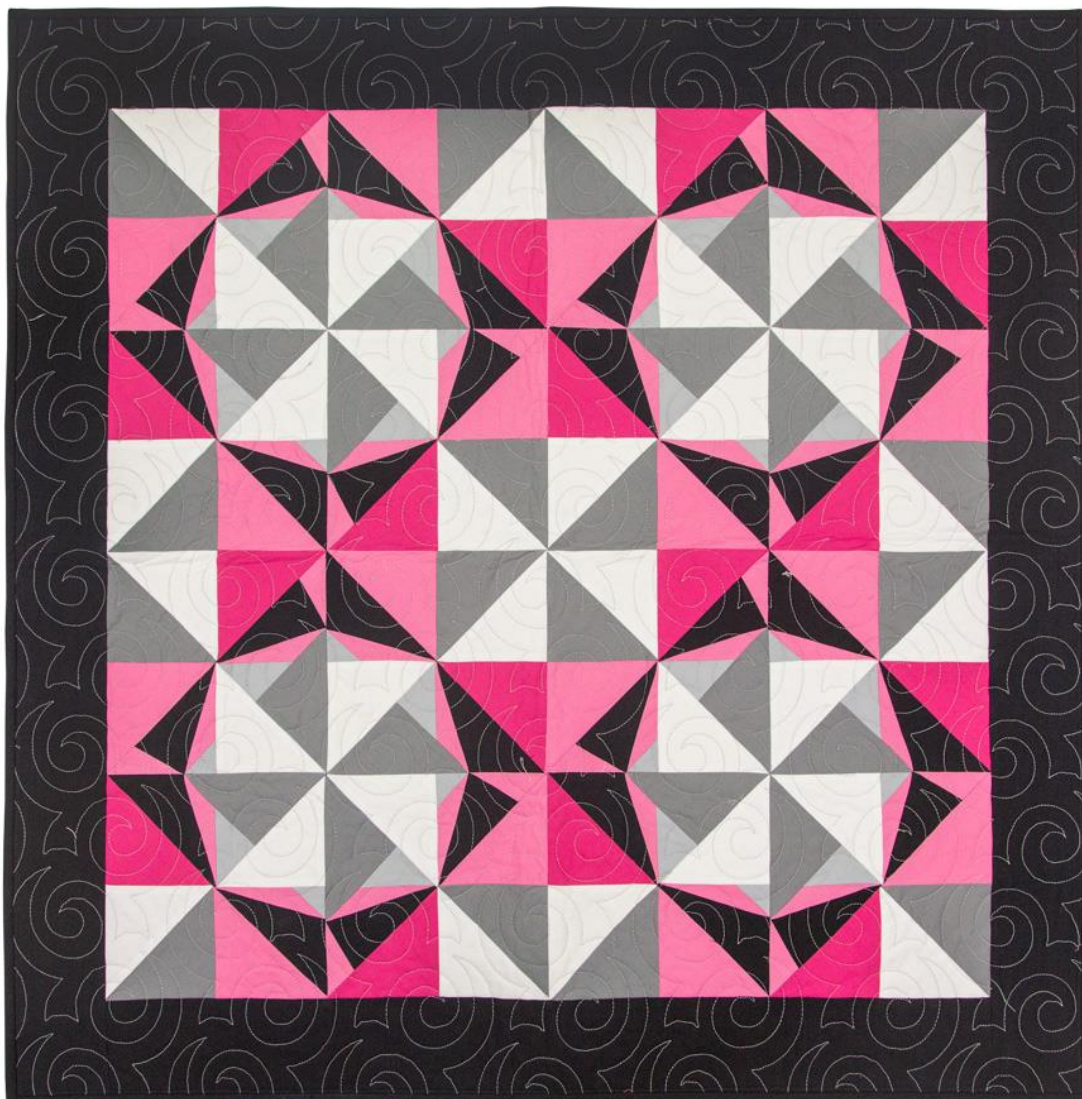


GO! Turning Lucky Stars Wall Hanging

Dies Needed:

GO! Lucky Star 10" Finished (55600)

GO! Qube Mix & Match 10 Block" (55797)

- GO! Quarter Square Triangle-5" Finished Square (Shape 4)

