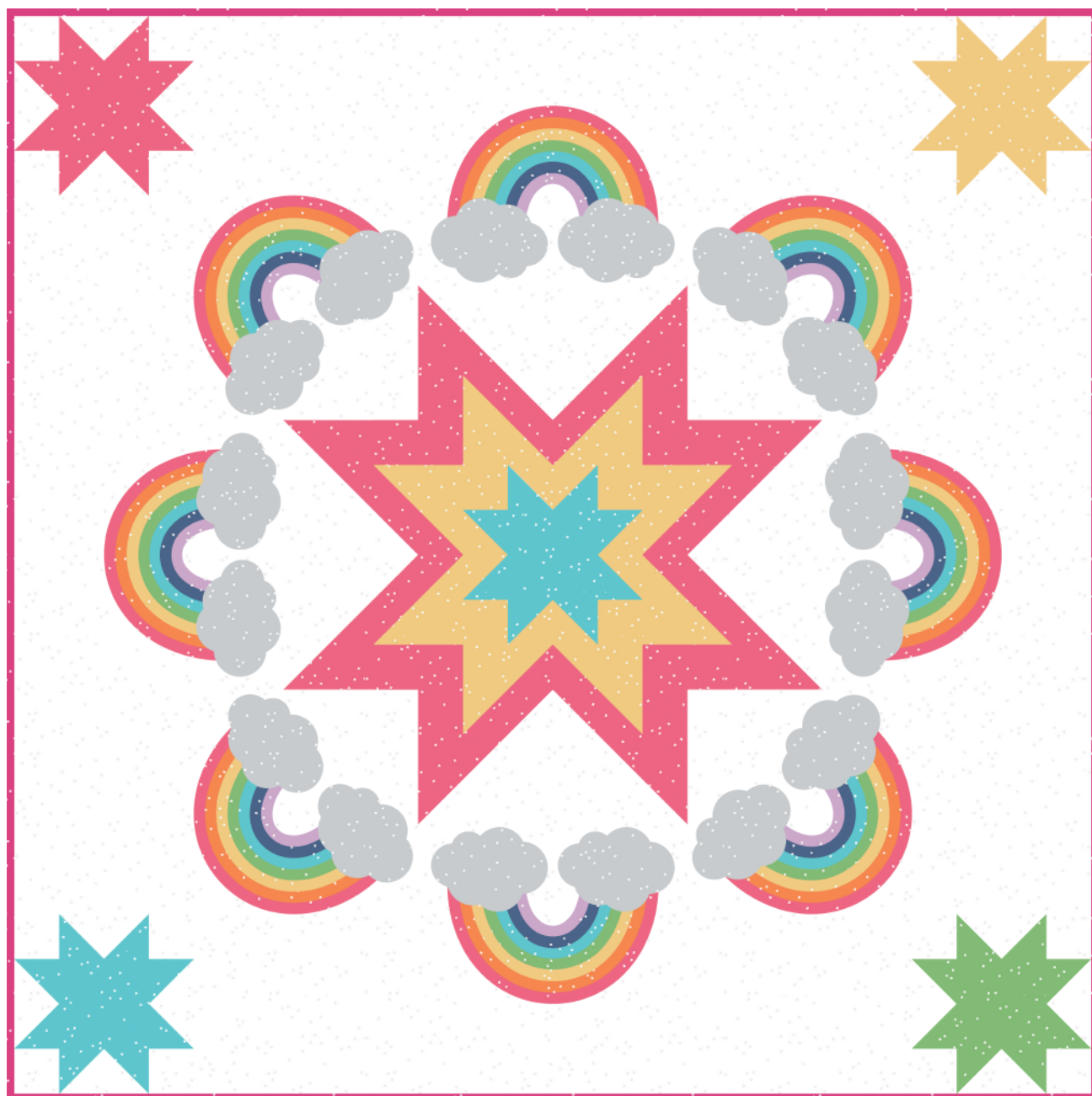


## GO! Radiant Rainbow Table Topper

## Dies Needed:

### GO! Rainbow (55688)

### GO! Qube Mix & Match 6" Block (55775)

- GO! Square 3½" (3" Finished) 55775, 55778, 55006 - Shape 1
- GO! Square 2" (1½" Finished) 55775, 55022 - Shape 2
- GO! Half Square Triangle 3" Finished 55775, 55778, 55009, 55456 - Shape 3
- GO! Quarter Square Triangle 3" Finished 55775 - Shape 4
- GO! Half Square Triangle 1½" Finished 55775, 55787 - Shape 5
- GO! Rectangle 2 x 3½" (1½" x 3" Finished) 55775 - Shape 8

