| Medium <br> Pink | GO! Alabama <br> Beauty-10" <br> Finished <br> (55597) | Cut 1-6-1/4" $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Fanfold rectangle, then <br> place over shape C to get mirror shapes when cutting. You <br> should have 4 C pieces when done, 2 left and 2 right. |
| Medium | GO! Strip <br> Cutter-1-1/2" (1" <br> Finished) <br> (55024) | Cut 1-1-1/2" Square |


| Light Gray | Cutter-1-1/2" (1" <br> Finished) <br> (55024) | Cut 8—1-1/2" Strips. Subcut into $24-1-1 / 2 " \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. |

| Dark Gray | GO! Alabama <br> Beauty-10" <br> Finished <br> (55597) | Cut $36-8-1 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 4$ " rectangles. Place the right side up over shape A to cut. |
| Black | GO! Alabama Beauty-10" <br> Finished (55597) | Cut $36-6$ " $\times 2-1 / 2$ " rectangles. Pace right side up over shape $B$ to cut. |
| Binding | $\begin{aligned} & \text { GO! Strip } \\ & \text { Cutter2-1/2" (2" } \\ & \text { Finished) } \\ & (55017 \text { or } \\ & 55014) \end{aligned}$ | Cut 4-2-1/2" strips. |

Sewing Directions:

## These directions are for HOW to sew the blocks. Please see the pictures on the next page to determine fabric placement for the blocks. <br> Press all seams open and use $1 / 4$ " seams, unless otherwise indicated.

1. Match up the notches and pin at notch, then sew left $C$ piece to the left side of piece $B$ as shown.

2. Match up notches and pin at notch, then sew right $C$ piece to the right side of piece $B$ as shown. Make 4 CBC units.

3. Match up notches and pin at notches, then sew piece A to the CBC unit. Make 4 CBCA units.

4. Match up notches and pin at notches then sew the 4 CBCA units together as shown.

5. Block should measure $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.

## Specific BLOCKS to sew

NOTE: I laid out each of these blocks as I was sewing them to make sure fabric was placed in the correct position.

1. Make 1 of each of the blocks shown below. Be careful as they are flips of each other.

2. Make 3 of the block shown below.


## Assemble the Quilt Top

1. Lay out blocks in 3 rows of 3 blocks each with sashing and cornerstones as shown in the quilt diagram below. Sew blocks together into rows. Press seams to one side.
2. Sew rows together. Press seams in opposite directions

## Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
