| B |  | 50742-2 | 1/3 | (1) 7 " $\times$ WOF strip. Subcut into (5) 7" squares. |
| C |  | 50742-3 | 1/3 | (1) 7 " $\times$ WOF strip. Subcut into (5) 7" squares. |
| D |  | 50743-1 | 1/3 | (1) $7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Subcut into (5) 7-1/2" squares. |
| E |  | 50744-3 | 1/3 | (1) 7 " $\times$ WOF strip. Subcut into (5) 7 " squares. |
| F |  | 50744-4 | 1/2 | (6) $2-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for binding. |
| G |  | 50745-3 | 1/3 | (1) 7 " $\times$ WOF strip. Subcut into (5) 7 " squares. |
| H |  | 50746-2 | 1/3 | (1) 7 " $\times$ WOF strip. Subcut into (5) 7" squares. |
| I |  | 50746-4 | 1/3 | (1) $7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Subcut into (5) 7-1/2" squares. |
| J | $\# 1 / 1 /=$ | 50748-4 | 1/3 | (1) 7-1/2" $\times$ WOF strip. Subcut into (5) 7-1/2" squares. |
| K |  | 50748-7 | 1/3 | (1) 7 " $\times$ WOF strip. Subcut into (5) 7 " squares. |
| L |  | 50750-3 | 1/3 | (1) 7 " $\times$ WOF strip. Subcut into (5) 7 " squares. |
| M |  | 50750-7 | 1/3 | (1) 7 " $\times$ WOF strip. Subcut into (5) 7" squares. |
| N | $\triangle \Delta^{\Delta}$ | 50751-3 | 1 | (4) $7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Subcut into (20) 7-1/2" squares. |

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## PRECUT SQUARES INTO TRIANGLES

1. Cut each $\mathbf{B}, \mathbf{C}, \mathbf{E}, \mathbf{G}, \mathbf{H}, \mathbf{K}, \mathbf{L}$, and $\mathbf{M}$ square diagonally in half once to make (10) triangles.

2. Cut each $\mathbf{A}, \mathbf{D}, \mathbf{I}, \mathbf{J}$ and $\mathbf{N}$ square diagonally in half twice to make (20) triangles. $\mathbf{N}$ will yield (80) triangles.


## TRIANGLE UNITS

3. Sew (1) $\mathbf{N}$ triangle and (1) A triangle short sides together, oriented as shown. Repeat to make a total of (80) dark tan triangle units, using $\mathbf{A}, \mathbf{D}, \mathbf{I}$ and $\mathbf{J}$ triangles paired with $\mathbf{N}$ triangles.


## HONEY BLOCKS

4. Sew (1) C triangle to (1) Triangle Unit along the long edges, as shown. Trim so block measures 6-1/2" square, aligning diagonal line on ruler with the center seam line. Repeat using C, E, G and $\mathbf{L}$ triangles to make a total of (40) squares.

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## LATTE BLOCKS

5. Now sew (1) B triangle to (1) Triangle Unit along the long edges. Trim so block measures 6-1/2" square, aligning diagonal line on ruler with the center seam line. Repeat using $\mathbf{B}, \mathbf{H}$, $\mathbf{K}$ and $\mathbf{M}$ triangles to make a total of (40) 6-1/2" squares.

6. Lay out alternating (4) Honey and (4) Latte Blocks into (10) rows of (8) blocks each. Note orientation of each block.