### GO! Qube 6" Companion Set-Angles (55788)

- GO! Trapezoid 45° - 3" Finished 55788 - Shape 16

### GO! Strip Cutter-3 1/2" (3" Finished) (55032)

White	1 ½ yards
Pink	½ yard
Orange	¼ yard
Yellow	½ yard
Green	⅓ yard
Light Blue	½ yard
Dark Blue	¼ yard
Purple	¼ yard
Gray	¼ yard
Batting	40" x 40"
Backing	1¼ yards
Binding	⅓ yard
Fusible Web	18" x 4 yards

## Cutting Directions:

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
White	Rotary	Cut 2—9½" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Cut strips into four 9½" x 18½" rectangles.
White	GO! Square 2" (1½" Finished) - Shape 2	Cut 1—5" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Cut the strip at 22". Fanfold the 5" x 22" strip into 5 layers. Cut 20—1½" finished squares.
White	GO! Quarter Square Triangle 3" Finished Square - Shape 4	Using the remainder of the 5" strip, fanfold into 4 layers. Cut 16—3" finished quarter squares triangles (QST).
White	GO! Half Square Triangle 3" Finished - Shape 3	Cut 1—4¼" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Cut the strip in half. Fanfold one 4¼" strip into 4 layers. Cut 8—3" finished half square triangles (HST).
White	GO! Square 3½" (3" Finished) - Shape 1	Using the second half of the 4¼" strip, fanfold into 4 layers. Cut 4—3" finished squares.
White	GO! Half Square Triangle 1½" Finished - Shape 5	Cut 1—4½" x strip. Cut off 11" and fold in half to make a 4½" x 5½" rectangle. Cut 8—1½" finished half square triangles.
White	GO! Rectangle 2 x 3½" (1½" x 3" Finished) - Shape 8	Continue using the 4½" strip from the previous step, cut a 4½" x 9" rectangle. Fold in half. Cut 4—2 x 3½" rectangles.
White	GO! Strip Cutter-3 1/2" (3" Finished) (55032)	Using the remaining 4½" strip from the previous step, use the die to cut a 3 ½" strip. Sub cut with rotary cutter into two 3 ½" x 5" rectangles. Cut 1—7½" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. With the die, cut that strip into two, 3 ½" strips. With a rotary cutter, sub cut one 3 ½" strip into four 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles and two 3 ½" x 5". With a rotary cutter, sub cut the second 3 ½" strip into four 3 ½" x 9 ½" rectangles.
Pink	GO! Rainbow (55559)	Cut 1—7½" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Apply fusible web to the strip. Cut into 8—7½" x 4½" fabric rectangles. Cut out eight pink rainbows.
Pink	GO! Half Square Triangle 3" Finished Shape 3	Cut 1—4½" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Cut the strip in half. Fanfold one 4½" strip into 4 layers. Cut 8—3" finished HST.
Pink	GO! Trapezoid 45° - 3" Finished - Shape 16	Using the second half of the 4½" strip, fanfold into 4 layers. Cut 8—Trapezoid 45°

## Cutting Directions:

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
Pink	GO! Square 2" (1½" Finished) - Shape 2	Cut 1—4½" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Cut one 4½" x 4½" square. From the square cut 4—1½" finished squares.
Pink	GO! Square 3½" (3" Finished) - Shape 1	Using the 4½" strip from the previous step, cut one 4½" x 4½" square. Cut 1—3" finished square.
Pink	GO! Rectangle 2 x 3½" (1½" x 3" Finished) - Shape 8	Continue using the 4½" strip from the previous step, cut a 4½" x 9" rectangle. Fold in half to create a 4½" x 4½" square. Cut 4—2 x 3½" rectangles.
Orange	GO! Rainbow (55559)	Cut 1—7½" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Apply fusible web to the strip. Cut into 8—7½" x 4½" fabric rectangles. Cut out eight orange rainbows.
Yellow	GO! Rainbow (55559)	Cut 1—7½" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Apply fusible web to the strip. Cut into 8—7½" x 4½" fabric rectangles. Cut out eight yellow rainbows.
Yellow	GO! Half Square Triangle 3" Finished - Shape 3	Cut 1—5" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Cut a 5" x 17" rectangle. Fanfold into 4 layers. Cut 8—3" finished HST.
Yellow	GO! Square 2" (1½" Finished) - Shape 2	Continue using the 5" strip. Cut a 5" x 5" square. Cut 4—1½" finished squares.
Yellow	GO! Quarter Square Triangle 3" Finished Square - Shape 4	Continue using the 5" strip. Cut a 5" x 5" square. Cut 4—3" finished QST.
Yellow	GO! Half Square Triangle 1½" Finished - Shape 5	Using remainder of the 5" strip. Cut 8—1½" finished HST.
Green	GO! Rainbow (55559)	Cut 1—7½" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Apply fusible web to the strip. Cut into 8—7½" x 4½" fabric rectangles. Cut out eight green rainbows.
Green	GO! Square 3½" (3" Finished) - Shape 1	Cut 1—4½" x 4½" square. Cut 1—3" finished square.

