# **Cutting Directions:**

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut	
Green	GO! Fractured Tumbler—3" Finished (55627)	Cut 1—4-1/2" x Width of Fabric (WOF) strip. Rough cut into 4-1/4" sections. Place fabric pieces on the die right side up. Sub cut into 8—shape A.	
Green	GO! Fractured Tumbler—3" Finished (55627)	Cut 1—4-5/8" x WOF strip. Rough cut into 4-5/8" squares. Place fabric pieces on the die right side up. Sub cut into 16—shape B.	
Green	GO! Square 1 1/2" (1" Finished) (Shape 2)	Cut 1—3-1/2" square. Sub cut 4—1" finished squares for cornerstones.	
Green	GO! Strip Cutter 1 3/4" (1 1/4" Finished) (55083)	Cut 4—1-3/4" x WOF strips. Rotary cut 2—2" x 29-1/2" and 2—2" x 32" outer border strips.	
Dark Pink	GO! Fractured Tumbler—3" Finished (55627)	Cut 2—4-5/8" x WOF strips. Rough cut into 4-5/8" squares. Place fabric pieces on the die right side up. Sub cut into 8—shape B. (Label these as shape B.) Place fabric pieces on the die right side down. Sub cut into 36—shape B. (Label these as shape Bd.)	
Dark Pink	GO! Strip Cutter 2 1/4" (1 3/4" Finished) (55053)	Cut 4—2-1/4" x WOF strips for binding.	
Pink	GO! Fractured Tumbler—3" Finished (55627)	Cut 1—4-1/2" x WOF strip. Rough cut into 4-1/4" sections.  Place fabric pieces on the die right side up. Sub cut into 8—shape A. (Label these as shape A.)  Place fabric pieces on the die right side down. Sub cut into 4—shape A. (Label these as shape Ad.)	
Pink	GO! Fractured Tumbler—3" Finished (55627)	Cut 2—4-5/8" x WOF strips. Rough cut into 4-5/8" squares. Place fabric pieces on the die right side up. Sub cut into 16—shape B. (Label these as shape B.) Place fabric pieces on the die right side down. Sub cut into 24—shape B. (Label these as shape Bd.)	





Pink	GO! Square 1 1/2" (1" Finished) (Shape 2)	Cut 1—3-1/2" x 7" rectangle. Fanfold into 3-1/2" sections. Sub cut 5—1" finished squares for cornerstones.
Light Pink	GO! Fractured Tumbler—3" Finished (55627)	Cut 1—4-5/8" x WOF strip. Rough cut into 4-5/8" squares. Place fabric pieces on the die right side up. Sub cut into 32—shape B.
White	GO! Fractured Tumbler—3" Finished (55627)	Cut 2—4-1/2" x WOF strips. Rough cut into 4-1/4" sections.  Place fabric pieces on the die right side up. Sub cut into 16—shape A. (Label these as shape A.)  Place fabric pieces on the die right side down. Sub cut into 4—shape A. (Label these as shape Ad.)
White	GO! Fractured Tumbler—3" Finished (55627)	Cut 2—4-5/8" x WOF strips. Rough cut into 4-5/8" squares. Place fabric pieces on the die right side up. Sub cut into 24—shape B. (Label these as shape B.) Place fabric pieces on the die right side down. Sub cut into 20—shape B. (Label these as shape Bd.)
White	GO! Strip Cutter 1 1/2" (1" Finished) (55024)	Cut 4—1-1/2" x WOF strips. Rotary cut 2—1-1/2" x 27-1/2" and 2—1-1/2" x 29-1/2" inner border strips.
White	GO! Strip Cutter 1 1/2" (1" Finished) (55024)	Cut 4—1-1/2" x WOF strips. Rotary cut 24—1-1/2" x 6-1/2" sashing strips.
White	GO! Strip Cutter 1 1/2" (1" Finished) (55024)	Cut 4—1" x WOF strips. Rotary cut 4—1" x 32" strips. Fold each one in half lengthwise, right side out and press into a 1/2" x 32" flange strip.






### **Sewing Directions:**


Use 1/4" seams unless otherwise indicated.

#### **Corner Block**

NOTE: Directions will be for one 6" finished block. Make 4 blocks.

1. Sew one pink shape A and one white shape A together as shown. Make 2.






2. Sew one green shape A and one white shape A together as shown. Make 2.




3. Lay out the four pieced units as shown. Sew together to complete one Corner Block.














# Side Block


NOTE: Directions will be for one 6" finished block. Make 8 blocks.

4. Lay out and sew one white shape B, two light pink shape B and one pink shape B together as shown. Make 2.







5. Lay out and sew one white shape Bd, two dark pink shape Bd and one pink shape Bd together as shown. Make 2.





6. Lay out the four pieced units as shown. Sew together to complete one Side Block.









#### **Center Block**

NOTE: Directions will be for one 6" finished block. Make 4 blocks.


7. Lay out and sew one white shape Bd, two pink shape Bd and one dark pink shape Bd together as shown.




8. Lay out and sew one dark pink shape B, two green shape B and one white shape B together as shown. Make 2.




9. Sew one white shape Ad and one pink shape Ad together as shown.



10. Lay out the four pieced units as shown. Sew together to complete one Center Block.









#### **Assemble the Quilt Top**

- 1. Lay out the four Corner Blocks, 8 Side Blocks and four Center Blocks in 4 rows of 4 blocks each as shown in the quilt diagram, rotating blocks as necessary. To this layout, insert the twenty-four white 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" sashing strips, the four green 1-1/2" square cornerstones and the five pink 1-1/2" square cornerstones as shown. Sew units together into rows. Press seams to one side.
- 2. Sew rows together. Press seams in opposite directions.
- 3. Sew the white 1-1/2" x 27-1/2" inner border strips onto opposite sides of the guilt center.
- 4. Sew the white 1-1/2" x 29-1/2" inner border strips onto the remaining sides of the quilt center.
- 5. Sew the green 1-3/4" x 29-1/2" outer border strips onto opposite sides of the quilt center.
- 6. Sew the green 1-3/4" x 32" outer border strips onto the remaining sides to complete the guilt top.

## **Quilting and Finishing**

- 1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
- 2. Pin or baste layers together.
- Quilt as desired. 3.
- Trim excess batting and backing off. 4.
- Baste, about 1/8" from the raw edges, one white 1/2" x 32" flange along each side of the quilt.
- Add binding, mitering corners.
