


## GO! Lava Lamp Wall Hanging

- GO! Strip Cutter-2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)

**Fabric Requirements:**

Fabric Color	Total Yardage
Cream	1 1/4 yards
Green	1/2 yard
Purple	3/4 yard
Binding	1/3 yard
Backing	1 yard

## Cutting Directions:

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
Cream	GO! Duck Creek Puzzle-10" Finished (55645)	Cut six 5-1/2" by WOF strips. Cut five of these strip into 5-1/2" x 33" rectangles. Fan fold these five strips into 5-1/2" widths. Place on Blade A and cut thirty Shape A. Cut the remaining strip into a 5-1/2" x 5-1/2" square. Take this and the remaining fabric from the previous five strips and place on Blade A to cut another six Shape A for a total of 36 Shape A.
		Use the remaining strip from the 5-1/2" x 5-1/2" cut to cut a 3" x 18" rectangle. Fan fold into 3" widths and place on blade E to cut six Shape E.
		Cut one 3" by WOF strip. Cut this strip into two 3 x 18" strips. Fan fold each strip into 3" widths and place on Blade E. Cut six Shape E from each strip for a total of 18 Shape E.
Green	GO! Duck Creek Puzzle-10" Finished (55645)	Cut two 3-1/2" by WOF Strips. Cut one strip into a 3-1/2" x 31-1/2" rectangle. Fan fold into 5-1/4" widths and place on blade B to cut twelve Shape B.
		Cut the remaining strip into a 3-1/2" x 21" rectangle and fan fold into 5-1/4" widths. Place on Blade B to cut eight Shape B for a total of twenty Shape B.
Purple	GO! Duck Creek Puzzle-10" Finished (55645)	Cut one 2-1/2" by WOF strips. Cut the strip into a 2-1/2" x 19-1/2" rectangle and a 2-1/2" x 13" rectangle. Fan fold the I into 3-1/4" widths and place on Blade C to cut twenty Shape C.
		Cut one 3" by WOF strip. Cut this strip into a 3" x 18" rectangle and a 3" x 9" rectangle. Fan fold each strip into 3" widths. Place on Blade D and cut nine Shape D.
	GO! Duck Creek Puzzle-10" Finished (55645)	Cut three 3-1/2" by WOF strips. Cut two strips into a 3-1/2" x 31-1/2" rectangle. Fan fold each of these strips into 5-1/4" widths and place on Blade B to cut twelve Shape B from each strip.
		Cut the last strip into a 3-1/2" x 26-1/4" rectangle. Fan fold into 5-1/4" widths and place on Blade B to cut ten Shape B for a total of thirty four Shape B.

Cut two 2-1/2" by WOF strips. Cut one strip into two 2-1/2" x 19-1/2" rectangles. Cut one 2-1/2" x 16-1/4" rectangle from the second strip. Fan fold each strip into 3-1/4" widths and place on Blade C to cut a total of thirty four Shape C.


Binding	GO! Strip Cutter-2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)	Lay fabric on blades to cut four 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

## Sewing Directions:


Use  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams, unless otherwise indicated.

Be sure to follow all diagrams! Various components mirror image others, be sure you are sewing together in the correct directions.


1. Gather all the shape B and Shape C fabrics. Lay out and stitch together as shown in the diagrams to create twelve green BC units, eight green CB units, sixteen purple BC units and eighteen purple CB units. Set aside.









2. Gather all the Shape D and Shape E fabrics. Lay out and stitch together as shown. Label the set of five as Center Unit A and the set of four as Center Unit B.






3. Gather ten purple CB units and five Center Unit A. Lay out and stitch together as shown. Label this completed unit as Central Unit A.





4. Gather eight purple BC units and four Center Unit B. Lay out and stitch together as shown. Label this completed unit as Central Unit B.



5. Gather five Central Unit A and ten Shape A fabrics. Lay out and stitch together as shown. Label completed unit as Central Unit A. Set aside.




6. Gather four Central Unit B and eight Shape A fabrics.  
Lay out and stitch together as shown. Label completed unit as Central Unit B. Set aside.





7. Gather twelve green BC units and six Shape A fabrics.  
Lay out and stitch together as shown. Label as End Unit C. Set aside.





8. Gather eight purple BC units and four Shape A fabrics.  
Lay out and stitch together as shown. Label as End Unit D. Set aside.




9. Gather four green CB units and four purple CB units and four Shape A fabrics. Lay out and stitch together as shown. Label as End Unit E. Set aside.





10. Gather four green CB units and four purple CB units and four Shape A fabrics. Lay out and stitch together as shown. Label as End Unit F. Set aside.





11. Gather two Central Unit A and four End Unit C. Lay out and stitch together as shown. Set aside.




12. Gather one Central Unit A and two End Unit D. Lay out and stitch together as shown. Set aside.




13. Gather two Center Unit A, two End Unit C, and two End Unit D. Lay out and stitch together as shown. Set aside.




14. Gather four Center Unit B, two End Unit E, and two End Unit F. Lay out and stitch together as shown. Set aside.






15. Lay out all the blocks as shown.



16. Stitch the blocks into rows, as shown.



17. Stitch the rows together to finish the quilt top.





## Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