## Cutting Directions:

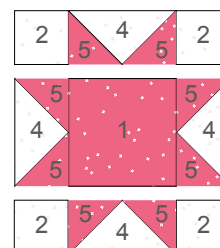
Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
Green	GO! Half Square Triangle 1½" Finished - Shape 5	Cut 1—3" x 11" rectangle. Fold in half to create a 3" x 5½" rectangle. Cut 8—1½" finished HST.
Light Blue	GO! Rainbow (55559)	Cut 1— 7½" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Apply fusible web to the strip. Cut into 8—7½" x 4½" fabric rectangles. Cut out eight light blue rainbows.
Light Blue	GO! Square 3½" (3" Finished) - Shape 1	Cut 1—4½" x 9" rectangle. Fold in half to create a 4½" x 4½" square. Cut 2—3" finished square.
Light Blue	GO! Half Square Triangle 1½" Finished - Shape 5	Cut 1—3" x 22" rectangle. Fanfold into 4 layers. Cut 16—1½" finished HST.
Dark Blue	GO! Rainbow (55559)	Cut 1— 7½" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Apply fusible web to the strip. Cut into 8—7½" x 4½" fabric rectangles. Cut out eight dark blue rainbows.
Purple	GO! Rainbow (55559)	Cut 1— 7½" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Apply fusible web to the strip. Cut into 8—7½" x 4½" fabric rectangles. Cut out eight purple rainbows.
Gray	GO! Rainbow (55559)	Cut 1— 9" x 26" strip. Apply fusible web to the strip. Cut into 2—4½" x 26" strips. Cut into 16—4½" x 3¼" rectangles. Cut 16 clouds.
Binding	GO! Strip Cutter 2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)	Cut 4 WOF strips and sew together to create binding.

## Sewing Directions:

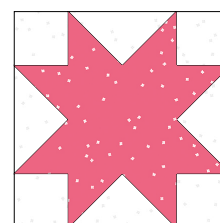
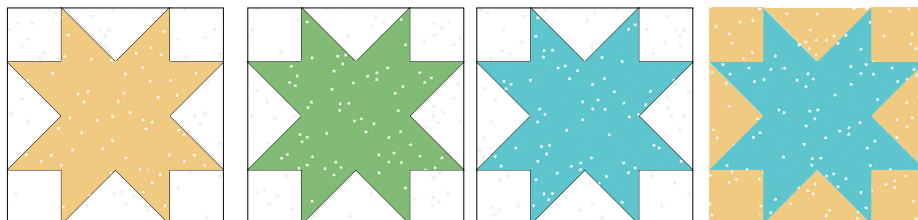
1. Sew two pink 1½" finished HST (Shape 5) to the white 3" finished QST (Shape 4) as shown in the diagram. Make a total of four flying geese units as shown. Press seams toward the pink fabric.



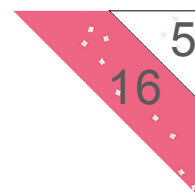
2. Lay out four white 2" squares (Shape 2), four flying geese units (Step 1), and one 3" finished square (Shape 1) to create the star block. Sew the top and bottom rows together. Press seams away from the flying geese units.



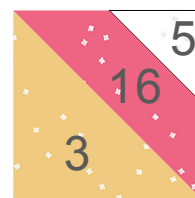
3. Sew the flying geese units to the center square first. Then sew the top and bottom rows together to form one block. Press seams toward the center row. Repeat for the following blocks.



