Students will piece a 42" x 42" quilt top. Book a 1-hr appointment with Jan before class starts to choose fabrics and go over the tools used.

Your serger can do more than finish edges! Check out some fabulous techniques using Rolled Hems, Decorative Flatlocking, Gathering, Pintucks, and Zipper Insertion. Learn how to use differential feed for smooth, pucker free seams on knits and lightweight fabrics. Discover which stitches are best for constructing seams and which are better for finishing edges. We will construct a Pillow Top or Tote to show off all the wonderful things your serger can do.

For this class you will need your serger in good working order with new needles inserted. A basic knowledge of your serger ie: basic threading & how to run a seam is required.