Additional Dies

- GO! Strip Cutter 3 1/2" (3" Finished) 2 Strips Die (55032)

Fabric Requirements:

Fabric Color	Total Yardage
White	5/8yd
Light Grey	1/8yd
Dark Grey	1/2yd
Pink	5/8yd
Dark Pink	1/4yd
Black	7/8yd
Binding Fabric	1/3yd
Batting	39" x 39"
Backing	41" x 41"

Cutting Directions: (Quilt was made with solid fabrics so there's no right or wrong side to the fabric)

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
White	GO! Lucky Star 10" Finished (55600)	Cut 2—6" x WOF (Width of Fabric) strips. Fanfold and lay on shape H and cut out 16 triangle shapes.
White	GO! Quarter Square Triangle-5" Finished Square (Shape 4)	Cut 1—6-3/4" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 6-3/4" widths. Sub cut into 16—5" Fin. QSTs (Quarter Square Triangles).
Light Grey	GO! Lucky Star 10" Finished (55600)	Cut 1—3" x WOF strips. Fanfold and cut out 16 of each D and E shapes.
Dark Grey	GO! Lucky Star 10" Finished (55600)	Cut 2—4-1/4" x WOF strips. Fanfold and lay on shape A and cut out 16 triangle shapes.
Dark Grey	GO! Quarter Square Triangle-5" Finished Square (Shape 4)	Cut 1—6-3/4" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 6-3/4" widths. Sub cut into 16—5" Fin. QSTs (Quarter Square Triangles).
Pink	GO! Lucky Star 10" Finished (55600)	Cut 2—5-1/2" x WOF strips. Fanfold and lay on shape F and G and cut out 16 G triangles and 32 F triangles.
Pink	GO! Quarter Square Triangle-5" Finished Square (Shape 4)	Cut 1—6-3/4" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 6-3/4" widths. Sub cut into 16—5" Fin. QSTs (Quarter Square Triangles).
Dark Pink	GO! Quarter Square Triangle-5" Finished Square (Shape 4)	Cut 1—6-3/4" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 6-3/4" widths. Sub cut into 16—5" Fin. QSTs (Quarter Square Triangles).
Black	GO! Lucky Star 10" Finished (55600)	Cut 2—6" x WOF strips. Fanfold and lay on shape B and C and cut out 16 B and C triangles.
Black	GO! Strip Cutter 3 1/2" (3" Finished)(55032)	Cut 2—7-1/2" WOF strips. Lay on die and cut out 4—3-1/2" WOF strips.

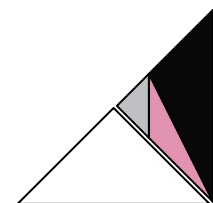
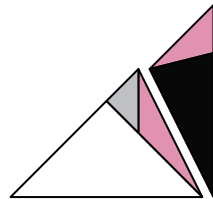
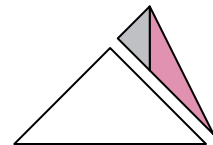
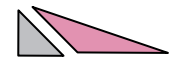
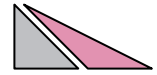
Sewing Directions:

Press all seams open and use ¼" seams, unless otherwise indicated.

Lucky Star Block

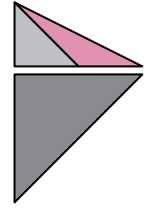
NOTE: Directions will be for one 10" finished block. Make 4 blocks.

1. Sew 1 Pink F triangle to sides of 1 Light Grey D triangle as shown.
2. Make 4 per block.
3. Sew 1 Pink F triangle to side of 1 Light Grey E triangle as shown.
4. Make 4 per block.
5. Sew 1 Pink G triangle to side of 1 Black C triangle as shown.
6. Make 2 per block.
7. Also make 2 per block in reverse!
8. Sew an E+F unit to sides of a White H triangle as shown
9. Make 4 per block.
10. On 2 of the sections, add a G and B unit from above.
11. Sew a Black B triangle to remaining 2 H+D+F units above.

