

# Quilting: Bindings & Labels

This final class in our quilting series takes you through binding and labeling your newly tied or quilted piece. It's those little finishing touches that bring it all together and make a simple "blanket" into a heirloom work of art.

## Supplies

- Machine in good working order with a new needle (#14/90 Universal or Sharp Needle) and manual
- Walking foot, if you have one
- Sewing Notions (scissors, snips, seam ripper, marking tool/Frixion pen, hand sewing needles, wax for coating thread, etc.)
- Rotary cutter with new blade, Cutting Mat, & Large Square quilting ruler
- Thread in desired color
- 2 prefilled bobbins of same thread
- Quilt Clips / Wonder Clips
- Milliners size 10, hand sewing needles
- Binding fabric – measurements will be discussed in class and will depend on the size of your quilt
