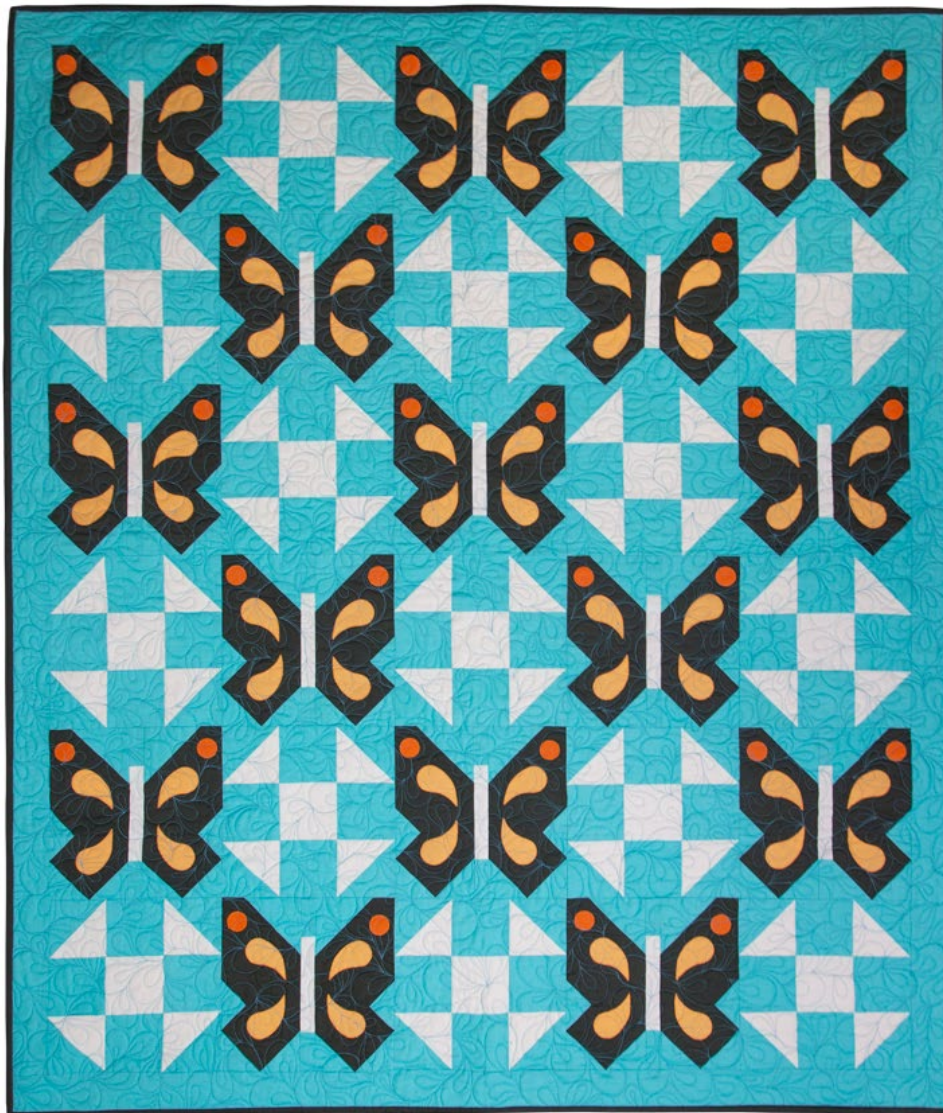


## GO! Fancy Wings Throw Quilt

## Dies Needed:

### GO! Qube Mix & Match 6" Block (55775) or 12" block (55778)

- GO! Square-3-1/2" (3" Finished) (55701)
- GO! Half Square Triangle-3" Finished Square (55703)

### Additional Dies Needed

- GO! Butterfly Pieced -9" Finished (55598)
- GO! Feathers Die (55008)
- GO! Circle-1/2", 3/4", 1", 1-1/4" Die (55484)
- GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55014 or 55017)

## Fabric Requirements:

Fabric Color	Total Yardage
Aqua	2-1/2 yards
Dark Green	2 yards
Mint Green	1 yard
Yellow	1/2 yard
Orange	1/4 yard
Batting	54" x 63"
Backing	58" x 67"
Fusible	2/3 yards

## Cutting Directions:

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
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Note: Apply fusible web to the wrong side of asterisked fabrics following manufacturer's instructions before cutting appliqué shapes.