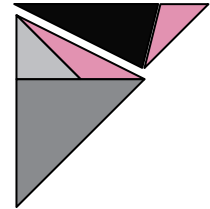


12. Sew 1 E+F unit to 1 Dark Grey A triangle as shown.

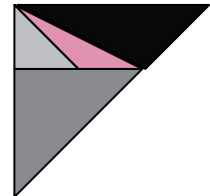
13. Make 4 per blocks.



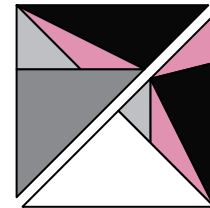
14. On 2 of the sections, add a G and B unit from above.



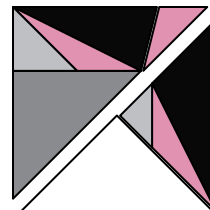
15. Sew a Black B triangle to remaining 2 H+D+F units above.



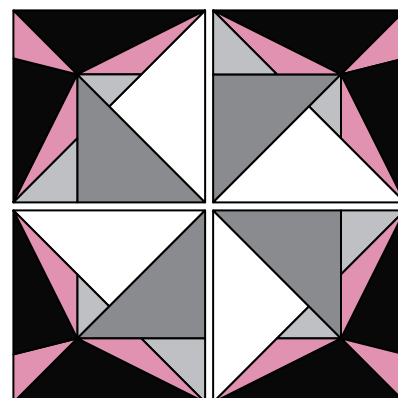
16. Sew 2 quarter block sections together with the Pink G triangle on the right side as shown.



17. Sew 2 quarter block sections together with the Pink G triangle on the left side as shown.



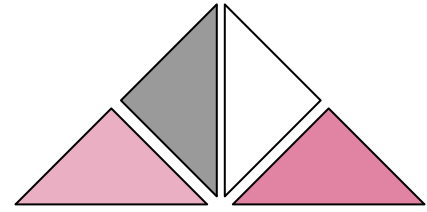
18. Sew block together with the 4 quarter block units paying attention to the pink G triangle.



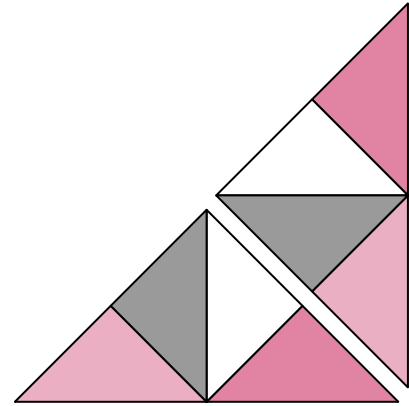
Lucky Star Block

NOTE: Directions will be for one 10" finished block. Make 1 block, 4 half blocks and 4 quarter blocks.

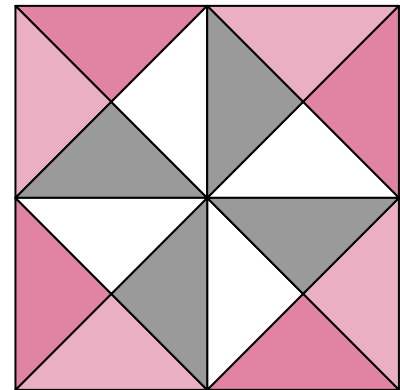
19. Sew 1 Pink, 1 Dark Pink, 1 White and 1 Dark Grey QST-Quarter Square Triangle (Shape 4) together as shown.
20. 16 units like this, set 4 aside as quarter (corner) blocks.



21. Sew 2 together as shown.
22. Make 4 as half (side) blocks.



23. Sew remaining 4 together into a full sized block.



Assemble the Quilt Top

1. Lay out blocks in diagonal rows follow chart below. Sew blocks together into rows. Press seams to one side or open.
2. Sew rows together. Press seams in opposite directions or open.
3. Trim 2 Black 3-1/2" border strips to 28-3/4" and PIN to sides of quilt top carefully, since the block fabrics are all on a bias. Start by pinning the center of the strip to the

center of the quilt top, then pin the edges and then pin between these pins and sew to sides of quilt.

4. Trim remaining 2 Black 3-1/2" border strips to 34-3/4" and carefully pin and sew to top and bottom of quilt as before.

Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding made from 4—2-1/2" strips, mitering corners.
