Tuffet

Fabric Requirements:

38 fabric strips measuring 2 ½" x 17 ¾"

1 fat quarter – to make an ~18" circle to cover the bottom of the tuffet

~5" square of fabric for covering the center button (you'll also need some Gorilla glue to ensure the covered button stays firmly together)

Half a Jelly Roll works perfectly for the tuffet as you will get two 17 ¾" strips out of every strip in the Jelly Roll. But you can use any fabric you'd like ... as long as you the length of each strip is 17 ¾".

Additional Supplies:

Bring a ½" presser foot if you have one but it's not absolutely necessary.

10 degree wedge ruler

Usual quilting supplies including long ruler and cutter.

Four legs of your choice ... any height. They can be purchased at Home Depot relatively cheap or there's a lot of choice on Amazon. Just search "furniture legs". You'll need some replacement screws but I'll bring those with me ... you can purchase them from me for ~\$5.00 for the 4 screws you'll need.
