## Dies Needed:

GO! Flying Swallows (55931)

GO! Strip Cutter 2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)

## Fabric Requirements:

| Light (in nine colors)       | ¼ yard of each color |
| Medium (in nine colors)      | ⅛ yard of each color |
| Medium-dark (in nine colors) | ¼ yard of each color |
| Dark (in nine colors)        | ⅛ yard of each color |
| Batting                      | 42" x 42"            |
| Backing                      | 2½ yards             |
| Binding                      | ⅓ yard               |

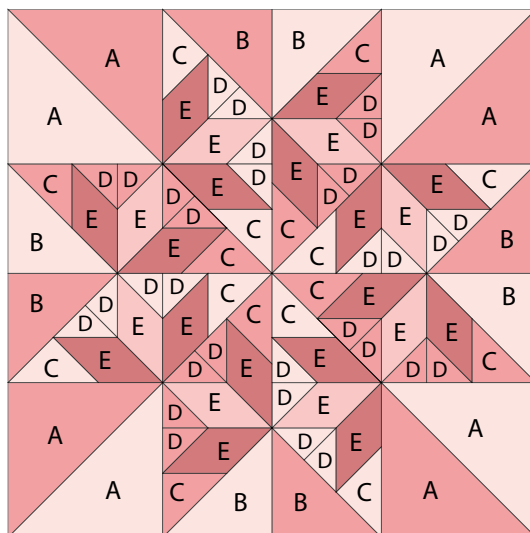

## Cutting Directions:

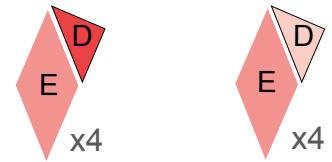
*Using starch before cutting fabric shapes is highly recommended. It adds stability to the material and helps you achieve more precise, accurate cuts and prevents the fabric from stretching, distorting, or fraying while you work.*

| Light Color<br>(for all nine colors)       | GO! Flying Swallows (55931)                         | Cut 1—5" x 10" strip. Fold in half, cut 4 - <b>A</b> pieces.<br>Cut 1—4" x 8" strip. Fold in half, cut 4 - <b>B</b> pieces.<br>Cut 1—3¾" x 8" strip. Fold in half, cut 8 - <b>C</b> pieces.<br>Cut 1—3½" x 14" strip. Fan fold into 4 layers, cut 16 - <b>D</b> pieces. |
| Medium Color<br>(for all nine colors)      | GO! Flying Swallows (55931)                         | Cut 1—2" x 24" strip. Fan fold into 4 layers, cut 8 - <b>E</b> pieces.                                                                                                                                                                                                  |
| Medium-dark Color<br>(for all nine colors) | GO! Flying Swallows (55931)                         | Cut 1—5" x 10" strip. Fold in half, cut 4 - <b>A</b> pieces.<br>Cut 1—4" x 8" strip. Fold in half, cut 4 - <b>B</b> pieces.<br>Cut 1—3¾" x 8" strip. Fold in half, cut 8 - <b>C</b> pieces.<br>Cut 1—3½" x 14" strip. Fan fold into 4 layers, cut 16 - <b>D</b> pieces. |
| Dark Color<br>(for all nine colors)        | GO! Flying Swallows (55931)                         | Cut 2—2" x 24" strip. Fan fold into 4 layers, cut 16 - <b>E</b> pieces.                                                                                                                                                                                                 |
| Binding                                    | GO! Strip Cutter 2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014) | Cut 4—2½" x WOF strips for binding. ## Sewing Directions:

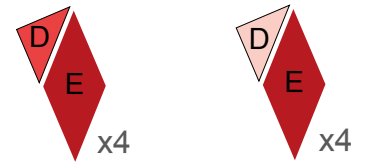
- Starting with the red block, sew 4 medium-dark **D** triangles to the right side of 4 medium **E** diamonds. Sew 4 light **D** triangles to the right side of 4 medium **E** diamonds. Press seams toward the **D** triangles.



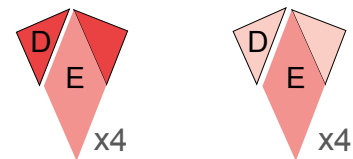
- Sew 4 medium-dark **D** triangles to the right side of 4 dark **E** diamonds. Sew 4 light **D** triangles to the right side of 4 dark **E** diamonds. Press seams toward the **D** triangles.



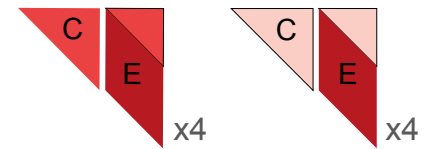
- Sew 4 medium-dark **D** triangles to the left side of 4 dark **E** diamonds. Sew 4 light **D** triangles to the left side of 4 dark **E** diamonds. Press seams toward the **D** triangles.



