

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Diameter: 48"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Mega Tweed® (97% Acrylic, 3% Viscose; 6oz/170g 74 yds/68m)

- #1007-18 Grape Tweed – 10 balls

Needles/Hook: US Size 17 (12.5 mm) double pointed needles (set of 5), 24" and 32" and 40" circular needle *or size needed to obtain gauge*, large crochet hook (exact hook size does not matter)

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers, scissors

GAUGE

6 sts x 9 rows = 4" in St st in the round.

Save time, check your gauge.

STITCH GUIDE

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6" tail. Insert crochet hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and beg working directly into center of ring. (This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.) *Insert hk into the circle and pull up a lp. Yo and draw through one lp on hk (1 lp made); rep from * until there are 9 sts on the hk.

Increase Rnd: *Yo, k1*; rep from * around.

Eyelet Rnd: *Yo, k2tog*; rep from * around.

NOTES

The throw is worked in the round from the center out. Multiple circular needles may need to be used at one time to hold all of the stitches.

THROW

Work **Magic Ring**. Place 3 sts each onto 3 dpns. Join in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Pm to mark beg of rnd.

K 1 rnd. Work **Increase Rnd** – 18 sts on ndl.

K 3 rnds. Work **Increase Rnd** – 36 sts on ndl.

Switch to 24" circular ndl.

K 3 rnds. Work **Eyelet Rnd**.

K 3 rnds. Work **Increase Rnd** – 72 sts on ndl.

Switch to 32" circular ndl.

(K 3 rnds. Work **Eyelet Rnd**) x 2.

K 3 rnds. Work **Increase Rnd** – 144 sts on ndl.

(Use 2 circulars to work around, since the circumference is quite large at this point.)

(K 3 rnds. Work **Eyelet Rnd**) 5 times.

K 3 rnds. Work **Increase Rnd** – 288 sts on ndl.

(Use 3 circulars to work around, since the circumference is quite large at this point.)

(K 3 rnds. Work **Eyelet Rnd**.) x 2.

K 1 rnd.

P 2 rnds.

Bind off in knit on next rnd.

Beg	begin(ning)
ch	chain
dpn	double pointed needles
hk	hook
k	knit
k2tog	knit two stitches together (1 stitch decreased)
lp	loop
m	marker
ndl	needle
p	purl
pm	place marker
rep	repeat
rnd	round
st(s)	stitch(es)
st st	stockinette stitch
yo	yarn over



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
