

## Anna-Beth's Valentine's Bunting

Makes 6 yards

You need:

Four quarter yards of four fabrics – I recommend batiks or solids so it's pretty on both sides!

2 packs Extra wide double fold bias tape

Scissors

Sewing machine with thread



Make a fold in your fabric about 4" from the end and place the template along the fold. Cut out. Continue the length of the fabric – with careful folding and cutting, you should be able to get about 5 hearts per fabric.

Continue with all fabrics.

Unfold your bias tape and place the tabs on the top of your hearts along the fold, then fold back up and stitch along the open folds, trapping and stitching the tabs inside. Continue, placing your hearts so the widest bit of curve is about an inch before the next heart's widest bit – your tabs will be about 4-5" apart.



Keep going till you run out of hearts/bias – whichever happens first, then hang up your lovely project!
