- GO! Square-6-1/2" (6" Finished) (Shape 1)
- GO! Half Square Triangle-6" Finished Square (Shape 3)
- GO! Quarter Square Triangle-6" Finished Square (Shape 4)
- GO! Half Square Triangle-3" Finished Square (Shape 5)
- GO! Square on Point-4-3/4" (4-1/4" Finished) (Shape 6)
- GO! Rectangle-3-1/2" x 6-1/2" (3" x 6" Finished) (Shape 8)

Additional Dies Needed

- GO! Strip Cutter-2 1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)
- GO! Farm Animals Medley (55215)

Medium Blue	3/4 yards

Red	1/4 yard or fat quarter
Gray	5" square
White	1/4 yard or fat quarter
Fabric for Applique	Small scraps of assorted colors
Batting	48" x 48"
Backing	48" x 48"
Fusible	18" x 23"





Cutting Directions


Fabric Color	GO! Dies Used	Number of Shapes to Cut
Light Blue	GO! Square-6-1/2" (6" Finished) (Shape 1)	Cut 2—7" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 7" widths. Sub cut into 8—6" finished squares.
	GO! Half Square Triangle- 6" Finished Square (Shape 3)	Cut 1—7-1/4" x 15" strip. Fanfold into 7-1/4" widths. Sub cut into 4—6" finished half square triangles.
	GO! Quarter Square Triangle-6" Finished Square (Shape 4)	Cut 1—7-3/4" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 7-3/4" widths. Sub cut into 16—6" finished quarter square triangles.
	GO! Half Square Triangle- 3" Finished Square (Shape 5)	Cut 1—4-3/4" x 16" strip. Fanfold into 4" widths. Sub cut into 8—3" finished half square triangles.
	GO! Square on Point-4-3/4" (4-1/4" Finished) (Shape 6)	Cut 1—5-1/4" x 16" strip. Fanfold into 5-1/4" widths. Sub cut into 3—6" finished squares on point.
	GO! Rectangle-3-1/2" x 6" (3" x 6" Finished (Shape 8)	Cut 1—7" x 15" strip. Fanfold into 7-1/2" widths. Sub cut into 4—3" x 6" finished rectangles.
Medium Blue	GO! Square-6-1/2" (6" Finished) (Shape 1)	Cut 1—7" x 14" strip. Fanfold into 7" widths. Sub cut into 2—6" finished squares.
	GO! Half Square Triangle- 6" Finished Square (Shape 3)	Cut 1—7-1/4" x 7-1/4" square. Sub cut into 2—6" finished half square triangles.
	GO! Quarter Square Triangle-6" Finished Square (Shape 4)	Cut 2—7-3/4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 7-3/4" widths. Sub cut into 16—6" finished quarter square triangles.
	GO! Half Square Triangle- 3" Finished Square (Shape 5)	Cut 1—4-3/4" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 4" widths. Sub cut into 12—3" finished half square triangles.
Dark Blue	GO! Half Square Triangle- 6" Finished Square (Shape 3)	Cut 1—7-1/4" x 7-1/4" square. Sub cut into 2—6" finished half square triangles.
	GO! Quarter Square Triangle-6" Finished Square (Shape 4)	Cut 1—7-3/4" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 7-3/4" widths. Sub cut into 16—6" finished quarter square triangles.
	GO! Half Square Triangle- 3" Finished Square (Shape 5)	Cut 1—4-3/4" x 8" strip. Fanfold into 4" widths. Sub cut into 4—3" finished half square triangles.
	Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)	Cut 4—2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub cut 2—2-1/2" x 36-1/2" vertical borders. Sub cut 2—2-1/2" x 40-1/2" horizontal borders.





	Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)	Cut 5—2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.	
Dark Gray for Barn Roof	GO! Half Square Triangle- 3" Finished Square (Shape 5)	Cut 1—4-3/4" x 4" rectangle. Sub cut into 2—3" finished half square triangles.	
Red for Barn Roof	GO! Half Square Triangle- 3" Finished Square (Shape 5)	Cut 1—4-3/4" x 4" rectangle. Sub cut into 2—3" finished half square triangles.

Light Blue	A—Cut 2 rectangles 3-1/2" x 4-1/2".		
Red	C—Cut 1 rectangle 1-1/2" x 12-1/2"		
	D—Cut 4 rectangles 1-1/2" x 4-1/2"		
	E—Cut 5 rectangles 1-1/2" x 2-1/2"		
	H—Cut 2 rectangles 2-1/2" x 4-1/2"		
	F—Cut 1 square 4-1/2" x 4-1/2"		
	G—Cut 2 squares 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"		
	I—Cut 1 rectangle 2-1/2" x 3-1/2"

Sewing Directions

Press all seams open and use 1/4" seams, unless otherwise indicated.

BROKEN DISHES BLOCK

NOTE: Directions will be for one 12" finished block. Make ONE block.

1. Sew one light blue and one medium blue 3" finished half square triangle (HST) (Shape 3) together as shown. Press seams open. Make 2 HST units.




2. Sew one light blue and one dark blue 3" finished HST (Shape 3) together as shown. Press seams open. Make 2 HST units.




3. Sew one medium blue HST unit and one dark blue HST unit together as shown. Press seams open. Make 2 half block units.



4. Arrange and sew the half block units as shown. Press seams open.











PROPELLER VARIATION BLOCK

NOTE: Directions will be for one 12" finished block. Make FOUR blocks.

1. Sew one medium blue 6" finished quarter square triangle (QST) (Shape 4) to both sides of a light blue 6" finished square (Shape 1) as shown. Press seams open. Make 1 partial square unit.