Aqua	GO! Square-3-1/2" (3" Finished) (55701)	Cut 6—4" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 4" widths. Sub cut into 60—3" finished squares.
Aqua	GO! Half Square Triangle-3" Finished Square (55703)	Cut 3—4-3/4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 4" widths. Sub cut into 60—Half Square triangles- 3" finished squares.
Aqua	GO! Butterfly Pieced- 9" Finished (55598)	Cut 4—7-7/8" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 5" widths. place fabric over shapes C, D, E, and F. Sub cut into 30—Shape C and F, and 60—Shape D and E.
Aqua	GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" finished) (55014 or 55017)	Cut 6—2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub cut into 2—2-1/2" x 54-1/2" vertical borders. Sub cut 2—2-1/2" x 49-1/2" horizontal borders.
Dark Green	GO! Butterfly Pieced- 9" Finished (55598)	Cut 4—10-3/4" x WOF strips. Cut strips into 15—10-3/4" x 10-1/4" rectangles. Fold each rectangle in half so that it measures 10-3/4 x 5-1/8". Place fabric over Shapes A and B. Sub cut into 30—shape A and B. **note- if you are using a print fabric, you will have 15 shape A and B that are cut out with fabric facing up, and 15 shapes A and B that are cut out with the fabric facing down. So that they are mirror images of each other.
Dark Green	GO! Strip cutter 2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55014 or 55017)	Cut 6—2-1/2" x WOF strips to use for quilt binding.
Mint Green	GO! Square-3-1/2" (3" Finished) (55701)	Cut 2—4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 4" widths. Sub cut into 15—3" finished squares.

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Mint Green	GO! Half Square Triangle-3" Finished Square (55703)	Cut 3—4-3/4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 4" widths. Sub cut into 60—Half Square triangles- 3" finished squares.
Mint Green	GO! Pieced Butterfly-9" Finished (55598)	Cut 3—1-3/4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 6" widths. Place fabric over shape G, sub cut into 15—Shape G.
*Yellow	GO! Feathers Die (55008)	Cut 10—5" x 3-1/4" rectangles. Place fabric over curved feathers, with fabric <b>facing UP</b> . Sub cut into 30—left pointing feathers.
*Yellow	GO! Feathers Die (55008)	Cut 10—5" x 3-1/4" rectangles. Place fabric over curved feathers, with fabric <b>facing DOWN</b> . Sub cut into 30—right pointing feathers.
*Orange	GO! Circle-1/2", 3/4", 1", 1-1/4" Die (55484)	Cut 4—2-3/4" x 5" rectangles. Place fabric over 1" circle. Sub cut into 30—1" finished circles.

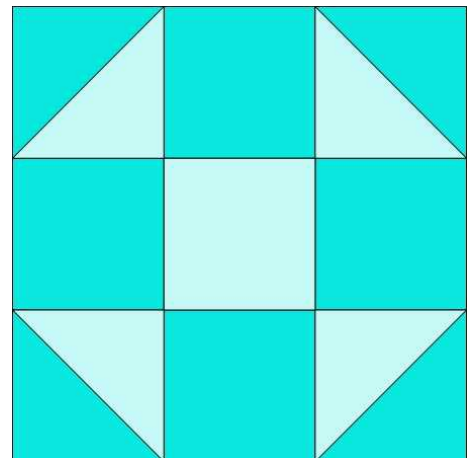
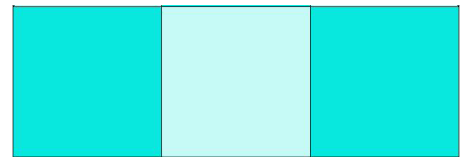
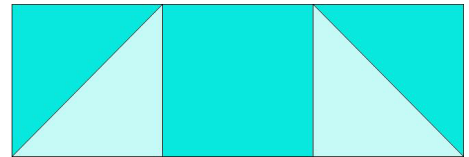
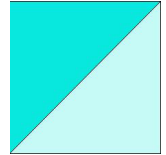
## Sewing Directions:

Press all seams open and use  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams, unless otherwise indicated.