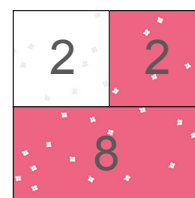
4. Sew one white 1½" finished HST (Shape 5) to short angle on one pink 3" finished trapezoid (Shape 16). Make 8 half trapezoid units. Press 4 units towards the white and 4 units toward the pink.



5. Sew one yellow 3" finished HST (Shape 3) to long edge on one half trapezoid unit. Make 8 HST units. Press 4 units toward the pink and 4 units toward the yellow.

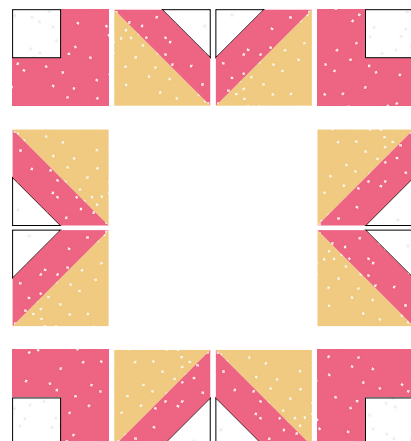


6. Sew one white 2" square (Shape 2) to one pink 2" square (Shape 2). Press toward the pink square. Sew one pink rectangle 2 x 3½" (Shape 8) to the rectangle created by shape 2. Press toward shape 8. Make 4 units.

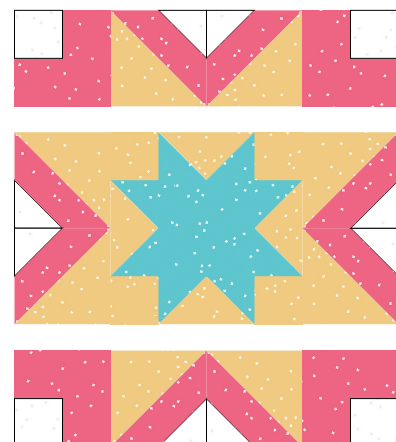




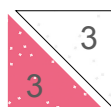
7. Arrange the HST and square units as shown in the diagram. Sew the top row together and press seams away from the HST. Sew the side HST units together, press seams to one side. Sew the bottom row together, press away from the HST.



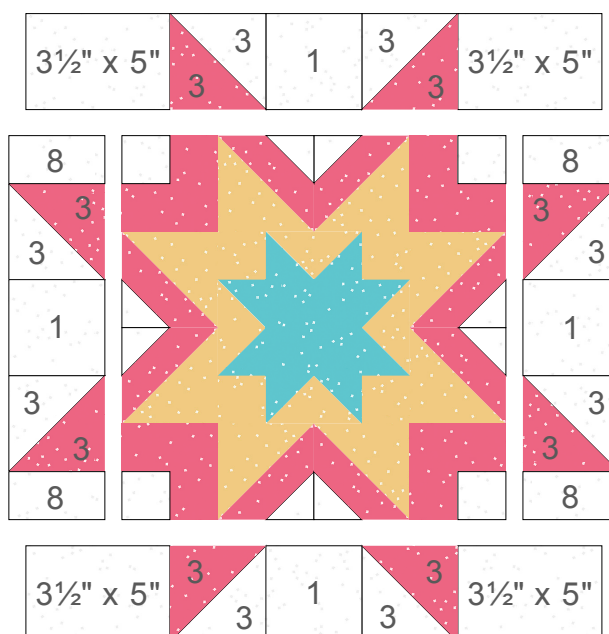
8. Lay out the center star as shown in the diagram. Sew the side units onto the star block first. Press away from the center. Sew the top and bottom rows to the center star block. Press the seams away from the center.