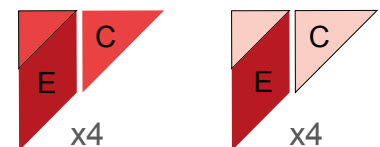
- Take the **E** units from step 1 and sew 4 medium-dark **D** triangles to the left side of 4 medium **E** units. Sew 4 light **D** triangles to the left side of 4 medium **E** units. Press seams toward the **D** triangles.



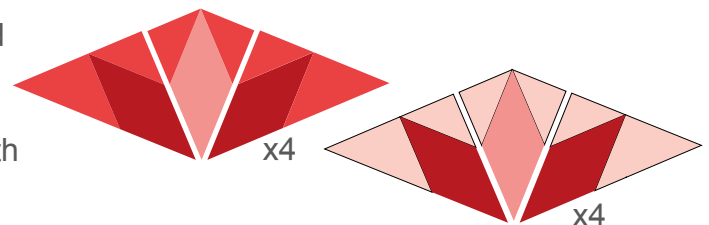
- Take the **E** units from step 2 and sew 4 medium-dark **C** triangles to the left side of 4 dark **E** units. Sew 4 light **C** triangles to the left side of 4 dark **E** units. Press seams toward the **C** triangles.



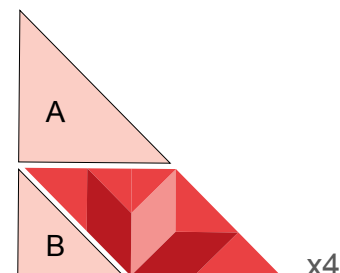
- Take the **E** units from step 3 and sew 4 medium-dark **C** triangles to the right side of 4 dark **E** units. Sew 4 light **C** triangles to the right side of 4 dark **E** units. Press seams toward the **C** triangles.



- Sew three **E** units with medium-dark background together like the diagram. Flip seams to nest if needed. Create 4 diamond units with the medium-dark background. Repeat for **E** units with the light background.

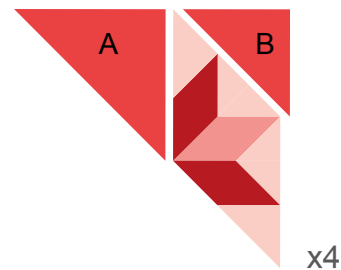


- Sew the light **B** triangles to the diamond units with medium-dark background. Press seams toward the **B** triangles. Repeat for all 4. Then sew the light **A** triangles to the diamond units. Press the seam toward the **A** triangles. Repeat for all 4. **These pieces are directional—be sure to follow the diagram carefully.**



## Sewing Directions:

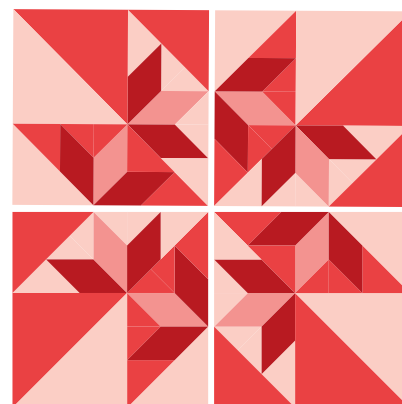
9. Sew the medium-dark **B** triangles to the diamond units with light background. Press seams toward the **B** triangles. Repeat for all 4. Then sew the medium-dark **A** triangles to the diamond units. Press the seam toward the **A** triangles. Repeat for all 4. **These pieces are directional—be sure to follow the diagram carefully.**



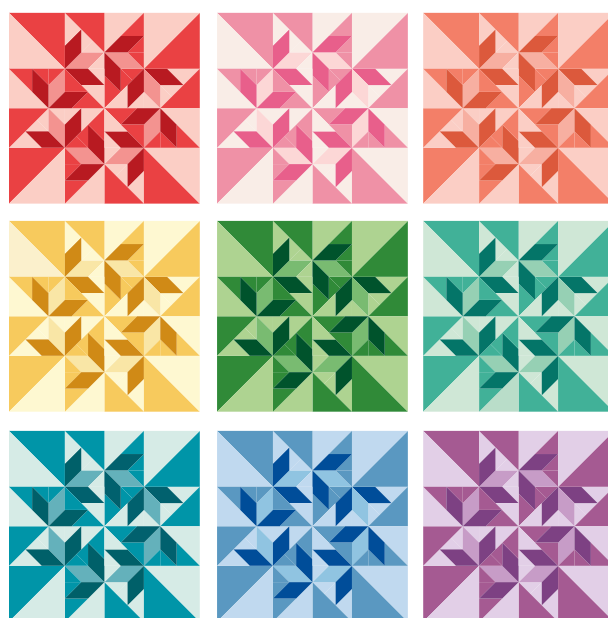
10. Sew the light and dark triangle units together in pairs to form a block as shown in the diagram. Press the seams to the side. Repeat for all 4.



11. Sew the blocks together in a four-patch as shown in the diagram. Repeat steps 1-11 for all nine colors.



12. Lay out and sew all of the finished blocks together in a nine-patch as shown in the diagram.



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### Quilting & Finishing:

1. Layer batting between the table topper and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering the corners.
