GO! Setting Triangles - 8" Finished (55551)
GO! Qube Mix \& Match 5" Block (55567)

- GO! Square- 1 3/4" (1 1/4" Finished) (Shape 2)
- GO! Half Square Triangle-1 1/4" Finished Square (Shape 5)


## Additional Dies Needed

- GO! Strip Cutter 1 3/4" (1 1/4" Finished) (55083)
- GO! Strip Cutter 2 1/4" (1 3/4" Finished) (55053)
- GO! Strip Cutter 2 1/2" (2" Finished) (55014 or 55017)


## Fabric Requirements:

| Fabric Color | Total Yardage |
| :--- | :---: |
| Yellow | $3 / 8$ yard |
| Orange | $2 / 3$ yard |
| Green | $5 / 8$ yard |
| Teal | $11 / 8$ yards |
| White | 1 yard |
| Batting | $38^{\prime \prime} \times 38^{\prime \prime}$ |
| Backing | $38^{\prime \prime} \times 38^{\prime \prime}$ |

Note: When cutting using the GO! Full Blown Tulip (55616) die, note that shapes AR, BR, CR and DR are mirror-images of shapes $A, B, C$ and $D$. Both are usually cut at the same time when fabric is fanfolded.

## Cutting Directions:

| Fabric Color | Die | Number of Shapes to Cut |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Yellow | GO! Full Blown Tulip - 8" Finished (55616) | Cut 2—4-1/4" x Width of Fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 3-3/4" sections. Sub cut into $14-$ Shape A and 14Shape AR. |
| Orange | GO! Full Blown Tulip - 8" Finished (55616) | Cut 2-4-1/4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into $3-3 / 4$ " sections. Sub cut into 14 -Shape A and 14-Shape AR. |
| Orange | GO! Strip Cutter 2 <br> 1/4" (1 3/4" <br> Finished) (55053) | Cut 4-2-1/4" x WOF strips for binding. |
| Green | GO! Full Blown Tulip - 8" Finished (55616) | Cut 2-2-3/4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 2-3/4" sections. Sub cut into 28-Shape D and 28-Shape DR. |
| Green | GO! Setting Triangles - 8" Finished (55551) | Cut 1-7-1/4" x WOF strip. Cut 2-7-1/4" squares. Fold each square diagonally in half. Place on die, aligning the fabric fold with the longest edge of the corner triangle shape. Sub cut into 4-corner setting triangles. |
| Teal | GO! Full Blown Tulip - 8" Finished (55616) | Cut 3-5-3/4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into $5-3 / 4$ " squares. Sub cut into 28-Shape B and 28-Shape BR. |
| Teal | GO! Half-Square Triangle-1 1/4" Finished (Shape 5) | Cut $1-6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Place on die at a $45^{\circ}$ angle, aligning the straight of grain with the diagonal edge of the triangles. Sub cut 8-1-1/4" finished Half Square Triangles (HST) for cornerstone triangles. |
| Teal | GO! Square-1 3/4" <br> (1 1/4" Finished) <br> (Shape 2) | Cut $1-4$ " square. Sub cut into $4-1-1 / 4$ " finished squares for cornerstone squares. |
| Teal | GO! Strip Cutter 2 1/2" (2" Finished) (55014 or 55017) | Cut $4-2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Rotary cut $2-2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 30-$ $5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ and $2-2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 26-5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ border strips. |
| White | GO! Full Blown Tulip - 8" Finished (55616) | Cut 2—3-5/8" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 5" sections. Sub cut into 28—Shape C and 28—Shape CR. |
| White | GO! Strip Cutter 1 3/4" (1 1/4" <br> Finished) (55083) | Cut 4-1-3/4" x WOF strips. Rotary cut into 16-1-3/4" x $8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strips. |

## Sewing Directions:

Press all seams open and use $1 / 4$ " seams, unless otherwise indicated.

## Full Blown Tulip Block

NOTE: Directions will be for one 8 " finished block. Make 5 blocks.

1. Lay out one white $C$, one teal $B$, one yellow $A$ and one green D as shown.

2. Sew the white $C$ and teal $B$ together.
3. Sew the green $D$ onto the $B-C$ unit.

4. Sew the yellow $A$ onto the $B-C-D$ unit to complete an ABCDY triangle. Make 2 ABCDY triangles.

5. Using one orange A, repeat Steps 1-4 to complete an ABCDO triangle as shown. Make 2 ABCDO triangles.

6. Lay out one white $C R$, one teal $B R$, one orange $A R$ and one green DR as shown.
7. Sew the white $C R$ and teal $B R$ together.

8. Sew the orange AR onto the BR-CR-DR unit to complete an ABCDRO triangle. Make 2 ABCDRO triangles.

9. Using one yellow AR, repeat Steps 6-9 to complete an ABCDRY triangle as shown. Make 2 ABCDRY triangles.
10. Sew one $A B C D Y$ and one $A B C D R O$ triangle together to complete Quarter Block Y. Make 2 Quarter Block Y.

11. Sew one $A B C D O$ and one ABCDRY triangle together to complete Quarter Block Z. Make 2 Quarter Block Z.

12. Lay out two Quarter Block Y and two Quarter Block Z as shown. Sew units together to complete one Full Blown Tulip Block.


## Full Blown Tulip Triangular Half-Blocks

1. Follow steps 1-4 in the previous section to create one ABCDY triangle. Make 4 ABCDY triangles.

2. Follow steps 1-4 in the previous section to create one ABCDO triangle. Make 4 ABCDO triangles.

3. Follow steps 6-9 in the previous section to create one ABCDRO triangle. Make 4 ABCDRO triangles.

4. Lay out and sew one of each of ABCDRY, ABCDY, ABCDRO, and ABCDO together to make a Full-Blown Tulip Triangular Half-Block W. Make 2 Full Blown Tulip Triangular Half Block W.

5. Lay out and sew one of each of ABCDRO, ABCDO, ABCDRY, and ABCDY together to make a Full-Blown Tulip Triangular Half-Block X. Make 2 Full Blown Tulip Triangular Half Block X.

6. Gently staystitch about $1 / 8$ " from the raw edge of the longest side of each Half-Block for better stability.
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## Assemble the Quilt Top

1. Lay out blocks, half-blocks, white sashing strips, teal cornerstone squares, teal cornerstone triangles and green corner setting triangles on point as shown in quilt diagram. Sew units together into diagonal rows. Press seams to one side.
2. Sew rows together. Press seams in opposite directions.
3. Sew $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 26-5 / 8$ " border strips to opposite sides of the quilt center.
4. Sew $2-1 / 2$ " $\times 30-5 / 8$ " border strips to the remaining side to complete the quilt top.

## Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
