This eight week course will focus on the basic techniques of quilting including rotary cutting, sewing an accurate quarter inch seam, piecing, machine appliqué and more. It's designed to introduce you to the basics and allow you to practice them as you build your quilt. Don't worry about getting everything perfect - the goal is to learn, enjoy the process, and make something you can be proud of. By the time you complete this class, you'll have new skills, a little more confidence, and hopefully the beginning of a lifelong love of quilting.