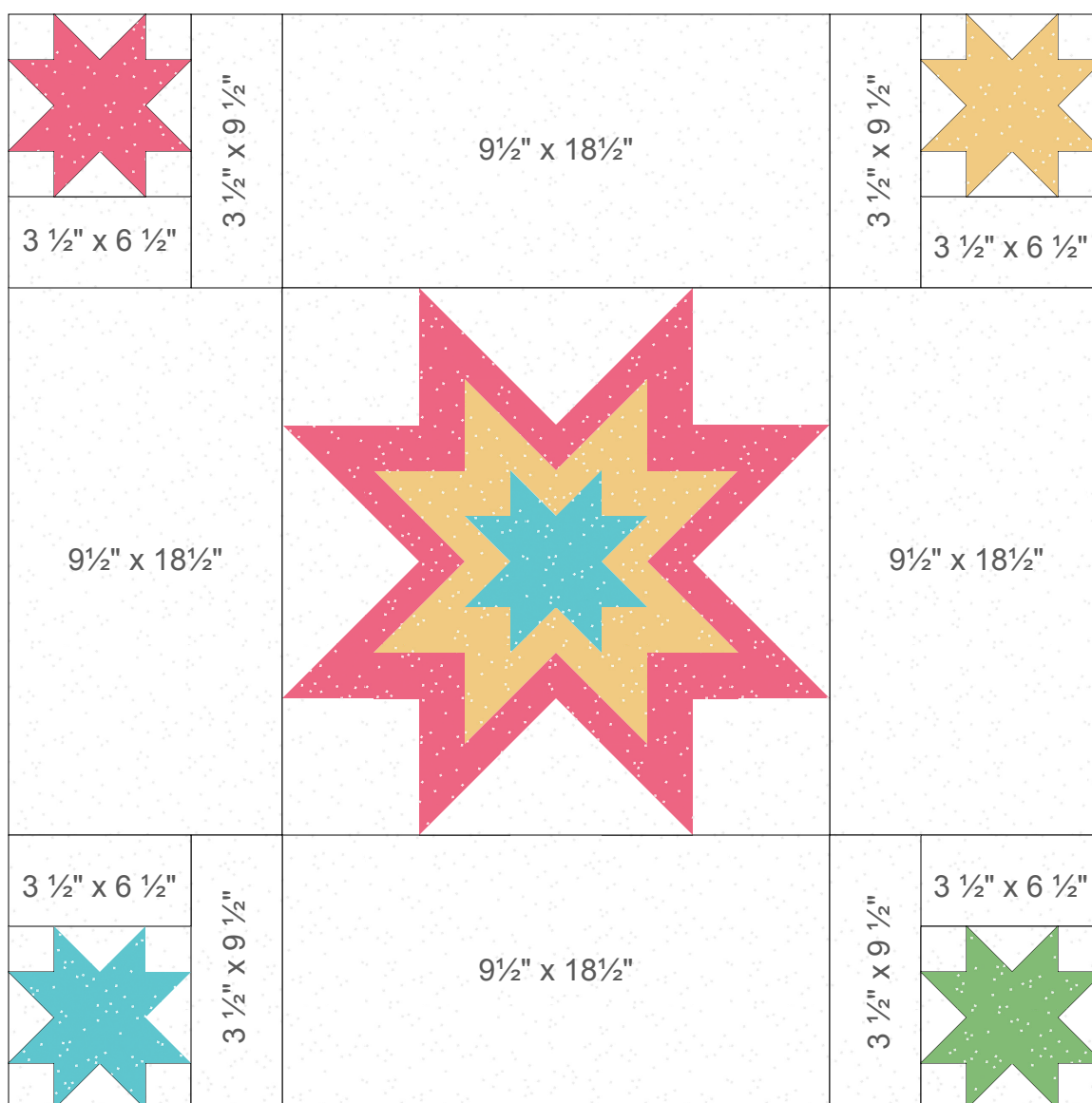
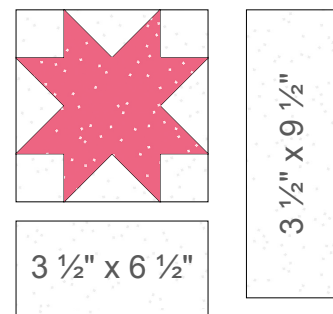
9. Sew one white 3" finished HST (Shape 3) to one pink 3" finished HST (Shape 3). Press towards the pink. Make 8 HST units.



10. Lay out the next set of blocks for the center star as shown in the diagram. Sew the top row together, press away from the HST. Sew the side columns together, press seams away from the HST. Sew the bottom row together, press away from the HST. Sew the side columns onto the star block first. Press away from the center. Sew the top and bottom rows to the center star block. Press the seams away from the center.

