

Knitted Ruffle Scarf

Materials:

“Ruffle” yarn – 1 to 2 balls depending on length desired

Knitting Needles: US 7 (4.5mm) or size to obtain gauge

Yarn needle to work in ends

Gauge: is not important for this scarf, but you will want to knit as evenly and consistently as possible.

To make:

- Beginning at side edge, cast on 70 stitches (or length desired) by inserting the needle through the outermost loops of the yarn along the edge from back to front.
- Work in garter st for 9 – 12 rows.
- Bind off. Weave in ends or knot and let hang as a decorative touch. Ends can also be sewn in place with sewing needle and thread.

Crocheted Ruffle Scarf

Materials:

“Ruffle” yarn – 1 to 2 balls depending on length desired

Crochet Hook: US I-9 (5.5mm) or size to obtain gauge

Yarn needle to work in ends

Gauge: is not important for this scarf, but you will want to crochet evenly and consistently if possible.

To make:

- Begin with hook in first loop closest to the wide border, * skip a loop, hook into the next loop and pull through as if making a slip stitch; repeat from * 20 – 40 times depending on preference, slip stitch in the second to last stitch from the hook, creating a picot loop.
- Repeat from * until piece measures 46" or length desired.
- Fasten off. Weave in ends or knot and let hang as a decorative touch. Ends can also be sewn in place with sewing needle and thread.
