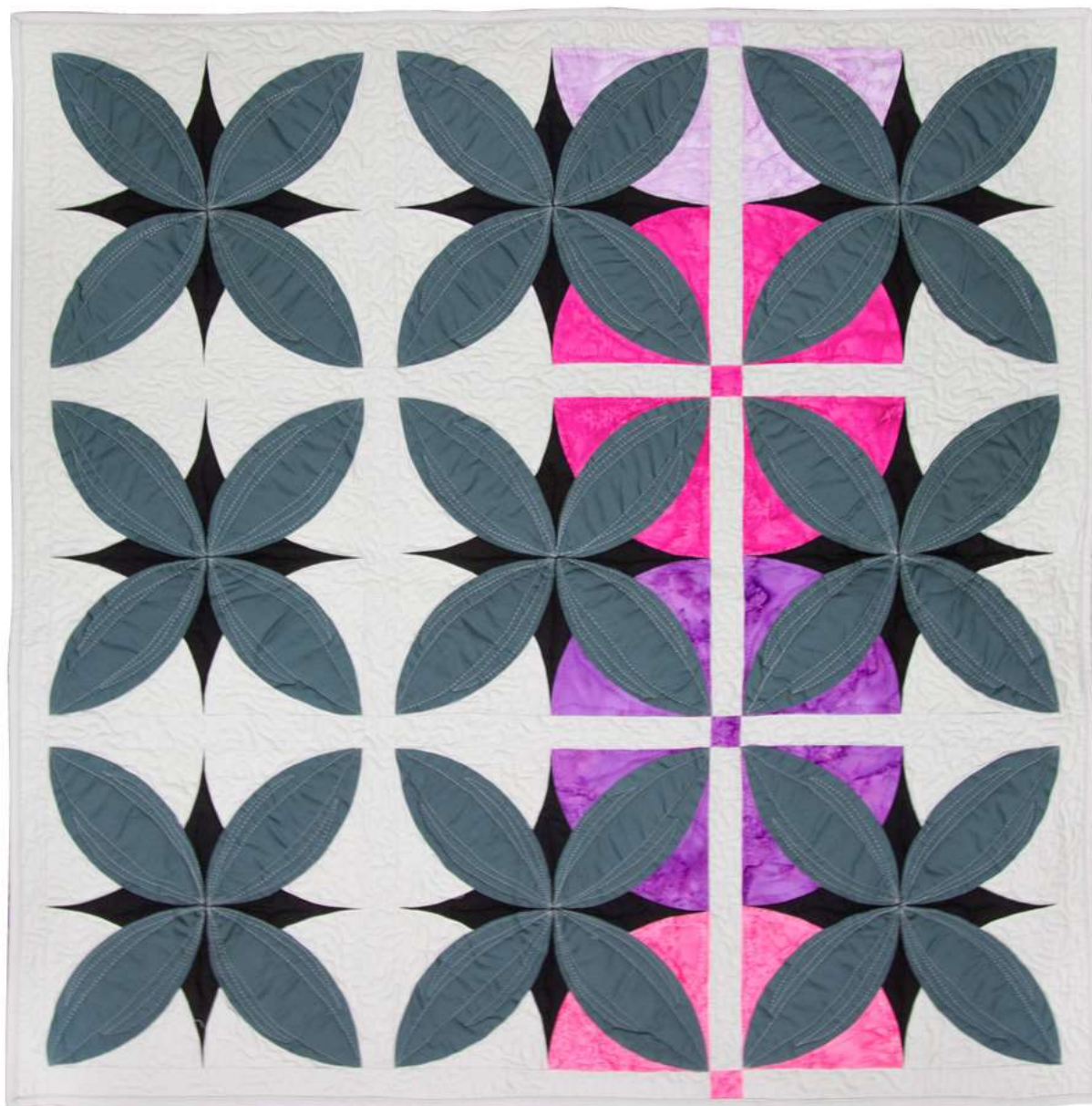


## GO! Modern Alabama Wall Hanging

## Dies Needed:

**GO! Alabama Beauty-10" Finished (55597)**

### Additional Dies (optional)

- **GO! Strip Cutter 1-1/2" (1" Finished) (55024)**
- **GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)**

