GO! Tree of Life-14" Finished (55588)

GO! Bear's Paw-14" Finished (55461)

Additional Dies Needed

- GO! Strip Cutter 1-1/2" (1" Finished) (55024) or (55164)

Fabric Requirements:

Fabric Color	Total Yardage
Red	1-1/4 yards
Cream	3/4 yard
Green	3/4 yard
Brown	1/2 yard
Batting	22" x 22"
Lining	22" x 22"
Backing	2 pieces (21"x 26")

Cutting Directions:

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
Red	GO! Bear's Paw-14" Finished (55461)	Cut 1—13-1/4" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Place fabric over shapes A, B, and C. Fanfold into 5" widths. Sub cut into 4—Shape A, 16—Shape B, and 1—Shape C.
Red	GO! Strip Cutter 1-1/2" (1" Finished) (55024) or (55164)	Cut 1—3-1/2" strip x WOF. Sub cut into 2—1" finished strips. Rotary cut 2—1-1/2" x 19-3/4" and 2—1-1/2" x 21-3/4" border strips.
Cream	GO! Bear's Paw-14" Finished (55461)	Cut 1—15-1/4" x WOF strip. Place Fabric over shapes B, C, and D. Fanfold into 3-1/4" widths. Sub cut into 16—Shape B, 4—Shape C, and 4—Shape D.
Cream	GO! Tree of Life-14" Finished (55588)	Cut 9-3/4" x 14-1/2" rectangle. Fold rectangle in half, and cover shapes D, C, G. Sub cut into 2—Shape D, 2—Shape C, and 2—Shape G (that are mirror images of each other)
Cream	GO! Tree of Life-14" Finished (55588)	Cut 1—4-1/2" x 4-1/2" square. Place fabric over shape F Sub cut into 1—Shape F
Cream	GO! Tree of Life-14" Finished (55588)	Cut 2—13-1/2" x 3-1/8" rectangles. Place over Shape B and Cut 20—Shape B.
Cream	GO! Tree of Life-14" Finished (55588)	Cut 2—2-3/4" x 5-1/2" rectangle. Fold in half and place over Shape A. Sub cut into 2—Shape A.
Green	GO! Tree of Life-14" Finished (55588)	Cut 1—2-3/4" x 11" rectangle. Fanfold into 2-3/4" widths. Sub cut into 4—Shape A
Green	GO! Tree of Life-14" Finished (55588)	Cut 3—13-1/2" x 3-1/8" rectangles. Sub cut into 28—Shape B
Brown	GO! Tree of Life-14" Finished (55588)	Cut 1—7-1/4" x 5-1/2" rectangle. Place fabric over shapes F and E. Sub cut into 1—Shape F, and 1—Shape E.

Brown	GO! Tree of Life-14" Finished (55588)	Cut 1—3-3/8" x 4-1/2" rectangle. Fold in half and place over shape H. Sub cut into 2—Shape H.
Brown	GO! Tree of Life-14" Finished (55588)	Cut 1—11" x 3-1/8" rectangle. Place fabric over 8 shape B. Sub cut into 8—Shape B.

Sewing Directions:

Press all seams open and use 1/4" seams, unless otherwise indicated.

Bear's Paw Block

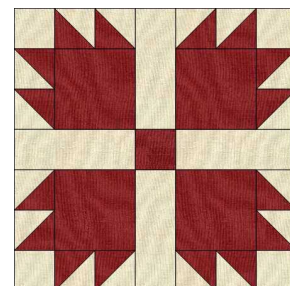
NOTE: Directions will be for one 14" finished block. Make 1 block.

How to Sew the Bear's Paw Quilt Block:

Step 1



Sew one white and one blue half square triangle (HST) (Shape B) together to make a HST unit.

Step 2 – Unit A



Sew two HST units together to make Unit A.

Step 3 – Unit B



Sew two HST units together to make Unit B.

Step 4 – Unit C



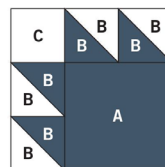
Sew one Unit A and one white square (Shape C) together to make Unit C.

Step 5 – Unit D



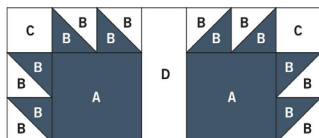
Sew one Unit B and one blue square (Shape A) together to make Unit D.

Step 6 – Unit E



Sew one Unit C and Unit D together to make Unit E.

Step 7 – Unit F



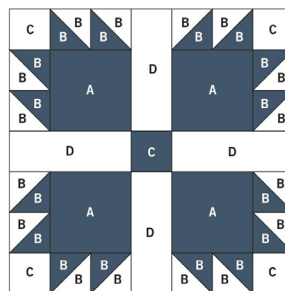
Sew two Unit E and one rectangle (Shape D) to make Unit F.

Step 8 – Unit G



Sew two white rectangles (Shape D) and one blue square (Shape C) to make Unit G.

Step 9



Sew two Unit F and one Unit G.

