Dies Needed:

GO! Qube 10" Companion Set – Angles (55799)

- GO! Triangles in Square- Center-5" Finished Square (55820) (Shape 13)
- GO! Triangles in Square- Sides- 5" Finished Square (55821) (Shape 14)
- GO! Kite-Center-5" Finished Square (55822) (Shape 15)

Additional Dies Needed

- GO! Merry GO Round- 10" Finished (55680)
- GO! Setting Triangles-5" Finished (55595)
- GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)

Fabric Requirements:

Fabric Color	Total Yardage
Cream	2-1/2 yards
Lime Green	1-3/4 yards
Blue	1/2 yard
Bright Green	1/2 yard
Batting	51" x 51"
Backing	55" x 55"

Cutting Directions:

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
Cream	GO! Setting Triangles-5" Finished (55595)	Cut 1—16" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Fanfold into 5" widths. Sub cut into 24—5" finished side setting triangles.
Cream	GO! Triangles in Square- Center 5" Finished square (55820)	Cut 3—6" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 6" widths. Sub cut into 16—5" finished triangles in square-center.
Cream	GO1 Triangles in Square-Sides 5" Finished square (55821)	Cut 2—4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 6" widths. (With printed fabric be careful to fanfold so you cut the ½ the amount of shapes with the fabric facing up and ½ with the fabric facing down) Sub cut into 16—5" finished triangles in square-sides.
Cream	GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)	Cut 5—2-1/2" x WOF strips. Join strips end to end with diagonal seams. Sub cut 2—2-1/2" x 43" vertical borders. Sub cut 2—2-1/2" x 47" horizontal borders
Cream	GO! Merry GO Round 10" Finished (55680)	Cut 4—4-1/4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 4-1/4" widths. Sub cut into 36— Shape D.
Cream	GO! Merry GO Round 10" Finished (55680)	Cut 3—4-1/2" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 2-7/8" widths. Sub cut into 36—Shape E.
Lime Green	GO1 Triangles in Square-Sides 5" Finished square (55821)	Cut 2—4" x WOF strips. Sub cut into 10—4" x 6" rectangles. Place 4—4" x 6" rectangles over shapes with fabric facing up . Sub cut 8—triangles in square-sides (left) Place 6—4" x 6" rectangles over shapes with fabric facing down . Sub cut 12—triangles in square-sides (right)
Lime Green	GO! Merry GO Round 10" Finished (55680)	Cut 2—3-7/8" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 3-7/8" widths. Sub cut into 32—Shape A.
Lime Green	GO! Merry GO Round 10" Finished (55680)	Cut 4—3-3/8" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 4-1/2" widths. Sub cut into 32—Shape B.

Lime Green	GO! Merry GO Round 10" Finished (55680)	Cut 3—6" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 2-3/4" widths. Sub cut into 32—Shape C.
Lime Green	GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)	Cut 5—2-1/2" Strips to use for quilt binding.
Blue	GO! Merry GO Round 10" Finished (55680)	Cut 1—3-7/8" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 3-7/8" widths. Sub cut into 4—Shape A.
Blue	GO! Merry GO Round 10" Finished (55680)	Cut 1—3-3/8" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 4-1/2" widths. Sub cut into 4—Shape B.
Blue	GO! Merry GO Round 10" Finished (55680)	Cut 1—6" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 2-3/4" widths. Sub cut into 4—Shape C.
Blue	GO1 Triangles in Square-Sides 5" Finished square (55821)	Cut 1—4" x WOF strip. Sub cut into 6—4" x 6" rectangles. Place 4—4" x 6" rectangles over shapes with fabric facing up . Sub cut 8—triangles in square-sides (left) Place 2—4" x 6" rectangles over shapes with fabric facing down . Sub cut 12—triangles in square-sides (right)
Dark Green	GO! Kite-Center 5" Finished Square (55822)	Cut 2—6" x WOF strip. Use the Cut & Shift™ method. Start at one end of fabric, place over the shape, layer fabric if desired. Continue to cut and shift the fabric strip downward to align cut angle of fabric with angle of blades to cut the next kite center across the width of fabric. Sub cut 8—5" finished kite-center.

