3-5/8 yards for backing

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

one 1-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
one 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangle

From Fabric B, cut:

one 2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
two 2" squares
two 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric C, cut:

one 2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
two 2" squares
two 1-1/2" squares

From Fabric D, cut:

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:
two 3" squares
two 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" border strips

From Fabric E, cut:

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:
two 3" squares
two 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric F, cut:

one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:
two 4" squares
two 3-1/2" x 16-1/2" border strips

From Fabric G, cut:

one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:
two 4" squares
two 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric H, cut:

two 5" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 5" squares
two 4-1/2" x 22 1/2" border strips

From Fabric I, cut:

one 5" x WOF strip. Subcut:
two 5" squares
two 4-1/2" x 13-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric J, cut:

two 6" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 6" squares
two 5-1/2" 30-1/2" border strips

From Fabric K, cut:

two 6" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 6" squares
two 5-1/2" x 21-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric L, cut:

one 7" x WOF strip. Subcut:
two 7" squares
two 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 6-1/2" x 40-1/2" border strips

From Fabric M, cut:

two 7" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 7" squares
two 6-1/2" x 31-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric N, cut:

one 8" x WOF strip. Subcut:
two 8" squares
three 7-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end, then subcut:
two 7-1/2" x 52-1/2" border strips

From Fabric O, cut:

one 8" x WOF strip. Subcut:
two 8" squares
three 7-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end, then subcut:
two 7-1/2" x 43-1/2" rectangles

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 1: Pair a 2" Fabric B square with a 2" Fabric C square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make four B/C HSTs.



Step 2: Pair a 3" Fabric D square with a 3" Fabric E square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make four D/E HSTs.



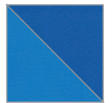
Step 3: Pair a 4" Fabric F square with a 4" Fabric G square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make four F/G HSTs.



Step 4: Pair a 5" Fabric H square with a 5" Fabric I square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make four H/I HSTs.



Step 5: Pair a 6" Fabric J square with a 6" Fabric K square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make four J/K HSTs.



Step 6: Pair a 7" Fabric L square with a 7" Fabric M square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make four L/M HSTs.



Step 7: Pair a 8" Fabric N square with a 8" Fabric O square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to $7\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make four N/O HSTs.



Assemble the Borders

Step 8: Sew one $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square between two B/C HSTs as shown. Press. Repeat to make two B/C Borders.



Step 9: Sew one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E rectangle between two D/E HSTs as shown. Press. Repeat to make two D/E Borders.



Step 10: Sew one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G rectangle between two F/G HSTs as shown. Press. Repeat to make two F/G Borders.



Step 11: Sew one 4-1/2" x 13-1/2" Fabric I rectangle between two H/I HSTs as shown. Press. Repeat to make two H/I Borders.



Step 12: Sew one 5-1/2" x 21-1/2" Fabric K rectangle between two J/K HSTs as shown. Press. Repeat to make two J/K Borders.



Step 13: Sew one 6-1/2" x 31-1/2" Fabric M rectangle between two L/M HSTs as shown. Press. Repeat to make two L/M Borders.



Step 13: Sew one 7-1/2" x 43-1/2" Fabric O rectangle between two N/O HSTs as shown. Press. Repeat to make two N/O Borders.



Assemble the Quilt

Step 14: Sew one 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" Fabric A rectangle between two 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" Fabric B rectangles. Press. This is the quilt center.



Step 15: Sew the B/C Borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press.

Step 16: Sew the 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" Fabric C border strips to the left and right edges of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 16: Sew the D/E Borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press. Sew the 3-1/2" x 16-1/2" Fabric D border strips to the left and right edges of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 17: Sew the F/G Borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press. Sew the 4-1/2" x 22-1/2" Fabric F border strips to the left and right edges of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 18: Sew the H/I Borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press. Sew the 5-1/2" x 30-1/2" Fabric H border strips to the left and right edges of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 19: Sew the J/K Borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press. Sew the 6-1/2" x 40-1/2" Fabric J border strips to the left and right edges of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 20: Sew the L/M Borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press. Sew the 7-1/2" x 52-1/2" Fabric B border strips to the left and right edges of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step #: Sew the N/O Borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!
