Mayor called the Town Board meeting to order at 7:05.

The minutes from October's monthly meeting were read and moved to be approved by Brian, with Melanie seconding, approved unanimously.

We discussed the Sub for Santa program and Melanie reported that the Randolph Fire District would not be taking charge of the program. She suggested that we continue with a committee approach with a two-year term as chairman and then alternating our chairman with another committee member. She was asked to contact some of the existing committee members to see if they would be willing to serve as chairman next year.

We talked about the lights that had been installed along the walkway at the bridge. Everyone was asked to make it a point to look at them and see what they thought.

The bills were read with Melanie asking how much the Zombie run reimbursement was and what it was used for. She believed that we should look at charging next year for the event so that we would not go in the hole. We also discussed moving it back to a Tuesday night to get more participation. Numbers were down this year.

Melanie moved to approved the bills with Brian seconding.

The board was given the opportunity to study the bid for the snow blower tractor. It should be arriving this week and will be put to use immediately. The board was glad it had come in so much under what we were expecting.

We then discussed the annexation project. We are still waiting for the third area to be surveyed and mapped. Merrill Muir has withdrawn his request to be annexed due to the increased cost of an access permit from UDOT. Apparently, it would cost approximately

\$250,000 and would not be feasible with just 10 homes going in. The Mayor has been trying to contact UDOT to complain about this exorbitant charge for access to our rural area and the effect it could have on our small community's growth and development.

We are, however, going to move forward with the project. Melanie moved to accept the petitions for annexation and Bridget seconded.

We are moving ahead with our Christmas Even program. The Senior Center is reserved for December 23 and Santa contacted. We will bag candy December 22 or 23.

Our town board party will be December 6 and we will say goodbye to Bridget and hello to Larry as our next board member at that time.

Melanie made the motion to be dismissed at 8:05 and Bridget seconded, unanimously agreed upon.