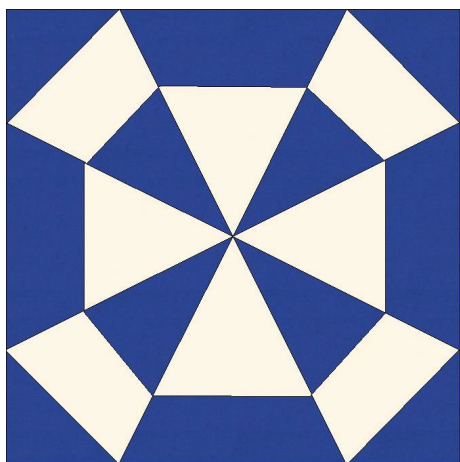
Sewing Directions:

Press all seams open and use ¼" seams, unless otherwise indicated.

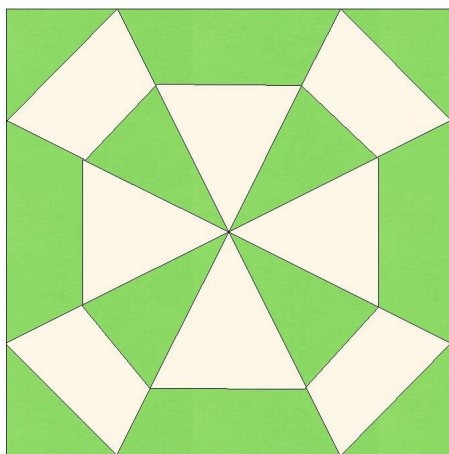
Merry Go Round Block

Using the BOB instructions make 9—Merry Go Round blocks.

1—in the blue colorway



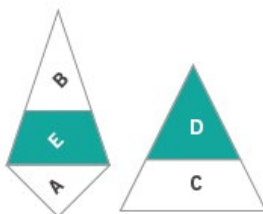
8—in the lime green colorway



How to sew a 2-color Merry Go Round Quilt Block:

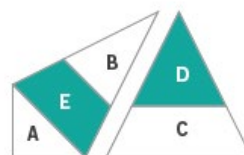
Read through assembly instructions before starting sewing. Use a ¼" seam allowance. Press seams open unless otherwise directed in pattern.

Step 1



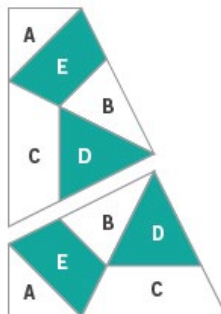
Sew shapes B, E and A together as shown. Sew shapes D and C together as shown. Press seams toward E and D shapes. Make four of each unit.

Step 2



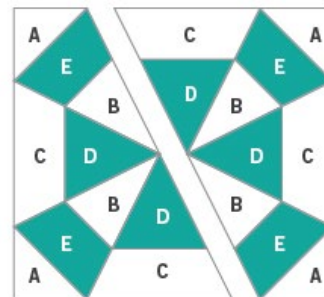
Sew one B/E/A unit to the left side of D/C unit as shown. Make four units.

Step 3



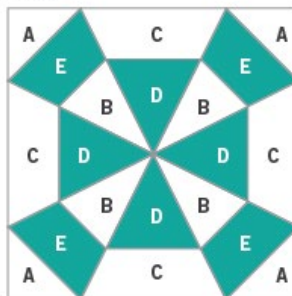
Sew two B/E/A/D/C units together as shown. Make two half blocks.

Step 4



Sew two half blocks together as shown to complete the block.

