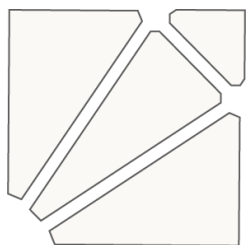

Fabric Used: Timeless Treasures Watermelon Fat Quarters

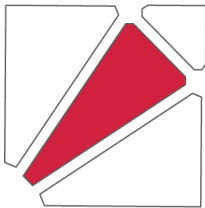
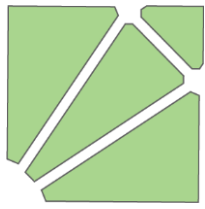


GO!® Dies Used, Number of Shapes to Cut & Fabric Requirements

NOTE: Cutting instructions are given for fabric as yardage, however, the equivalent as fat quarters is also given in the fabric requirements chart below

Light		GO! Crossed Canoes (55181)	Cut 6—6-1/4" x WOF. Sub cut into 32 complete crossed canoe units.	Yardage included below.

Cutting Instructions

Fabric Color	Shapes	GO! Dies Used	Number of Shapes to Cut	Fabric Required
Red		GO! Crossed Canoes (55181)	Cut 3—6-1/4" x WOF. Sub cut into 32—3" x 6-1/4" rectangles. Place over center canoe shape and cut.	Yardage included below.
Green		GO! Crossed Canoes (55181)	Cut 6—6-1/4" x WOF. Sub cut into 32 crossed canoe units. Set aside the green canoe shapes for another project--they will not be used in this quilt.	Yardage included below.
Green	Border and Binding	GO! Strip Cutter-2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)	Cut 10—2-1/2" x WOF strips for border and binding. Sub cut borders as follows: Vertical Borders: Cut 2—2-1/2" x 46-1/2", Cut 2—2-1/2" x 50-1/2".	Yardage included below.
Red	Squares for Setting Blocks		Cut 1—2-1/2" x WOF. Sub cut into 13—2-1/2" (2" Finished) squares.	Yardage included below.
Green	Squares for Setting Blocks		Cut 1—2-1/2" x WOF. Sub cut into 12—2-1/2" (2" Finished) squares.	Yardage included below.
Light	Rectangles for Setting Blocks		Cut 3—9-1/2" x WOF. Sub cut into 40—2-1/2" x 9-1/2" (2" x 9" Finished) rectangles.	Yardage included below.

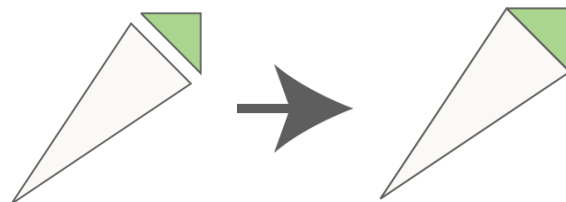

Green	2 yards	8 Assorted Fat Quarters
Red	3/4 yard	3 Assorted Fat Quarters

Additional Fabrics Needed:

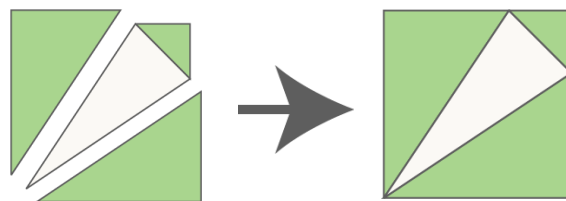
- Backing—58" x 58"
- Batting—58" x 58"

Sewing Directions (Make 16 Crossed Canoe Blocks)

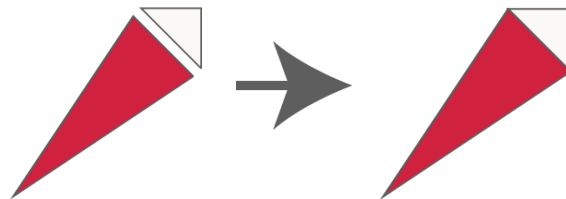
1. Lay out and sew a white canoe to a green half square triangle as shown. Press seam toward the half square triangle.



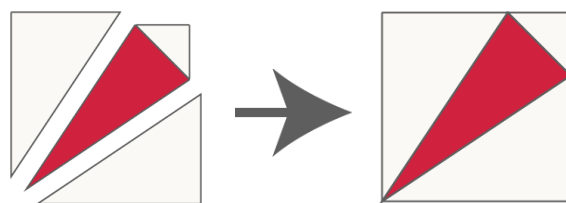
2. Lay out, pin and sew a green triangle corner to each side of the canoe unit as shown. Press seams toward the side triangle corners. Make a total of 32 green canoe-triangle units.



