





The back-of-hand side is convex so your hand can slip in easily. **\$ 15 plus supplies.**

This fat quarter friendly bag is a great way to get ready for your summer travel with the zippered front pocket, two back pockets six inside pockets and a magnetic snap closure. The Kristine Spool by Kimberbell June 22 from 12 - 5



The "Kristine" zipper pouch includes piecing and quilting — all in one hoop! Each has a pieced "spool" and the zipper pouch is lined and shows no raw seams or stabilizer! This in the hoop Pouch is a great way to use up scraps. What makes it even better is all supplies are included, you just bring your embroidery machine, some basic sewing supplies and some threads. **The \$25 price includes the embroidery pattern and the supplies!**

Monogram Fast Fobs June 30 from 10 – 12


