

Kitty Fleece Hat

Materials Needed:

2/3 yd. fuchsia polar fleece
Thread to match

Instructions:


Fold the fleece in half so that you have a 12" x 60" strip. Make sure that the greatest stretch of the fabric is from selvedge to selvedge. Cut off the selvages. Cut 11 1/2" pieces along the raw edge opposite the fold. (You should be able to get 5 hats out of a width!)

Fold Edge



With right sides together, using a straight stitch, stitch from the fold down to the cut edge 1/2" on each side. Trim the corners, then turn right sides out. Turn up the cut edge 2" and pin. Using a zig-zag stitch, stitch along the cut edge, lightly stretching the fabric as you sew.

To create the "ears," match the stitch line on the sides of the hat to the center of the top to create triangles. Using a straight stitch, sew 2" from the corner.



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