## Fabric Requirements:

Fabric Color	Total Yardage
Medium Pink	1 Fat Quarter
Light Pink	1 Fat Quarter
Medium Purple	1 Fat Quarter
Light Purple	1 Fat Quarter
Light Gray	1 ¼ yard
Dark Gray	1 ¼ yard
Black	½ yard
Binding	⅓ yard
Backing	1 ¼ yard

## Cutting Directions:

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
Medium Pink	GO! Alabama Beauty-10" Finished (55597)	Cut 1—6-1/4" x 8-1/2" rectangle. Fanfold rectangle, then place over shape C to get mirror shapes when cutting. You should have 4 C pieces when done, 2 left and 2 right.
Medium Pink	GO! Strip Cutter-1-1/2" (1" Finished) (55024)	Cut 1—1-1/2" Square
Light Pink	GO! Alabama Beauty-10" Finished (55597)	Cut 2—6-1/4" x 8-1/2" rectangle. Fanfold rectangle, then place over shape C to get mirror shapes when cutting. You should have 8 C pieces when done, 4 left and 4 right.
Light Pink	GO! Strip Cutter-1-1/2" (1" Finished) (55024)	Cut 1—1-1/2" Square
Medium Purple	GO! Alabama Beauty-10" Finished (55597)	Cut 1—6-1/4" x 8-1/2" rectangle. Fanfold rectangle, then place over shape C to get mirror shapes when cutting. You should have 4 C pieces when done, 2 left and 2 right.
Medium Purple	GO! Strip Cutter-1-1/2" (1" Finished) (55024)	Cut 1—1-1/2" Square
Light Purple	GO! Alabama Beauty-10" Finished (55597)	Cut 2—6-1/4" x 8-1/2" rectangle. Fanfold rectangle, then place over shape C to get mirror shapes when cutting. You should have 8 C pieces when done, 4 left and 4 right.
Light Purple	GO! Strip Cutter 1-1/2" (1" Finished) (55024)	Cut 1-1-1/2" Square
Light Gray	GO! Alabama Beauty-10" Finished (55597)	Cut 12—6-1/4" x 8-1/2" rectangle. Fanfold rectangle, then place over shape C to get mirror shapes when cutting. You should have 48 C pieces when done, 24 left and 24 right.
Light Gray	GO! Strip Cutter-1-1/2" (1" Finished) (55024)	Cut 1 Strip of fabric. Then subcut 12—1-1/2" Squares

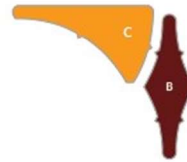
Light Gray	GO! Strip Cutter-1-1/2" (1" Finished) (55024)	Cut 8—1-1/2" Strips. Subcut into 24—1-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles.
Dark Gray	GO! Alabama Beauty-10" Finished (55597)	Cut 36—8-1/8" x 4" rectangles. Place the right side up over shape A to cut.
Black	GO! Alabama Beauty-10" Finished (55597)	Cut 36—6" x 2-1/2" rectangles. Place right side up over shape B to cut.
Binding	GO! Strip Cutter2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)	Cut 4—2-1/2" strips.

## Sewing Directions:

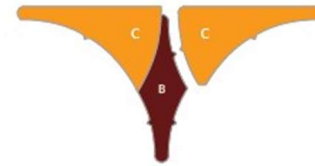
**These directions are for HOW to sew the blocks. Please see the pictures on the next page to determine fabric placement for the blocks.**

*Press all seams open and use 1/4" seams, unless otherwise indicated.*

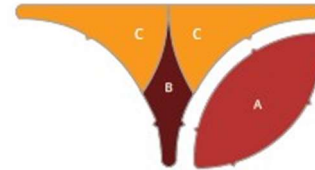
1. Match up the notches and pin at notch, then sew left C piece to the left side of piece B as shown.



