Mayor Sim Bell called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM and led the Pledge of Allegiance. April handed out copies of the finalized budget. The board reviewed the budget and asked any questions that they had. Brandon Hatch said that the Canal company offered to put the pipe in for us at the bridge going to Dusty Morse's when they line the canal if we can have the pipe there and ready. It was discussed whether to adjust the budget to add the \$15,000 to \$20,000 for this culvert or to amend the budget later. Kaleb has been checking all the hydrants to see what needs to be replaced and/or fixed. He still has about 10 more to test. He does not have an exact price for what they will cost. Sim opened the public hearing for the budget. No one is present to comment. Brandon Hatch made a motion to accept the budget as is. Kathy 2nd. All in favor. Public meeting was closed.

April asked if there were any questions or concerns on the minutes from last meeting. There are not. Kathy made a motion to approve of the minutes. Clay 2nd. All in favor. April read the bills. Brandon Hatch made a motion to approve the bills. Brandon Miller 2nd. All in favor.

Fencing at the tennis courts is done. Brandon Miller will let Courts Unlimited know that we are ready for surfacing. They gave us an estimate for late July. We need to order the basketball stands/hoops. April said that we will have around \$28,000 left after we pay for the rest of the surfacing. We will get some portable bleachers with the remaining money after we order the basketball stands/hoops. Kaleb will measure the gate to see how big of bleachers that we can get.

Kaleb got a bid for the fencing around the park from Bridger Valley Fence. It is \$9,272 to get up to the double gates. The board is good with that.

Tourism Grant for 2027 was discussed. Some ideas where finishing the fire pit, finish the rest of the fence, putting in a new backstop on the baseball diamond, and new light posts in the park. Kathy is still working on getting a map put together for Christmas decorations in the park. Sim still wants to see about doing a Fishing Derby. He thinks that we might be able to get the State to sponsor some of it. Clay will look unto what other fishing derbies do to get some ideas.

Laurel Telford put in a silent bid for the old fencing around the tennis courts. The board wants to post a notice for a silent bid and leave it open for a month.

We will meet at 4:30 PM on June 25th for the Softball BBQ. We will serve food from 5 to 8.

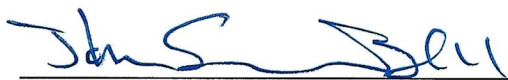
Overdue water bills were discussed.

We need to decide if we will raise the property taxes by the end of June. The board and mayor do not want to raise them.

The grant that the county awarded to Outlaw Woodworks has been turned over to us to put conditions on it. The board decided that they need to have construction started to get half of the money. And at least one building out of the three needs to be done to get the rest of the money. They have not yet requested to come to planning and zoning to get any buildings approved to start building.

The county has awarded the town \$6,000 for an American 250 Celebration Grant. We can use it however we would like to celebrate America turning 250. Ideas were discussed. Brandon thinks it would be cool to get a big flag to put in the park. Kathy found some signs that we could hang up on the fence and/or light poles that could be reusable. Kaleb mentioned that the flags that we hang on the light poles are getting pretty tattered and we could use some new ones. Kaleb will measure the poles to see about getting decorative signs and count how many poles we have.

Brandon Miller made a motion to close at 7:37 PM. Clay 2nd. All in favor.
