Dies Needed:

GO! Pine Burr - 10" Finished (55639)

Additional Dies (optional)

GO! Strip Cutter 2 1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)

Fabric Requirements:

Fabric Color	Total Yardage
Ultra Marine	3 yds
Bluegrass	1 1/3 yd
Aloe	1 1/3 yd
Red	1 1/4 yds
Pimento	1 yds
Goldfish	5/8 yd

Additional Supplies:

Throw Size batting.

1 3/4 yds Wide back or 4 yd 44" Backing Fabric

Cutting Directions:

****This pattern assumes fabric is at least 42" wide.**

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
Ultra Marine	GO! Pine Burr 10" (55639)	Cut (13) 6" x WOF strip. Accordion fold and place on Die C. Cut 600 C pieces.
Ultra Marine	GO! Strip Cutter 2 1/2" (55017)	Cut (3) 8-1/2" strips WOF. Place on die and cut (7) 2-1/2" strips. Set aside for binding.
Bluegrass	GO! Pine Burr 10" (55639)	Cut (6) 7" x WOF strips. Accordion fold and place on Die A. Cut 100 A pieces.
Aloe	GO! Pine Burr 10" (55639)	Cut (6) 7" x WOF strips. Accordion fold and place on Die A. Cut 100 A pieces.
Red	GO! Pine Burr 10" (55639)	Cut (6) 4" x WOF strips. Accordion fold and place on Die B. Cut 100 pieces.
Pimento	GO! Pine Burr 10" (55639)	Cut (5) 6" x WOF strip. Accordion fold and place on Die C. Cut 200 C pieces.
Goldfish	GO! Pine Burr 10" (55639)	Cut (3) 6" x WOF strip. Accordion fold and place on Die C. Cut 100 C pieces.

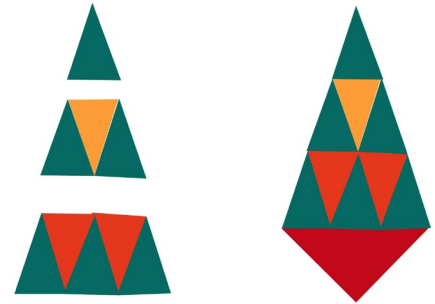
Sewing Directions:

Pine Burr Block

NOTE: Directions will be for one 10" finished block. Make 25 blocks.

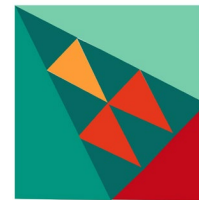
Center Triangle Units:

1. Lay out C triangle pieces according to the diagram.
2. Sew the second row of triangles together.
3. Sew the third row of triangles together.
4. Sew the three rows of triangles together to create the center triangle C unit.
5. Sew red B triangle to base of C unit.



Quarter Pine Burr Blocks:

1. Split your C units into two piles.
2. On pile one:
 - a. Sew the aloe A triangle to the RIGHT of the C unit.
 - b. Sew the bluegrass A triangle to the LEFT of the C unit.
3. On pile two:
 - a. Sew the aloe A triangle to the LEFT of the C unit.
 - b. Sew the bluegrass A triangle to the RIGHT of the C unit.



Pine Burr Blocks:

1. Sew quarter blocks together according to diagrams.
 - a. Make 15 traditional blocks.
 - b. Make 10 blocks with the bluegrass diamond in the center.



Assemble the Quilt Top

1. Lay out the Pine Burr blocks in the setting as shown.
2. Sew blocks together in rows. Press seams in opposite directions.
3. Sew rows together.

Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
