

Christmas Stocking

MATERIALS

Makes 2.

½ yard cotton print for stocking

½ yard muslin for lining

⅜ yard Cuddle (or fabric of your choice) for cuff

12" length of ¾"-wide ribbon

CUTTING

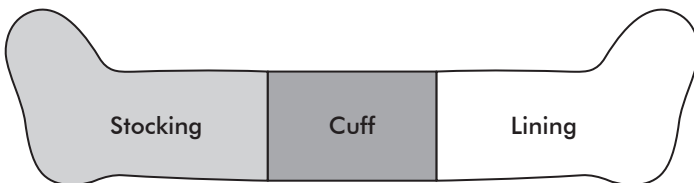
From the cotton print, cut 2 and 2 reversed of the stocking pattern.

From the muslin, cut 2 and 2 reversed of the stocking pattern.

From the Cuddle, cut 4 of the cuff pattern.

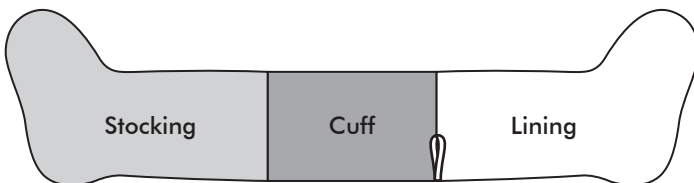
MAKING THE STOCKINGS

- 1 If you want quilted stockings, use the stocking pattern to cut 2 and 2 reversed pieces of batting. Layer the batting to the wrong side of each stocking piece and quilt as desired.
- 2 Sew each cuff piece to the top of a stocking piece and a lining piece, along the short edges of the cuff piece.



Make 2 and 2 reversed.

- 3 Cut the ribbon into two 6" lengths. Sew a ribbon loop to two of the stocking/lining units, placing it at the cuff/lining seam and aligning the raw edges.



- 4 With right sides facing and using a ¼" seam allowance, sew together each pair of stocking/lining units, leaving a 3" opening for turning.
- 5 Clip the curves and turn right side out.
- 6 Hand stitch the opening closed.
- 7 Push the lining into the stocking. Turn the cuff down over the stocking and hang.
