Dies Needed:

GO! Prairie Star-14" Finished (55540)

Fabric Requirements:

Fabric Color	Total Yardage
Dark Diamonds	1/4 yard
Medium Diamonds	1/2 yard
Light Diamonds	1/2 yard
Background	3/4 yard





Cutting Directions:

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
Dark Diamonds	Prairie Star-14" Finished (55540)	Cut 3 – 2-1/4" strips. Fan-fold to fit on the diamond shapes and sub-cut into 48 dark diamonds.
Medium Diamonds	Prairie Star-14" Finished (55540)	Cut 6 – 2-1/4" strips. Fan-fold to fit on the diamond shapes and sub-cut into 48 dark diamonds.
Light Diamonds	Prairie Star-14" Finished (55540)	Cut 5 – 2-1/4" strips. Fan-fold to fit on the diamond shapes and sub-cut into 48 dark diamonds.
Background	Prairie Star-14" Finished (55540)	Cut 3 – 8" strips. Fan-fold to fit on the larger square and triangle, and sub-cut 20 triangles and 2 squares.






Making the Topper:


- Collect your diamond shapes. Stitch into three rows. Press seams open.
- 2. Stitch the three rows together to make a larger pieced diamond. Press the seams open. Make 24 of these pieced diamonds.



- Stitch the pieced diamonds into pairs. Press open.
- Stitch the pieced diamond pairs into sets of 4. Press open.



Attach the background triangles and background squares as shown to make the units. You will need to stitch y-seams to attach these pieces.
















6. Stitch the units together to make the table topper.



7. Quilt and bind as desired.