Step 7

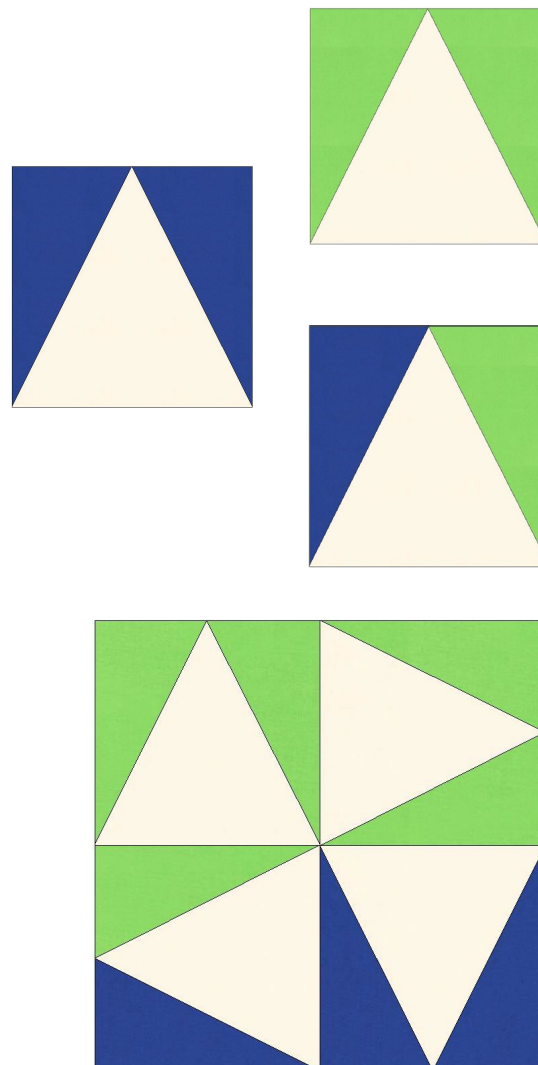


Block should measure 10½" x 10½".

Triangles in Square Block

NOTE: Directions will be for one 10" finished block. Make 4 blocks.

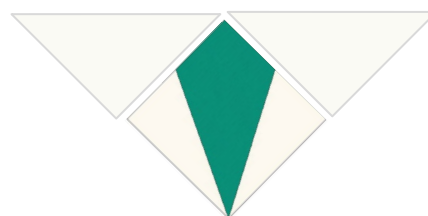
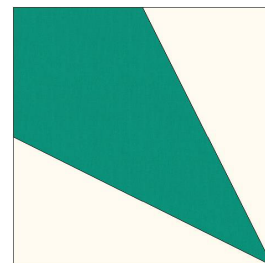
1. Sew one lime green triangles in square (TIS)-sides (Shape 14) to each long edge of one cream TIS-center (Shape 13). Press seams open. Make 2 Lime green/cream TIS units.
2. Sew one blue TIS-sides (Shape 14) to each long edge of one cream TIS-center (Shape 13). Press seams open. Make 1 blue/cream TIS unit.
3. Sew one lime green TIS-side. (Shape 14) to the right edge of one cream TIS-center (Shape 13). Sew one blue TIS-side (Shape 14) to the left edge of one cream TIS center (Shape 13). Press seams open. Make 1 blue/cream/green TIS unit.
4. Lay out quarter block units as shown. Sew top two units. Press to one side. Sew bottom two units. Press to opposite sides.
5. Sew half blocks together to complete block. Make 1—10" finished Triangles in Square Block.



Kite Setting Triangles

NOTE: Directions will be for one 10" finished pieced side setting triangle. Make 8 pieced side setting triangles.

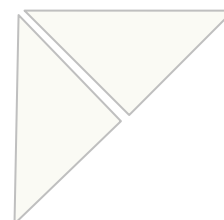
1. Sew one cream TIS-sides (Shape 14) to each long edge of one bright green kite center (Shape 15). Press seams open. Make 1 kite unit.
2. Sew one cream 5" finished side setting triangle to either side of kite unit as shown. Press seams open. (Be careful with these bias edges)
3. Make 1—10" finished pieced side setting triangle.