2. Sew one medium blue 6" finished QST (Shape 4) to the remaining two sides of the light blue 6" finished square (Shape 1) as shown. Press seams open. Make 1 completed square.




3. Sew one light and one dark blue QST (Shape 4) together along the short sides of the triangles as shown. Make 2 QST subunits in the configuration shown. These are a mirror image of the subunits in Step 4.



4. Sew one light and one dark blue QST (Shape 4) together along the short sides of the triangles as shown. Make 2 QST subunits in the configuration shown. These are a mirror image of the subunits in Step 3.



- 5. Sew one QST subunit from Step 3 and one QST subunit from Step 4 to opposite sides of the square unit from Step 2 as shown. Press seams open.
- 6. Sew one QST subunit from Step 3 and one QST subunit from Step 4 to the opposite sides of the partial block from Step 5 as shown. Press seams open. This completes one block.









SHOOFLY VARIATION

NOTE: Directions will be for one 12" finished block. Make ONE block.

1. Sew one medium blue 3" finished half square triangle (HST) (Shape 5) to either side of a 6" finished square on point (SOP) (Shape 6) as shown. Press seams open. Make 1 partial SOP units.









3. Sew one dark blue HST (Shape 5) and one light blue HST (Shape 5) together as shown. Press seams open. Make 4 HST units.






4. Sew two HST units from Step 3 with one 3" x 6" finished rectangle (Shape 8) as shown. Press seams open. Make 2 HST/rectangle units.






5. Sew two Shape 8 rectangles to either side of the SOP unit as shown. Press seams open. Make one rectangle/SOP unit.



6. Sew the HST/rectangle units and the rectangle SOP units together as shown to make one complete block. Press seams open.










FOUR PATCH BLOCK

NOTE: Directions will be for one 12" finished block. Make ONE block.

1. Sew one light blue and one medium blue 6" finished square (Shape 1) together as shown. Press seams open. Make 2 rectangle units.




2. Sew the two rectangle units together as shown. Press seams open. This makes one complete four patch block.




FOUR PATCH VARIATION BLOCK

NOTE: Directions will be for one 12" finished block. Make ONE block.


1. Sew one medium blue 3" finished half square triangle (HST) (Shape 5) to either side of a 6" finished square on point (SOP) (Shape 6) as shown. Press seams open. Make 2 partial SOP units.



2. Sew one medium blue 3" finished HST (Shape 5) to either side of the 6" SOP as shown. Press seams open. Make 2 complete SOP unit.





3. Sew one SOP unit and one Shape 1 light blue square together as shown. Press seams open. Make two SOP-Shape 1 rectangle units.





4. Sew the SOP-Shape 1 rectangle units together as shown to make one complete Four Patch Variation block.











BARN BLOCK

NOTE: Directions will be for one 12" finished block. Make ONE block.

- 1. Sew one gray 3" finished half square triangle (HST) (Shape 5) and one light blue HST (Shape 5) together. Press seams open. Make 2 gray HST units.
- 2. Sew the two gray HST units together as shown to make the barn roof. Press seams open.
- 3. Sew a red E and a white I together as shown to make an El subunit. Press seams open.
- 4. Sew a red H to the sides of the red and white El subunit as shown. Press seams open. Make one EHI unit.
- 5. Sew the roof HST unit to the EHI unit. Press seams open.
- 6. Sew one red 3" finished half square triangle (HST) (Shape 5) and one light blue HST (Shape 5) together. Press seams open. Make 2 red HST units.
- 7. Sew a finished red HST to the light blue A as shown. Make 2 red HST—A units with the triangles stitched in the direction shown. Press seams open.
- 8. Sew the red HST—A units and the barn roof—EHI unit together as shown to make the upper barn unit. Press seams open.































9. Sew the red C to the lower edge of the upper barn unit as shown. Press seams open.





10. Sew a red E to both sides of a white G to make an EGE subunit. Press seams open. Make 2 EGE subunits.




11. Sew a red D to both sides of an EGE subunit to make a DEGED unit. Press seams open. Make two DEGED units.




12. Sew a DEGED unit to both sides of a white F square to complete the lower barn unit.



13. Sew the upper barn unit to the lower barn unit as shown. Make one barn block.





MACHINE EMBROIDERY

NOTE: Complete embroidery directions will be found in the separate embroidery designs.


- 1. For placement of Farm Animals, cut the shape from fabric or paper and use your embroidery software/machine to determine the center of the shape and where you want that shape to be placed on your quilt block. Lay the shape on your quilt block and mark the center of the shape placement on your quilt block. Place the quilt block in the embroidery hoop matching the center of the embroidery hoop with the center mark of the shape on the guilt block. Load the embroidery for that animal into your embroidery machine and complete the applique.
- 2. Complete this process for each applique. Complete all embroidery on quilt blocks before assembling quilt top.





Assemble the Quilt Top

- 1. Lay out blocks in 3 rows of 3 blocks each as shown in quilt diagram. Sew blocks together into rows. Press seams to one side.
- 2. Sew rows together. Press seams open.



Assemble the Borders

- 1. Cut the borders according to the cutting instructions. Measure the height of the quilt and adjust the length of the vertical border accordingly. Stitch the vertical border to the sides of the quilt.
- 2. Measure the width of the quilt and adjust the length of the horizontal border accordingly. Stitch the horizontal border to the top and bottom of the guilt. Press seam allowances toward the border



Quilting and Finishing:

- 1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
- 2. Pin or baste layers together.
- 3. Quilt as desired.
- 4. Add binding, mitering corners.