### Shoo Fly Block

**NOTE:** Directions will be for one 9" finished block. Make 15 blocks.

1. Sew one aqua and one mint green 3" finished half square triangle (HST) (55703) together as shown. Press seams open. Make 4 HST units.
2. Sew one HST unit to either side of one aqua 3" finished square (55701) press seams open. Make a total of 2—one top row and one bottom row per block.
3. Sew one aqua 3" finished square to each side of one mint green 3" finished square as shown. Press seams open. Make one center row.
4. Sew one top row to the top of the center row. Press seams open. Sew one bottom row to the bottom of the center row. Press seams open. Make 1—9" finished shoo fly block. Repeat for remaining blocks.



## Butterfly Pieced Block

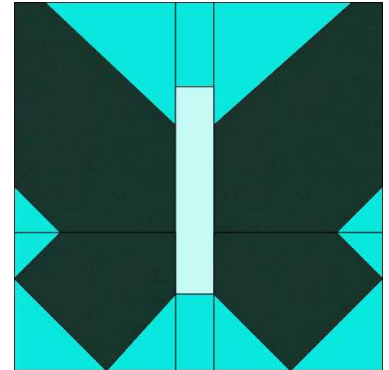

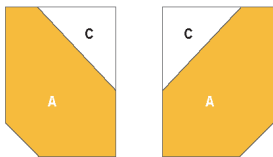

### How to Sew the 4-color, 9" finished Butterfly Pieced Block:

This die is designed to cut two 4-color, 9" blocks in one pass through the cutter. The How to Sew instructions show you how to assembly one of those blocks. Use a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seams open unless otherwise directed.

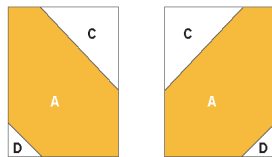


Step 1



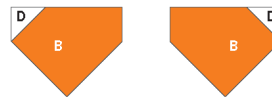
Sew pieces A and C together as shown. Make 2 A/C mirror-image units.

Step 2



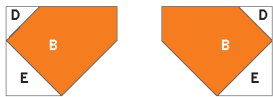
Sew piece D to A/C unit as shown. Make 2 A/C/D mirror-image units for wing tops.

Step 3



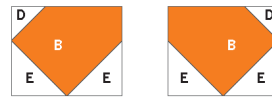
Sew pieces D and B together as shown. Make 2 D/B mirror-image units.

Step 4



Sew piece E to D/B unit as shown. Make 2 D/B/E mirror-image units.

Step 5



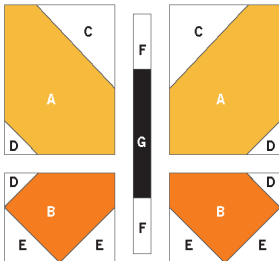
Add another E piece as shown. Make 2 D/B/E/E mirror-image units for wing bottoms.

Step 6



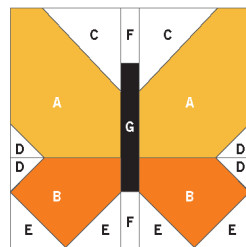
Sew F pieces to piece G as shown. Make 1 unit row.

Step 7



Sew wing top and bottom units together into rows, then sew rows together as shown.

Step 8



Finished block should measure 9 1/2" x 9 1/2".

