- 3 yards paper-backed fusible web, such as Wonder Under by

- 1 copy of each appliqué pattern printed at actual size

Preparation

## For all appliqué methods:

Make a full appliqué pattern from each half shape.

## For fusible appliqué:

Trace each full appliqué shape (5) times onto the paper side of fusible web. Cut out roughly $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ outside the traced line. Follow the manufacturer's instructions to fuse to the wrong side of Fabrics F - Y as detailed in Cutting instructions,, centering appliqué shapes on motifs where desired. Cut out on the traced line.

## For all other appliqué methods:

Trace the full appliqué shapes onto the corresponding fabrics listed below, centering appliqué shapes on motifs where desired, adding the seam allowance required for your preferred method of appliqué, and cut out.

## Cutting

WOF = Width of Fabric; LOF = Length of Fabric. WOF of a Fat Quarter or Fat Eighth is approximately 21 ".

## From Fabric A, cut:

(7) $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF; cut
(20) $10^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ block backgrounds

## From Fabric B, cut:

(28) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF; cut
(40) $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2 "}$ and
(40) $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 12^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ block sashing strips

## From Fabric C, cut:

(17) $2^{1 / 21} \times$ x WOF; cut
(49) $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strips

## From Fabric D, cut:

(8) $2^{1 / 2 "} \times$ WOF for border

## From Fabric E, cut:

Enough $2 \frac{1}{4}$ "-wide bias strips to make 300 " of bias binding

## From Fabric F, M, P, S, and V, cut from each:

(1) Heart appliqué, centered on a motif if applicable

## From Fabric G, J, Q, T, and W, cut from each:

(1) Spade appliqué, centered on a motif if applicable

## From Fabric H, K, N, U, and X, cut from each:

(1) Diamond appliqué, centered on a motif if applicable

## From Fabric I, O, R, and Y, cut from each:

(1) Club appliqué, centered on a motif if applicable

## From Fabric L, cut:

(1) Club appliqué
(30) $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ cornerstone squares, fussy cut centered on the Chesire cat motifs

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## Instructions

All seam allowances are $1 / 44^{\prime \prime}$, pieces are sewn right sides together, and seam allowances are pressed open unless otherwise stated.

1. Fold the Fabric $\mathbf{A} 10^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares in half vertically and finger press the fold to mark the center of each square.
2. Fold the hearts, clubs, diamonds, and spades in half along the vertical axis and finger press the fold to mark the center of each shape
3. If using paper-backed fusible web, peel the paper backing off each shape first. Pin, glue baste, or follow the manufacturer's instructions to fuse the shapes, right side up, to the right side of the Fabric A 101/2" squares, matching the center folds. Center the Hearts 1" from the top and bottom of the squares. Center the Spades, Diamonds, and Clubs $1 / 2$ " from the top and bottom of the squares. (Fig. 1)

4. Using matching thread and a small zigzag stitch, or alternate decorative stitch of your choice, appliqué around each shape to secure it to the background square. Keep the needle down when pivoting at sharp corners. (Fig. 2 shown top right)

5. Sew a Fabric B $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ block sashing strip to the top and bottom of each block. Press towards Fabric B. Sew a Fabric B $1^{1 / 21} \times 12^{1 / 2 "}$ block sashing strip to the sides of each block and press towards Fabric B again to complete the block. (Fig. 3)

6. Sew (5) Fabric L $2^{1 / 2 "}$ " cornerstones and (4) Fabric C $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 12^{1 / 2 "}$ sashing strips together as shown into a sashing row. Press towards Fabric C. Repeat to make (6) total sashing rows. (Fig. 4)

## Quilt Top Assembly

Note: Follow the Quilt Layout diagram shown at right while assembling the quilt. Press seam allowances towards the Sashing Strips. Measure the Quilt Center width and height before adding borders. Adjust border measurements where necessary to match your measurements.
7. Sew the blocks together into (5) rows of (4) blocks with (5) Fabric C $2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1 / 2 "}$ sashing strips between each block and at the beginning and end of each row. Press towards Fabric C.
8. Sew the rows together with a sashing row between each. Press. Sew the remaining sashing rows to the top and bottom of the quilt.
9. Sew the Fabric $\mathbf{D} 2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips together end-to-end using diagonal seams into (1) continuous strip. Trim the seam allowances to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$.
10. Measure the quilt top center vertically through the middle and cut (2) Side Borders to fit ( $72^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ long) from the continuous Fabric $\mathbf{D}$ strip. Sew to the left and right sides of the quilt top center and press towards the border.
11. Repeat Step 10 to measure the quilt top horizontally through the center and cut and add (2) Top/Bottom Borders to fit ( $62^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ long).
12. Layer the backing, batting, and quilt top; baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim the batting and backing even with the quilt top.
13. Sew the Fabric E binding strips end-to-end using diagonal. Press seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
14. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
15. Leaving an 8 " tail of binding, sew the binding to the top of the quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12 " from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where the loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding right sides together. Trim seam to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
16. Turn the binding to the back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.