Corner Setting Triangles

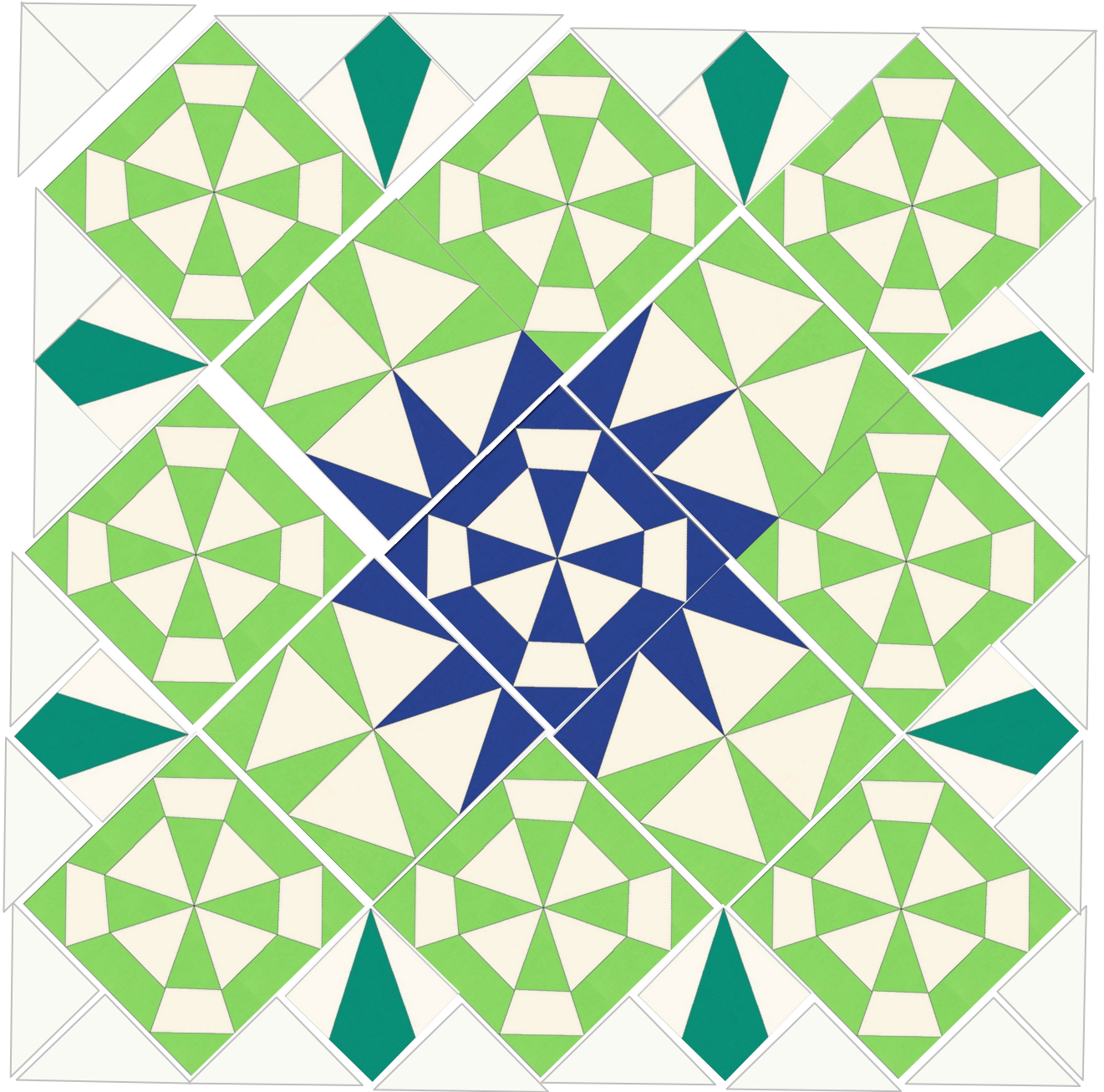
NOTE: Directions will be for one 10" finished pieced corner setting triangle. Make 4 pieced corner setting triangles.

1. Sew two cream 5" finished side setting triangles together along one of the short sides as shown. Press seams open. (be careful with these biased edges)
2. Make 1—10" finished pieced corner setting triangle.



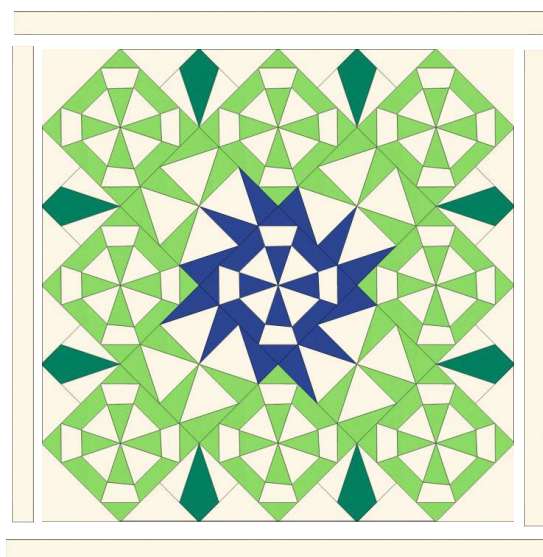
Assemble the Quilt Top

1. Lay out blocks in diagonal rows as shown in quilt diagram. Sew blocks together into rows. Press seams to one side.
2. Sew rows together. Press seams in opposite directions



Borders

1. Cut the vertical and horizontal borders according to the cutting instructions. Measure the height of the quilt and adjust the length of the vertical borders accordingly. Stitch the vertical borders to the sides of the quilt.
2. Measure the width of the quilt and adjust the length of the horizontal border accordingly. Stitch the horizontal borders to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press seam allowances toward the border.



Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
