Notes: Mark and store cutting pieces according to the block they have been assigned to, as this will ease the piecing process.

## STAR BLOCKS

1. Flying Geese Units: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) $K 3-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Place (1) square, right side together (RST), at a corner of (1) D 3-1/4" $\times 6^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal (1) K corner triangle. Repeat with another K 3-1/4" square at the opposite corner of the same D rectangle to complete (1) flying geese unit. Make (4).

2. Sew (2) flying geese units to the opposite sides of (1) K 6" square to make a row unit.
3. Sew (2) D 3-1/4" squares to the opposite short sides of (1) $3-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ flying geese unit to make a row unit. Make (2) row units.
4. Sew together row units to complete (1) Star Block. Make (4). Square to 11-1/2".

## Star Unit

6. Flying Geese Unit: Repeat Step 1 using (2) D 1-3/4" squares and (1) F 1-3/4" $\times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Make (4).
7. Sew (2) flying geese units to the opposite sides of (1) D $3^{\prime \prime}$ square to make a row unit.
8. Sew (1) F 1-3/4" square to each side of (1) flying geese unit to make a row unit. Make (2).
9. Sew together row units to complete (1) Star Unit, measuring 5-1/2" square.

10. Sew together (3) B 1-1/2" $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and (2) D 1-1/2" $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles as shown. Sew unit to the right of Star Unit. Unit measures 5-1/2" $\times 11-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
11. Sew together (3) B $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and (3) D $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and add to the bottom of previously sewn section to complete (1) Flag Block. Make (4). Square to 11-1/2".

## Pieced Rows

13. Rows 1, 3, 5 and 7: Arrange and sew together (4) Flag Blocks and (3) Star Blocks.

Rows 2, 4, 6 and 8: Arrange and sew together (4) Star Blocks and (3) Flag Blocks.
Use Quilt Diagram on Page 6 as a reference.
Row 1: F/D/B, L/D, L/D/I, A/D, K/D/H, G/D, A/D/M
Row 2: A/D, A/D/M, G/D, G/D/C, E/D, J/D/B, F/D
Row 3: K/D/H, K/D, E/D/B, J/D, F/D/B, L/D, G/D/C
Row 4: L/D, G/D/C, F/D, L/D/I, G/D, E/D/B, K/D
Row 5: L/D/I, A/D, J/D/B, E/D, A/D/M, K/D, L/D/I
Row 6: E/D, F/D/B, J/D, K/D/H, F/D, E/D/B, A/D
Row 7: J/D/B, G/D, E/D/B, J/D, J/D/B, E/D, F/D/B
Row 8: F/D, A/D/M, K/D, G/D/C, L/D, K/D/H, J/D
14. Sew pieced rows together to complete quilt top.