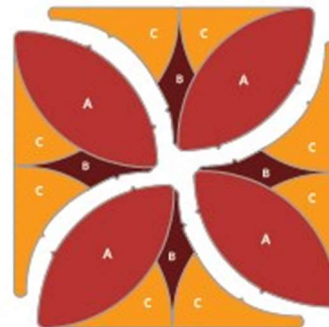
2. Match up notches and pin at notch, then sew right C piece to the right side of piece B as shown. Make 4 CBC units.



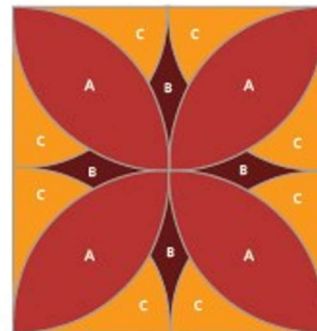
3. Match up notches and pin at notches, then sew piece A to the CBC unit. Make 4 CBCA units.



4. Match up notches and pin at notches then sew the 4 CBCA units together as shown.



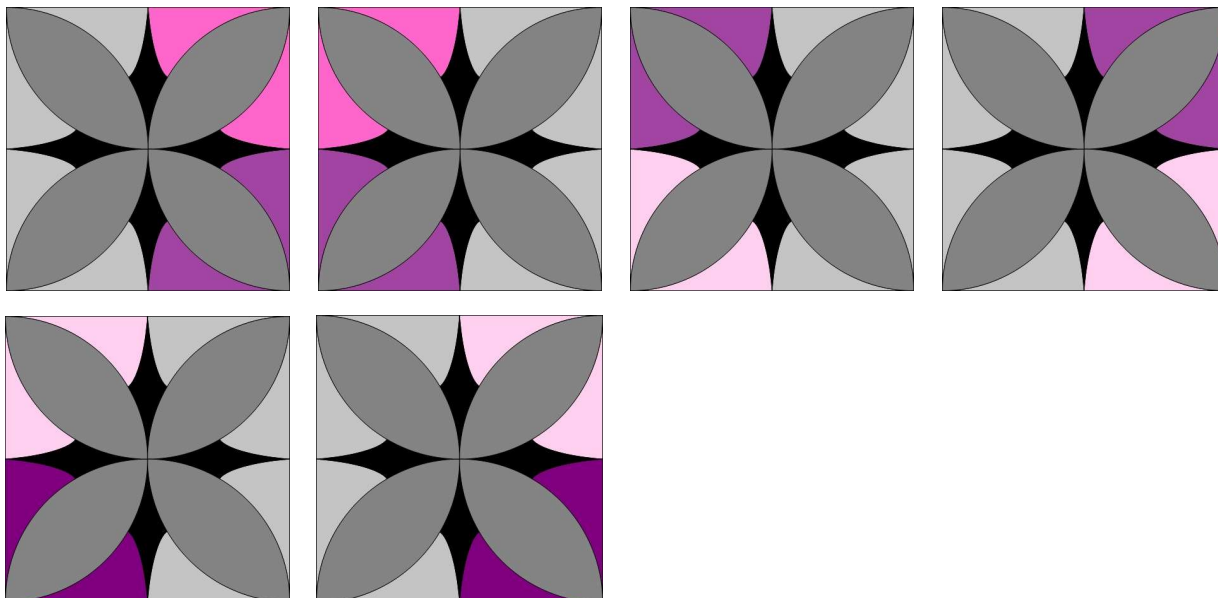
5. Block should measure 10 1/2" square.



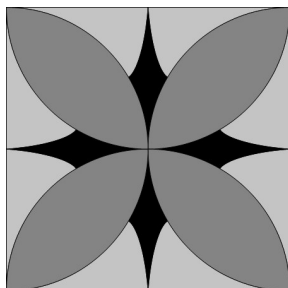
## Specific BLOCKS to sew

**NOTE:** I laid out each of these blocks as I was sewing them to make sure fabric was placed in the correct position.

1. Make 1 of each of the blocks shown below. Be careful as they are flips of each other.



2. Make 3 of the block shown below.





## Assemble the Quilt Top

1. Lay out blocks in 3 rows of 3 blocks each with sashing and cornerstones as shown in the quilt diagram below. Sew blocks together into rows. Press seams to one side.
2. Sew rows together. Press seams in opposite directions

## Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