3. Lay out and sew a red canoe to a white half square triangle as shown. Press seam toward the half square triangle.

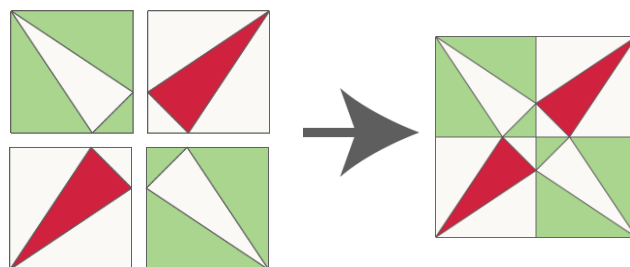


4. Lay out, pin and sew a light triangle corner to each side of the red canoe unit as shown. Press seams toward the triangle corners. Make a total of 32 red and light canoe-triangle units shown.



5. Lay out, pin and sew a green Canoe unit to a red canoe unit to make a half Crossed Canoe block. Press seams open.

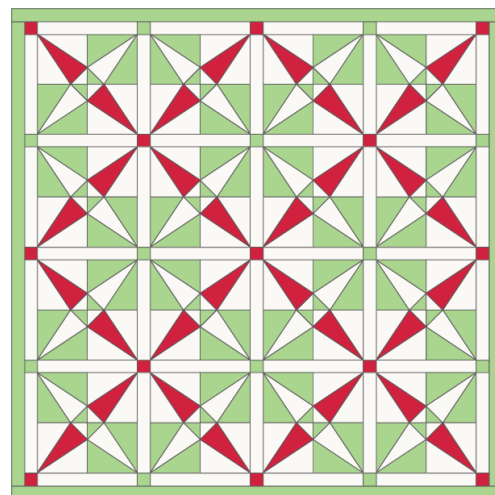
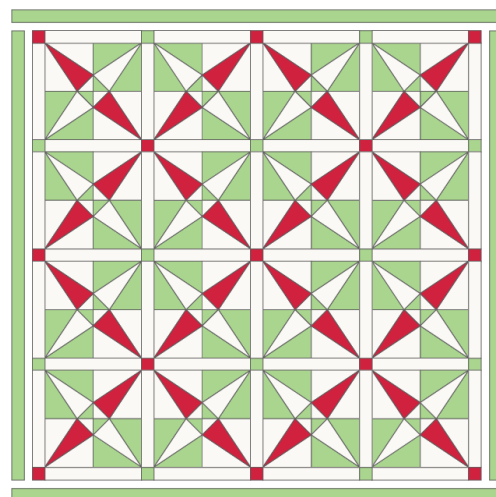
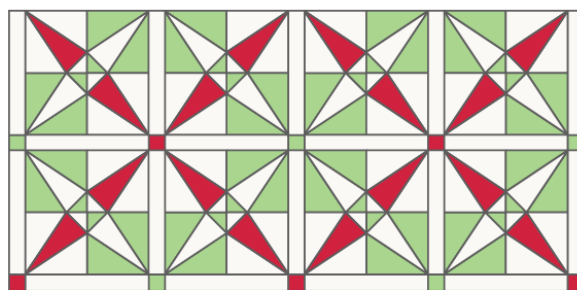
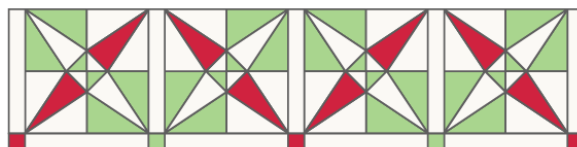
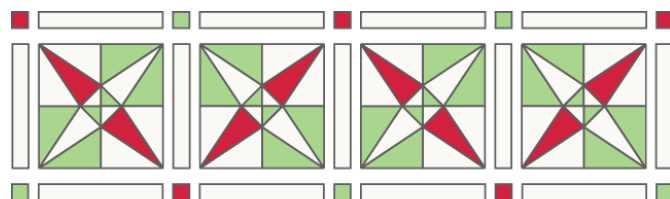
6. Lay out, pin and sew two green and red half blocks together to make a complete Crossed Canoe block as shown. Press seams open between canoe units.



Make 16 Crossed Canoe blocks.

Assemble the Quilt Top and Border:

1. Lay out blocks as shown with vertical rectangles between blocks.
2. Stitch the blocks together into rows of four blocks bordered by five rectangles as shown. Note the rotation of the blocks in Row 1 and in Row 2.
3. Sew the horizontal rectangles into rows with the green and red squares in the order shown.
4. Stitch the rows of blocks together with the horizontal rectangles and squares bordering the rows to complete the top.
5. Cut the vertical and horizontal outer borders according to the cutting instructions.
6. Stitch the vertical border to the right and left sides of the quilt.
7. Stitch the horizontal border to the top and bottom of the quilt.
8. Press seam allowances toward the borders.



Quilting and Finishing:

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add green binding, mitering corners.

Color Variation:

The following color variation was done using a Fat Quarter pack from the Timeless Treasures Batik Fireside Collection. It requires 9-11 Fat Quarters of varying medium-dark fat quarters and yardage of the light background fabric. Solid yardage can be used for the border and binding.
