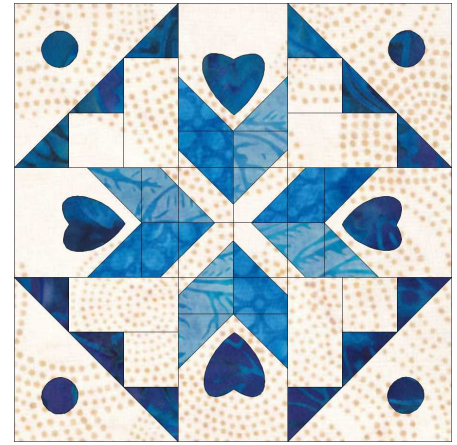


Fair Isles Winter Block 1

Chevron Hearts

12" x 12" (12-1/2" unfinished)

Foundation Pieced Pattern by Morning Glory Designs



Cutting List:

This block is foundation pieced. The cutting list has already added 1/2" seam allowance around all pieces to allow for foundation piecing. Label all pieces with the letter shown.

From white batik:

- Cut 2 squares 6-1/2" x 6-1/2". Cut once on the diagonal to make 4 triangles (A)
- Cut 4 rectangles 4" x 5-1/2". (B)
- Cut 4 squares 2-1/2" x 2-1/2". Cut once on the diagonal to make 8 triangles (E)
- Cut 4 rectangles 2-1/2" x 4". (G)
- Cut 4 squares 2-1/2" x 2-1/2". (H)
- Cut 4 rectangles 1-1/2" x 3-1/4" (J)

From dark blue batik:

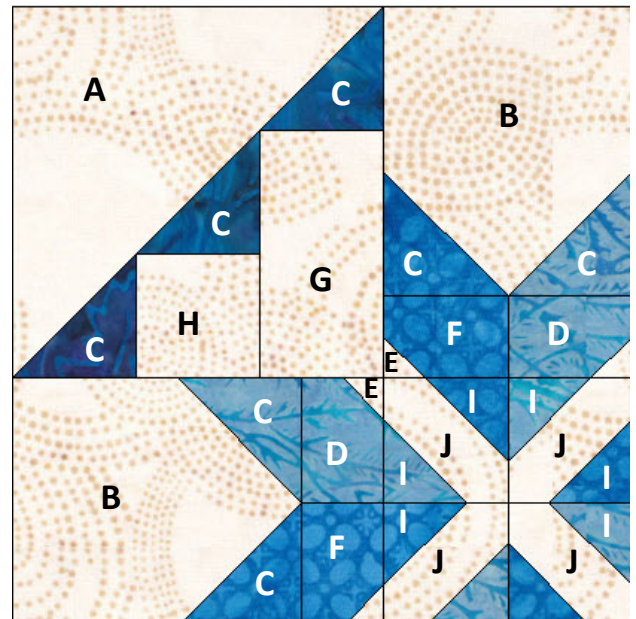
- Cut 6 squares 3-1/2" x 3-1/2". Cut once on the diagonal to make 12 triangles. (C)
- Trace 4 hearts and 4 circles using the templates provided onto the backing of your fusible web. Fuse onto dark blue batik and cut out on the traced lines.

From medium blue batik:

- Cut 2 squares 3-1/2" x 3-1/2". Cut once on the diagonal to make 4 triangles. (C)
- Cut 4 rectangles 2" x 2-1/2". (F)
- Cut 2 squares 3" x 3". Cut once on the diagonal to make 4 triangles. (I)

