Rainbow colors or preferred colors varying in different hues (10 or more colors)	2 1/2" Strip roll, Multiple or Various Colored Scraps
White -Includes Backing and Binding	3/4 yard
Batting	1/2 yard

Cutting Directions:

- **Black (Dark and Light/Smoke): Butterfly Body
- **Colored Fabric: Butterfly Wings
- **White Fabric: Background, backing and binding



Black (Dark) (Center butterfly body)	GO! Square-1 1/4" (3/4" Finished) (55681)	Cut 12: 1-1/4" unfinished squares
Black (Light/Smoke) (Sides of butterfly body)	GO! Square-1 1/4" (3/4" Finished) (55681) GO! Half Square Triangle-3/4" Finished Square (55761) (Shape 12.1)	Cut 16: 1-1/4" unfinished squares Cut 8: 1-1/4" Half Square Triangles
Color 1 (Red) (Wings)	GO! Square-1 1/4" (3/4" Finished) (55681)	Cut 22: 1 1/4" unfinished squares
Color 2 (Dark Red) (Wings)	GO! Square-1 1/4" (3/4" Finished) (55681)	Cut 16: 1 1/4" unfinished squares
Color 3 (Orange) (Wings)	GO! Square-1 1/4" (3/4" Finished) (55681) GO! Half Square Triangle-3/4" Finished Square (55761) (Shape 12.1)	Cut 24: 1-1/4" unfinished squares Cut 4: 1-1/4" Half Square Triangles
Color 4 (Yellow) (Wings)	GO! Square-1 1/4" (3/4" Finished) (55681)	Cut 26: 1-1/4" unfinished squares
Color 5 (Green) (Wings)	GO! Square-1 1/4" (3/4" Finished) (55681)	Cut 22: 1-1/4" unfinished squares
Color 6 (Dark Blue) (Wings)	GO! Square-1 1/4" (3/4" Finished) (55681)	Cut 16: 1-1/4" unfinished squares

Color 7 (Light Blue) (Wings)	GO! Half Square Triangle-3/4" Finished Square (55761) (Shape 12.1)	Cut 12: 1-1/4" Half Square Triangles
Color 8 (Magenta) (Wings)	GO! Square-1 1/4" (3/4" Finished) (55681)	Cut 8: 1-1/4" unfinished squares
Color 9 (Purple) (Wings)	GO! Square-1 1/4" (3/4" Finished) (55681)	Cut 6: 1-1/4" unfinished squares
Color 10 (Dark Red/Purple) (Wings)	GO! Half Square Triangle-3/4" Finished Square (55761) (Shape 12.1)	Cut 4: 1-1/4" Half Square Triangles
Color 11 (Light Purple) (Wings)	GO! Half Square Triangle-3/4" Finished Square (55761) (Shape 12.1)	Cut 4: 1-1/4" Half Square Triangles
White (Background)	GO! Square-1 1/4" (3/4" Finished) (55681) GO! Half Square Triangle-3/4" Finished Square (55761) (Shape 12.1)	Cut 86:1-1/4" unfinished squares (34 extra included for top and bottom rows-Optional or use sashing.) Cut 42: 1-1/4" Half Square Triangles
Batting		Cut One: 16" x 16" rectangle piece of batting
Sashing and Backing (White)		Cut One: 1-1/4" sashing x WOF for the left and right side of the quilt. Cut a second 1-1/4" sashing x WOF if preferred to use for the top and bottom (Above and below the butterfly). Cut One: 17" x 19" rectangle piece of fabric for the backing
Binding (White)	GO! Strip Cutter 2 1/4" (55053) or Strip Cutter 2 1/2" (55014)	Cut Two: 2-1/4" strips by WOF or 2- 1/2" strips by WOF

Sewing Directions:


Press all seams open and use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams, unless otherwise indicated.

NOTE: All the pieces are squares except for the half square triangles. Use the illustration for inspiration.




Forming the Half Square Triangles:

1. Take one white half square triangle piece and one colored half square triangle piece. Place them right sides together. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.
2. Press seams open or to one side.
3. Repeat with all half square triangles and put them aside.



Assembling the Butterfly Quilt Top:

4. Using the illustration of the butterfly, lining up each piece within each row from left to right. Start with Row 1 at the top of the butterfly wings and repeat with each consecutive row.
5. Sew each piece right sides together with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press each seam in the same direction so that all seams are facing to the right or left.
6. Repeat with each piece in the row until the row is completed.
7. Repeat steps 4-6 with each row. Press seams in the opposite direction of the following row. Pressing each row in the opposite direction as the row before it. This helps when sewing the rows together.
8. With the right sides together, match all seams of each row and sew the rows together. Repeat until all rows have been sewn and pressed. If choosing to piece together the top and bottom rows of all white, do that now or wait to put sashing on the top and bottom instead.



Add the Sashing:

- Take one sashing piece and place it with the right sides together along the right edge of the pieced quilt. Sew together and press open or toward one side. Trim to correct length.
- Repeat with the second sashing piece on the other side of the quilt. Repeat with the top and bottom if the top and bottom were not pieced together using the 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares.

Quilting and Finishing

- Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
- Pin or baste layers together.
- Quilt as desired.



Bind the Wall Hanging:

- Take the cut strips and piece them right sides together to make binding for the wall hanging.
- Press the seams open. Fold over the binding lengthwise with wrong sides together and press the full length of the binding.
- Using a 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance along the edge, stitch the binding onto the front of the wall hanging.
- Fold over to the back of the wall hanging and press it. Stitch to the back of the wall hanging.
