Mayor Sim Bell started the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance at 6:30 PM. Geo Peart is here with some questions and concerns on the price increase for water billing. He is wondering why the base rate for businesses is higher than residential customers. He thinks businesses already pay higher taxes, collect sales tax for the town and they should not have to pay a higher water rate. This was discussed. Geo is asking for the town to reduce the business basic rate to the same as the residential rate. We will discuss this at next month's meeting when more of the town board members are present. Having a higher rate for overage and/or a higher rate if the meter is bigger was discussed. Geo would also like to see the sidewalk in front of the seminary building be finished around the corner. He suggested getting town citizens to volunteer to help do the work. Sim said that we can put some numbers together and see what we can do.

April asked if there were any questions on the minutes. There were none. Brandon Miller made a motion to approve the minutes. Kathy 2nd. All in favor. April read the bills. Kathy made a motion to approve the bills. Brandon Miller 2nd. All in favor.

Tourism Grant was next on the agenda. Kathy explained the work that she has been doing and what she has planned for the Christmas decorations for the park. Doing an ice-staking rink again was discussed. Also, getting a small shed to store all the decorations was discussed. Brandon Miller would like to replace the rest of the fence at the park, replace the backstop at the baseball field, and replace the lights by the tennis courts. Kaleb said

that the fence around the park is almost done. They should finish soon. Sim will get a quote on fish for the derby.

The tennis court is done. The basketball standards came today. Kaleb will set the posts and order signs for the tennis courts. Doing a silent bid for the old fencing was discussed. Kaleb will get April a measurement for the advertisement. We will also have a silent bid for the old basketball standards.

We will address the issue of vacant homes next month. Kaleb will try to get a list of addresses for those lots that do not have a meter so that we can send them a letter about taking care of their property. Making a map of all the meters in town was discussed. Kaleb has made a map of all the hydrants in town. The company doing the culvert has asked to use our water. Kaleb will keep track of how much they use.

We will plan on doing a town clean up day in the Spring and get some dumpsters for residents to use.

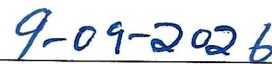
We will meet at 7 AM to set up for the town breakfast on August 15th. Clay will bring his extra griddle. We will meet for the parade at 4:30.

The town received some letters from 4H kids asking for boosts on their animals. This was discussed. The board decided to give each kid \$25. The CD rate at Zions Bank is 3.72% for 12 months. We will transfer half of the \$55,000 to the General Reserve Fund and half to a CD. Overdue water bills were discussed. Bank Statements were passed around. Brandon thinks that some of the trees in the park are dying and looking bad. Cutting some down and replacing them was discussed.

Kathy made a motion to close the meeting at 8:13 PM. Brandon Miller 2nd. All in favor.
