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## Learn To Quilt

### 5 sessions - 2hrs each

*To continue to offer great classes at A Quilter's Garden, we encourage you to consider us as your first choice when purchasing class supplies and fabrics. All of the items needed for class may be purchases at A Quilter's Garden.*

## Class Syllabus

### Prior to First Class

- Select project size and get free pattern which is available at the time of sign up.
- Based on pattern select fabrics for your quilt.
- Ensure that your sewing machine is in good working condition and that you can thread it, wind a bobbin and adjust your tension.

### First Class

- You will need to bring a rotary cutter and ruler (rotary mats will be provided)
- We will go over safety tips and accuracy for cutting.
- Pen and paper, for notes
- You will begin the rotary cutting for the quilt top.
- Whatever cutting is not finished in class you should finish before the next class.

### Second Class

- You will need to bring sewing machine, Quarter Inch or ¼" Piecing Presser Foot, neutral threads, scissors or thread snips, seam ripper, straight **size 1** quilting pins, rotary cutter and ruler. (good idea to bring your sewing machine manual)
- We will check everyone's ¼" seam.
- Then piece all Block A's.

Please note, the classroom is at the back of the shop so you can park in the back and walk right into the classroom space.

### Third Class

- You will need to bring sewing machine with ¼" seam foot, neutral threads, scissors or thread snips, seam ripper, pins, rotary cutter and ruler.
- We will cut and piece all Block B's.

### Fourth Class

- You will need to bring sewing machine with ¼" seam foot, neutral threads, scissors or thread snips, seam ripper, rotary cutter and ruler.
- We will sew each row and then sew the rows together.

### Fifth Class

- You will need to bring sewing machine with ¼" seam foot, neutral threads, scissors or thread snips, seam ripper, pins, rotary cutter and ruler.
- We will add the borders and go over tying and quilting methods to finish the quilt and binding.
