch 'n Pitch Night presented by Pacific Fabrics & Crafts

Materials needed:

350 yards Ladder or Ribbon style yarn such as:
Lion Brand Trellis, Lion Brand Incredible or
Tahki Stacy Charles Cancun

One pair size 13 needles
Size J crochet hook

Cast on 40 stitches using a stretchy cast-on method.

Rows 1: Purl

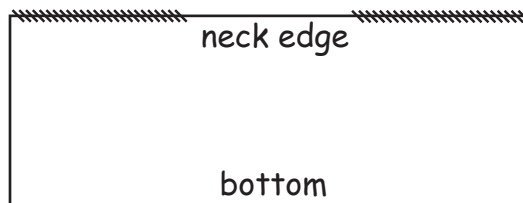
Row 2: Knit

Row 3: Purl

Row 4: K2 *K2tog, yo, K1 repeat from* K2

Repeat rows 1-4 until the piece measures approximately 65". Bind off.

Fold piece in half and sew the side edges together as shown:



Sew hatched edges

Weave in ends and add fringe: Cut the remaining yarn into 16" lengths and attach every inch or so to the lower edge of the poncho using the crochet hook.



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