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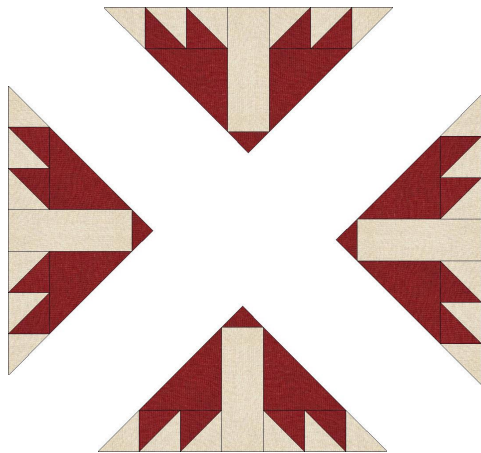

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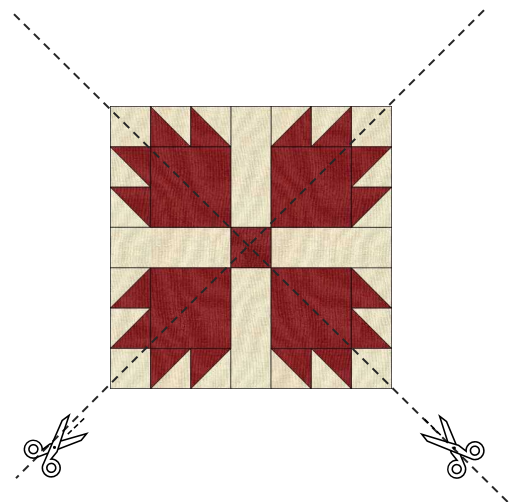
Cut Bear's Paw Block-

Take pieced Bear's paw block and using a ruler and rotary cutter, cut block into quarters. Cut from bottom left corner to top right corner, and bottom right corner to top left corner.

*Optional--to help stabilize the block you could draw the cut lines sew 1/8th of an inch on either side of the lines, and then cut the block into quarters.



Pieces should look like this after they are cut.



Tree of Life Block

NOTE: Directions will be for one 14" finished block. Make 1 block.

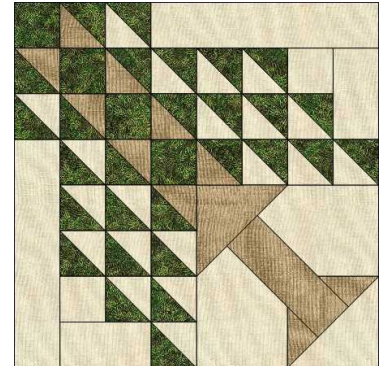

How to Sew the 3-color, 14" finished Tree of Life Block: Use a 1/4" seam allowance. Press as directed.

Step 1



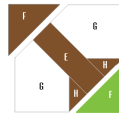
In colors shown, sew 2 B pieces together to create B/B units as shown. Make 20 green/white units and 8 green/brown units.

Step 2



Sew G piece to H piece to make mirror-image G/H units as shown.
Make 1 of each unit.

Step 3



In colors shown, sew 2 mirror image G/H units to E piece. Then sew 1 F piece to top and bottom of G/H/E/G/H unit as shown. Make 1 trunk unit.

Step 4



For Row 1: In colors shown, sew 1 A piece to 2 B/B units. Then sew 1 D piece as shown. Make 1 unit.



For Row 2: In colors shown, sew 2 A pieces and 5 B/B units together as shown. Make 1 unit.

Step 5

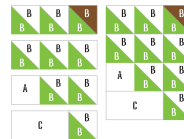


For Rows 3 & 4: In colors shown, sew 6 B/B units to 1 A piece. Make 2 units.



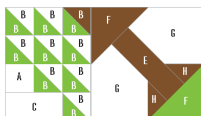
Sew Row 2 to Row 3 as shown.
Then sew C piece to right side
of rows. Make 1 unit.

Step 6



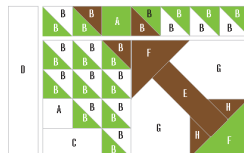
For Rows 5-8: In colors shown, sew 1 A piece, 9 B/B units and 1 C piece into rows, then sew rows into 1 'Rows 5-8' unit.

Step 7



Sew 'Rows 5-8' unit (from step 6)
to trunk unit (from step 3).

Step 8



Sew Row 4 (from step 5) to top of 'Rows 5-8'/trunk unit (from step 7). Then sew D piece to left side of unit.

Step 9



To complete block, sew Row 1 (from step 4) to Rows 2 & 3 (from step 5). Then sew Rows 1-3 to top of unit from step 8. Block should measure 14½" square.

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Assemble the Pillow

1. Lay out Tree of Life block and 4 quarters of the Bear's Paw block as shown.
2. Pin and sew one quarter bear's paw block to opposite sides of Tree of Life block. Press seams open.
3. Sew remaining quarter Bear's Paw blocks to Tree of Life block to create a square as shown.



Assemble the Borders

1. Cut the vertical and horizontal borders according to the cutting instructions. Measure the height of the pillow and adjust the length of the vertical borders accordingly. Stitch the vertical border to the side of the pillow.
2. Measure the width of the pillow and adjust the length of the horizontal border accordingly. Stitch the horizontal border to the top and bottom of pillow. Press seam allowances toward border.

Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between pillow top and lining
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim quilted pillow top to 21" square

Assemble Pillow

1. Cut 2—21 x 26" rectangles from red fabric.
2. Fold each of the two backing pieces in half to measure 13" x 21". Layer backing pieces so that the folded edges overlap enough that the completed backing measures 21" square. Pin backing in place.
3. Layer the completed backing with the pillow top, right sides together.
4. Sew a 1/4" seam all the way around the pillow. Turn inside out through the folded edges of the backing.