## Butterfly Appliqué

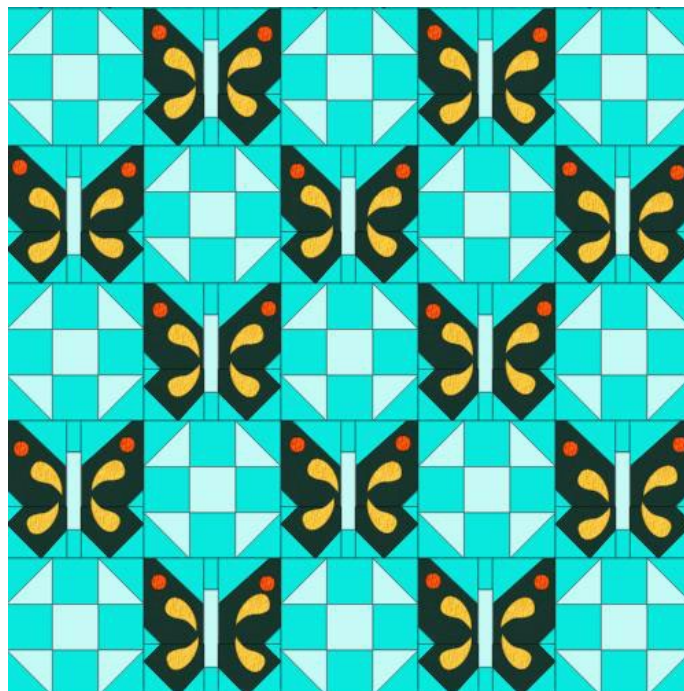
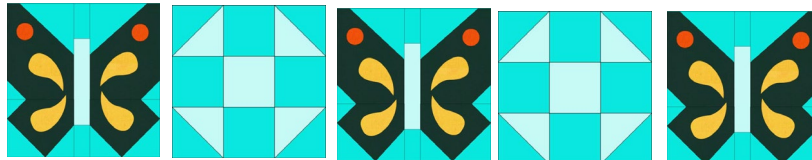
1—9-1/2" pieced butterfly block, 2—orange 1" circle, 2—yellow right pointing feathers, 2—yellow left pointing feathers.

Lay out, fuse, and appliqué feathers and circles onto 9-1/2" pieced butterfly block using block image as a reference. Make 15 blocks.



## Assemble the Quilt Top

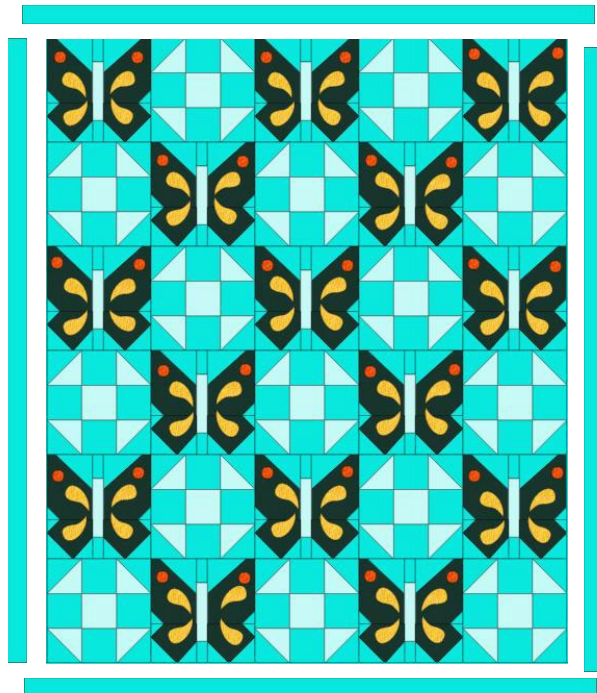
1. Lay out blocks in 6 rows of 5 blocks each as shown in quilt diagram. Sew blocks together into rows. Press seams to one side.
2. Sew rows together. Press seams in opposite directions



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## Assemble the Borders

1. Cut the vertical and horizontal borders according to the cutting instructions. Measure the height of the quilt and adjust the length of the vertical border accordingly. Stitch the vertical border to the sides of the quilt.
2. Measure the width of the quilt and adjust the length of the horizontal border accordingly. Stitch the horizontal border to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press seams toward the border.





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## Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