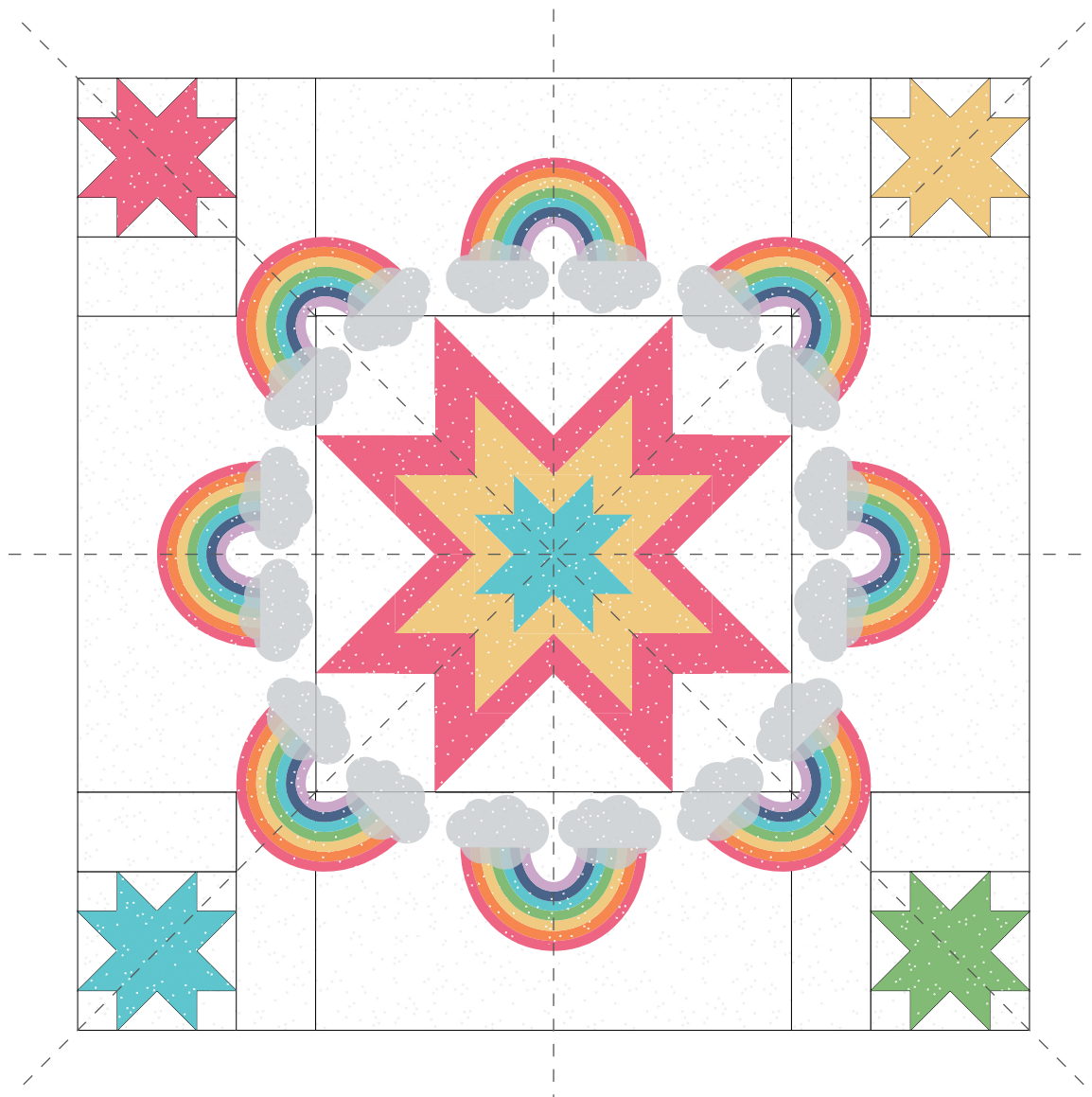


11. Lay out table topper. Sew a  $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$  rectangle to each of the corner star blocks. Press the seams away from the star. Following the diagram below, sew the  $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 9\frac{1}{2}"$  rectangle to the correct side of the corner star units. Press away from the star. Sew the  $9\frac{1}{2}" \times 18\frac{1}{2}"$  rectangles to each side of the center star block. Press away from the star. Sew the top row together and sew the bottom row together. Press towards the  $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 9\frac{1}{2}"$  rectangles. Sew the top row and the bottom row to the center star unit. Press away from the center star.





12. Using the diagram below, place the rainbows on the table topper.  
The clouds will be added after the rainbows are placed.



## Quilting and Finishing the GO! Radiant Rainbow Table Topper

1. Layer batting between the table topper top and backing fabric.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Attach binding strips, ensuring mitered corners for a clean finish.
