Mayor Weston discussed with Sim the need for culverts to serve as bridges over the R&W Canal for two of the streets in town. He felt we needed to get them installed before the spring irrigation water was put into the canal. Scott had obtained some prices on different sizes and types of culverts. Sim was going to check with a couple of construction companies and get some bids for immediate dirt work. The board will probably have to do a conference call this week and accept the bid for installation and culvert type.

We still had no definitive answer from one of our previous summer employees about returning to work. We will, most likely, have to consult other board members about hiring later in the week as well.

Melanie reported via text that she had got a construction company to look at the WW House and give her a bid on repairs. As soon as she receives his paperwork, she will contact other board members to get that approved as well.
