- GO! Quarter Square Triangle-4 1/2" Finished Square (55718) (Shape 4)
- GO! Half Square Triangle-2 1/4" Finished Square (55719) (Shape 5)

## Cutting Directions:

### WOF – Width of Fabric

Use a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

For shapes E, F & G on the New York Beauty die, I like to sift through my scraps after cutting the larger shapes and use scraps to cut out the smaller ones. Directions call for cutting of strips, but you can conserve fabric by using up your scraps.

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
Cream	GO! New York Beauty-9" Finished (55932)	<p>Cut 1 – 10 " x WOF strip. Fan fold over Shapes C, E &amp; F.</p> <p>Cut 4 each of shapes C, E &amp; F.</p> <p>Cut 1 – 10 " x WOF strip. Fan fold over shape B. Cut 4 shape B.</p> <p>Cut a strip 4" x WOF. Cut in half to 4" x 20". Fan fold strips and cut a total of 12 shape E. Total of 16 E are needed (4 were cut in previous step).</p> <p>Cut 3 strips 4" x WOF. Fan fold and cut 28 shape F. Total of 32 shape F are needed (4 were cut in previous step.)</p>
Cream	GO! Triangles in Square-Sides-4 1/2" Finished Square (55756) (Shape 14)	<p>Cut 4 – 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Cut strips into 22-1/2" lengths. (This will give you 6 layers.) Fan fold and cut 32 pairs of triangles.</p>
Cream	GO! Quarter Square Triangle-4 1/2" Finished Square (55718) (Shape 4)	<p>Cut 5 – 3-1/4" x WOF strips. Cut your strips down to 33" long. (This will give you 6 layers.) Fan fold and cut 32 triangles.</p>
Cream	GO! Square-2 3/4" (2 1/4" Finished) (55717) (Shape 2)	<p>Cut 1 – 3-1/4" x 15" strip. Fan fold and cut 4 squares.</p>
Cream	GO! Half Square Triangle-2 1/4" Finished Square (55719) (Shape 5)	<p>Fan fold the remainder of the 5-1/2" strip from the #1 block from previous step and cut out 4 pairs of triangles.</p>
Teal	GO! New York Beauty-9" Finished (55932)	<p>Cut 1 – 10 " x WOF strip. Fan fold and place over Shape C. Cut 4 of shape C.</p> <p>Cut 3 - 4" x WOF strip. Cut strips to 15" lengths. (This will give you 6 layers.) Fan fold and cut 40 Shape G.</p>

Teal	GO! Half Square Triangle-2 1/4" Finished Square (55719) (Shape 5)	Cut 1 – 3-1/4" x 16" strip. Fan fold and cut out 4 pairs of triangles.
Teal	GO! Half Square Triangle-1 1/8" Finished Square (55769) (Shape 12.1)	Cut 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle. (Or use up scraps.) Place over blades and cut 4 tiny half square triangles.
Teal	GO! Strip Cutter 2 1/2" (2" Finished) 3 strip (55017 or 55014)	Cut 2 – 8" x WOF strips. Fold and place over die blades. Cut 6 strips 2-1/2" x WOF.
Magenta	GO! New York Beauty-9" Finished (55932)	Cut 2 – 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Fan fold and cut 8 Shape D.
Magenta	GO! Triangles in Square-Center-4 1/2" Finished Square (55755) (Shape 13)	Cut 5 – 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Cut strips down to 33". (This will give you 6 layers). Fan fold and cut 32 triangles.
Magenta	GO! Half Square Triangle-2 1/4" Finished Square (55719) (Shape 5)	Cut 4 – 3-1/4" x WOF strips. Cut strips down to 24". (This will give you 6 layers of fabric when folded). Fan fold and cut 32 pairs of triangles.
Green	GO! New York Beauty-9" Finished (55932)	Cut 1 - 4" x WOF strip. Fan fold and cut 8 Shape A.
Green	GO! Half Square Triangle-2 1/4" Finished Square (55719) (Shape 5)	Cut 4 – 3-1/4" x WOF strips. Cut strips down to 24". (This will give you 6 layers of fabric when folded). Fan fold and cut 32 pairs of triangles.
Green	GO! Quarter Square Triangle-4 1/2" Finished Square (55718) (Shape 4)	Cut 5 – 3-1/4" x WOF strips. Cut your strips down to 33" long. (This will give you 6 layers.) Fan fold and cut 32 triangles.
Green	GO! Bowtie-4 1/2" Finished Square (55768) (Shape 11.1)	Cut 3-1/4" x 12" rectangle. Fold in half and cut 4 bowtie units.

Color scraps	GO! Scrappy Binding-2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55646)	Cut 2 – 5-1/2" x 21-1/4" strip of each color (teal, magenta and green). Place on die blades and cut strips.
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## Make blocks:

We recommend laying out all cut pieces and reading through assembly instructions before starting sewing. Use a 1/4" seam allowance.

