GO! Dies needed

- GO! Nine Patch Star 9" Finished (55685)
- GO! Strip Cutter 2 1/2" (2" finished) (55017)

Fabric Requirements:

Fabric Color	Total Yardage
Six Assorted Prints	1/4 yard each
Pink	3/4 yard
Dark Pink	3/4 yard
Mint	1 yards
White	3 1/2 yards
Binding	3/4 yard
Backing	3 1/2 yards

Cutting Instructions:

Fabric Color	Die	Number of shapes to cut
Pink	GO! Nine Patch Star 9" Finished (55685)	Rough cut Seven strips, 2 1/2" x Width of Fabric (WOF), fanfold across shape "A" to cut One Hundred Twenty-Eight (128) squares. Rough cut One strip, 5 1/5" x WOF, fanfold across shape "B" to cut Four (4) triangles.
Dark Pink	GO! Nine Patch Star 9" Finished (55685)	Rough cut Eight strips, 2 1/2" x WOF, fanfold across shape "A" to cut One Hundred Sixty (160) squares.
Mint	GO! Nine Patch Star 9" Finished (55685)	Rough cut Ten strips, 5 1/5" x WOF, fanfold across shape "B" to cut One Hundred Twelve (112) triangles.
Assorted Prints (Six)	GO! Nine Patch Star 9" Finished (55685)	From each print, rough cut Two, 3 1/4" x WOF strips. Fanfold across shape "C" to cut One Hundred Forty-Four (144) kite shapes. (Twenty-Four of each print)

Cutting Instructions (Continued):

Fabric Color	Die	Number of shapes to cut
Background	GO! Nine Patch Star 9" Finished (55685)	Rough cut Ten strips, 5 1/5" x WOF, fanfold across shape "B" to cut One Hundred Sixteen (116) quarter square triangles. Rough cut twelve strips, 6" x WOF, fanfold across shape "D" to cut Two Hundred Eighty-Eight (288) triangles. <i>*NOTE* this is a directional shape, as such half of the shape should be facing left and the other half right.</i>
Binding	GO! Strip Cutter 2 1/2" (2" finished) (55017)	Rough cut One strip, 16" x WOF, fold in half along the lengthwise grain. Position on die board to cover all 4 blades to cut Six WOF binding strips.


Block Sewing Directions

NOTES:


- All seams are sewn right sides together, at a standard $\frac{1}{4}$ ".
- The edges of the units, as well as the finished quilt, will be on the bias grain, take care not to stretch or distort your blocks as you work.

Nine Patch units:


1. Arrange Nine-Patch blocks as shown, with the Dark Pink squares in the outer corners. Sew blocks into rows, pressing seams in opposite directions.




2. Join rows together to create a Nine-Patch unit. Press seams to one side. Create Thirty-Two (32) identical units.



3. On Four of the completed Nine-Patch units, attach Three White Triangle (shape B) and One Mint Triangle (shape B) as shown. Press seams out toward triangles.




2. On the remaining Twenty-Eight Nine-Patch units, attach Two White Triangle (shape B) and Two Mint Triangle (shape B) as shows. Press seams out toward triangles.




Periwinkle units:

1. Sew a White Triangle (shape D) to either side of a Print Kite (shape C). Press seams open. Create Four (4) identical units.

**NOTE* The edge of shape D with the straight of grain cut should be on the same side as the wide end of the Kite shape.*




2. Combine Two matching Kite units together as shows. Press seams open. Make Two (2) units.



3. Combine two units together as shows, matching up the center seam. Press seam open.


4. Repeat steps 1-3 to create Thirty-Six (36) Periwinkle Blocks in total, Six from each of the assorted print fabrics.



Half-Square Triangle (HST) units:


1. Attach one White Triangle (shape B) and one Mint Triangle (shape B), sewing along the long edge. Press seam open. Create Forty-Eight (48) HST units.

**NOTE* The outer edge of the HSTs will be bias.*




2. Attach one Pink Triangle (shape B) and one Mint Triangle (shape B), sewing along the long edge. Press seam open. Create Four (4) HST units.

**NOTE* The outer edge of the HSTs will be bias.*




Quilt Top Assembly

1. Pin and Sew Periwinkle units into Six rows of Six blocks each. Press seams in opposite directions.
2. Pin and sew rows together, nesting seams. Press seams to one side.




3. Sew Twelve White/Mint HST units together as shown. Press seams open. Create Four (4) rows.




4. Attach a Pink/Mint HST unit to each end of the combined HST row as shown. Press seams open. Create Two (2) long rows.




5. Pin and sew the Two short HST rows to the Left & Right sides of the Quilt Center. Press seams toward the center.
6. Pin and sew the Two long HST rows to the Top & Bottom of the Periwinkle Quilt Center. Press seams toward the center.




7. Pin and sew Seven Nine-Patch units together as shows, will all of the Mint triangles on one side and all of the White on the other. Press seams open. Create Four (4) rows.



8. Pin and sew one Nine-Patch unit that has only one Mint triangle to each end of a combined Nine-Patch row. Press seams open. Create Two (2) long rows.



9. Pin and sew the Two shorts HST rows to the Left & Right sides of the Periwinkle Quilt Center. Press seams out toward the edges.
10. Pin and sew the Two long HST rows to the Top & Bottom of the Periwinkle Quilt Center. Press seams out toward the edge.



Finishing your quilt:

1. Layer your quilt backing, batting & quilt top together
2. Pin/Baste layers together and quilt as desired.
3. Bind quilt using your preferred method.
4. Label your quilt and enjoy!
