Additional Dies (optional)

- GO! Setting Triangles-10" Finished (55553)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2-1/2" (2" finished) (55017 or 55014)
- GO! Big Square-10-1/2" (10" Finished) (55592)

Fabric Requirements:

Fabric Color	Total Yardage
Light Pink	1 yard
Medium Pink	1/2 yard
Black	3 1/2 yards
Binding	1/2 yard
Backing	3 yards

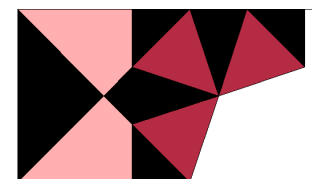
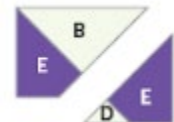
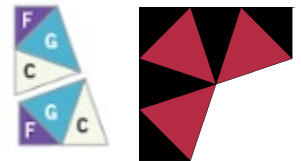
Cutting Directions:

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
Light Pink	GO! Enigma Star-10" Finished (55676)	Cut 2—11" x 14-1/8" rectangles. Place on selected blade and cut.
Medium Pink	GO! Enigma Star-10" Finished (55676)	Cut 2—8-1/4" x 5-1/8" rectangles. Place on selected blade and cut.
Black	GO! Big Square-10-1/2" (10" Finished) (55592)	Cut 4 - 11" strips. Subcut into 11 – 10-1/2" squares.
Black	GO! Setting Triangles-10" Finished (55553)	Cut 3 – 8-1/2" strips. Subcut into 8 large side triangles and 4 small corner triangles.
Black	GO! Enigma Star-10" Finished (55676)	Cut 4 - 4" strips. Subcut into 34 A pieces.
Black	GO! Enigma Star-10" Finished (55676)	Cut 4 - 3" strips. Subcut into 32 B pieces.
Black	GO! Enigma Star-10" Finished (55676)	Cut 2 - 3" strips. Subcut into 32 C pieces.
Black	GO! Enigma Star-10" Finished (55676)	Cut 2 – 1-3/4" strips. Subcut into 32 D pieces.
Black	GO! Enigma Star-10" Finished (55676)	Cut 3 – 2-3/4" strips. Subcut into 34 F pieces.
Binding	GO! Strip Cutter-2-1/2" (2" finished) (55017 or 55014)	Cut 6 – 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

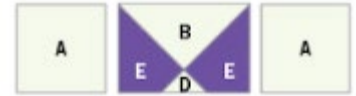
Sewing Directions:

Press all seams open and use 1/4" seams, unless otherwise indicated.

1. Sew 34 medium pink G pieces to 34 black F pieces.
2. Sew 32 black C pieces onto the units from step 1. You will have 2 leftover FG pieces. Sew these onto two FGC units so that there are FG units on both sides of C. These will be used for the half blocks at the edges of the quilt.
3. Sew the units from step 2 into pairs. This includes the two units with the extra FG on the side. (These two should not be sewn to each other) The two with the extra units should be set aside for the half blocks at this point. Your half blocks should look like the picture on the right.
4. Sew the units from step 3 into pairs. You should have 7 blocks when you are done.
5. Sew 32 light pink E pieces to 32 black B pieces. Also sew 32 light pink E pieces to 32 black D pieces.
6. Sew the units from step 5 to each other. You should have 32.
7. Sew 14 units from step 6 to the 7 center units from step 4 as shown at right.
8. Sew 2 units from step 6 to the half block units from step 3 as shown at right.



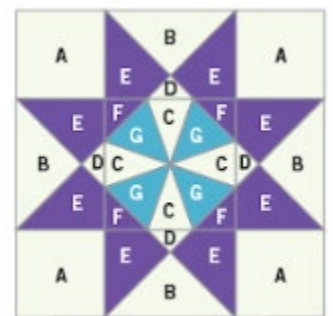
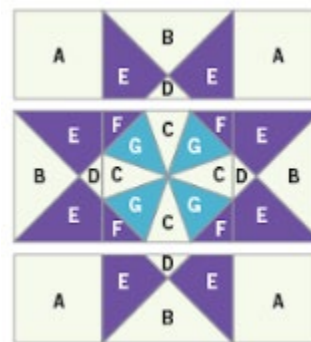
9. Sew 16 units from step 6 to 32 black A squares as shown. You should have two extra black A squares.



10. Complete the half blocks. Sew one unit from step 8 to one unit from step 9 to one black triangle as shown at right.



11. Sew 7 regular blocks. Sew the rows from steps 7 and 9 together.



Assemble the Quilt Top

NOTE: Black is replaced with white here so you can see how to orient blocks.

1. Lay out blocks in diagonal rows as shown in the quilt diagram. Sew blocks together into rows. Press seams to one side.
2. Sew rows together. Press seams in opposite directions
3. Trim the two half blocks flush with the edges of the quilt.

Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
