

Laura Heine Fabric Collage Class Supply List

Class Supply List:

In this class, we will learn how to make one of the Laura Heine Collage Quilts.

You can pick your pattern and everyone will be working on their own creation. This is a design and learning class, so you will NOT need your sewing machine. No sewing will be involved in this class.

SUPPLIES:

- Sharp regular scissors
- Serrated applique scissors are recommended (Karen Kay Buckley's Perfect Scissors Blue Handles)
- Regular Pencil or Permanent pen for tracing your pattern
- Laura Heine Pattern of your choice
- Applique pressing sheet
- Teflon or Pressing paper sheets
- Fabric Collage Kit or your choice of 40 to 80 small fabric pieces of fabric
- Pattern Ease – size recommended on the pattern
- Steam a Seam 2 (see pattern to see how much is recommended for your project)
- A small portable iron is helpful to have at your workstation if you have a wool pressing mat or mini ironing surface

HOMEWORK: It is most helpful to pre-fuse your fabric from your fabric kit to the Steam a Seam 2 prior to class. Please refer to the YouTube Video by Beehive Quilt Shop titled:

Fabric Collage Workshop/Class Supply List –

– for TEENY TINY PROJECTS (You can choose to do a larger project)

Order the following items from Beehive Quilt Shop, so that you have all items in hand BEFORE the workshop:

1. Order – Laura Heine Collage Pattern
2. Order – Corresponding Laura Heine kit
3. Order – Pattern Ease Foundation 19" x 23" or size indicated on kit.
4. Steam a Seam 2 as indicated on the pattern (no substitutions)
5. Pattern Ease can be purchased in advance or on the day of the class (see pattern for amount)
6. Steam a Seam 2 (at least 3 yards)

Bring to Workshop:

1. #2 pencil (sharpened) and black fine tip sharpie marker/pen
2. Karen K Buckley Medium Blue handle serrated scissors (can use scissors you have IF they are serrated).
3. Goddess Applique pressing sheet 17 x 24 (not smaller) or Precision FusingMat 17x24
4. Small rotary cutter, mat (12 x 17) and ruler (3 x12) – Don't buy new if your sizes aren't exact to those listed – just be close. Won't need anything bigger.
5. Bring small iron and small iron pad. There will be irons and boards there. Easier if you
6. AND – remember your pattern, kit and pattern ease and steam a seam 2