### Center Block – Make 4

1. Stitch 11.1 and 12.1 together. Press to the teal. Make 4




units.

2. Stitch 8 sets of teal and cream half square units together. Press to the teal.




3. Join 1 #11.1/12.1 unit, two half square triangle units, and one #2 square into a block, following the diagram.



Repeat to make 4 blocks.



4. Lay out 4 blocks. Stitch units together. Set aside.




### Flying Geese – cream with green – Make 32






5. Start with a cream triangle #4. Stitch a green triangle #5 to one side. Press to the darker fabric.
6. Stitch a green triangle to the other side. Press to the darker fabric. Set aside.

### Flying Geese – green with magenta – Make 32











7. Start with a green triangle #4. Stitch a magenta triangle #5 to one side. Press to the darker fabric.
- Stitch a magenta triangle to the other side. Press to the darker fabric. Set aside.

### Triangles in a Square – Make 32



- Start with a magenta triangle #13. Stitch a cream triangle #14 to one side. Press to the darker fabric.
- Stitch a cream triangle #14 to the other side. Press to the darker fabric. Set aside.


## Border Blocks – Make 16




- Use 2 Triangles in a square, 2 green flying geese, and 2 cream flying geese blocks for each border block.
- Sew 4 patches together as shown in diagram. Set aside.

## New York Beauty – Teal corner – Make 4



- Sew 5 shape G and 4 shape F together as shown. Press seams open.




8. Sew 1 shape E facing left and 1 shape E facing right to the ends of G/F unit as shown. Press seams open.




- With right sides together and matching notches, align raw edge of shape D's small curved edge to raw edge of shape A's curved edge. Add pins and ease fabric as needed, to ensure a smooth seam. Sew shape D and A together using a consistent  $\frac{1}{4}$ ' seam allowance. Press seam towards shape A.
- Using the same process as step 3, with right sides together and matching notches, align E/F/G unit to A/D unit as shown. Add pins and ease fabric as needed to ensure a smooth seam. Sew together using a consistent  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press seam towards A/D unit.




- Using the same process as previous steps, with right sides together and matching notches, align green shape B to E/F/G unit as shown. Add pins and ease fabric as needed to ensure a smooth seam. Sew together using a consistent  $\frac{3}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press seam towards shape B.



- Using the same process as previous steps, with right sides together and matching notches, align cream shape C to shape B as shown. Add pins and ease fabric as needed to ensure a smooth seam. Sew together using a consistent  $\frac{3}{4}$ \* seam allowance. Press seam towards shape C.




13. Block should measure 9-1/2" x 9-1/2".




**New York Beauty – Cream corner – Make 4**


- Sew 5 shape G and 4 shape F together as shown. Press seams open.




14. Sew 1 shape E facing left and 1 shape E facing right to the ends of G/F unit as shown. Press seams open.




15. With right sides together and matching notches, align raw edge of shape D's small curved edge to raw edge of shape A's curved edge. Add pins and ease fabric as needed, to ensure a smooth seam. Sew shape D and A together using a consistent 1/4" seam allowance. Press seam towards shape A.




16. Using the same process as step 3, with right sides together and matching notches, align E/F/G unit to A/D unit as shown. Add pins and ease fabric as needed to ensure a smooth seam. Sew together using a consistent  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press seam towards A/D unit.



17. Using the same process as previous steps, with right sides together and matching notches, align green shape B to E/F/G unit as shown. Add pins and ease fabric as needed to ensure a smooth seam. Sew together using a consistent  $\frac{3}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press seam towards shape B.




18. Using the same process as previous steps, with right sides together and matching notches, align cream shape C to shape B as shown. Add pins and ease fabric as needed to ensure a smooth seam. Sew together using a consistent  $\frac{3}{4}$ \* seam allowance. Press seam towards shape C.



19. Block should measure 9-1/2" x 9-1/2".

### Assemble quilt



20. Assemble rows together, following diagram. Alternate pressing direction of block seams to facilitate nesting seams.

21. Sew rows together. Press long seams down. Measure your quilt center top to bottom.

22. Sew 2 pairs of long teal strips together. Press seam to one side. Cut your strips to the length of your quilt center. Attach to the sides of your quilt. Press. Measure your quilt center side to side.
23. Sew remaining 2 pairs of long teal strips together. Press seam to one side. Cut your strips to the length of your quilt center. Attach to the side of your quilt. Press.
24. Prepare binding by attaching strips together.

### **Layer and quilt as desired:**

25. Layer your quilt top, batting and backing.
26. Sample quilt was quilted with lines of stitching echoing the seam allowances.
27. Square up and bind your quilt.

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