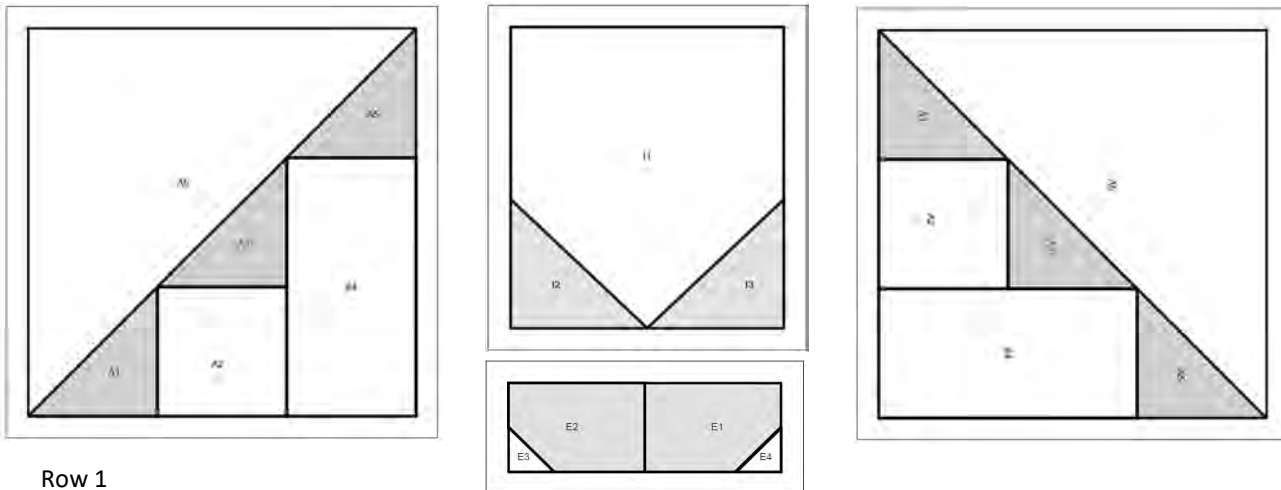
From light blue batik:

- Cut 2 squares 3-1/2" x 3-1/2". Cut once on the diagonal to make 4 triangles. (C)
- Cut 4 rectangles 2" x 2-1/2". (D)
- Cut 2 squares 3" x 3". Cut once on the diagonal to make 4 triangles. (I)

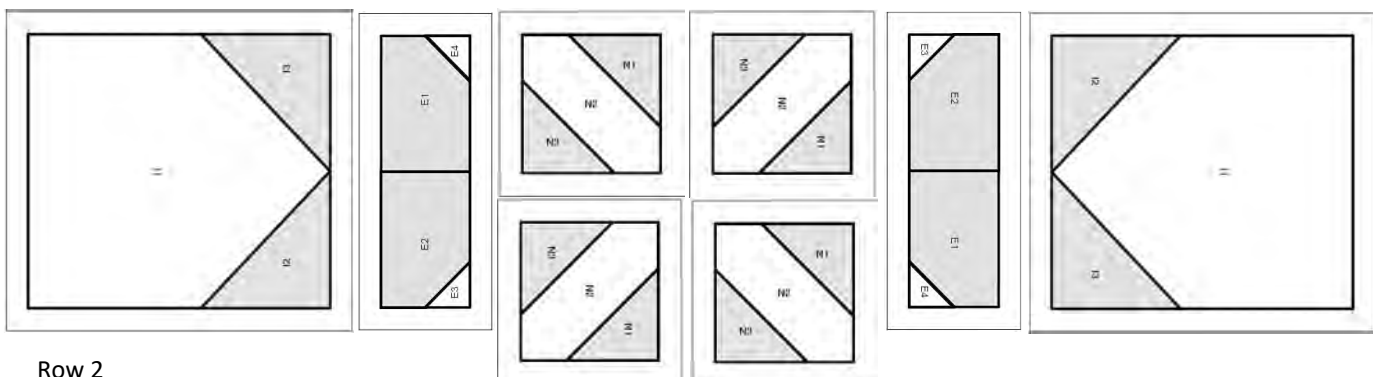


Instructions:

1. Print 1 copy of the 4-page foundation pattern on light-weight paper, velum, or newsprint paper. Check the 1" test boxes on each pattern page to be sure that the foundations have printed out at 100%. Even the tiniest error will decrease the overall size of the completed block.
2. Label each foundation pattern with the fabric color for each patch.
3. Piece all similar foundations at one time, chain piecing using the pre-cut patches. There are four of each foundation and this will speed up your progress.
4. Pin the fabric face up to the unprinted side of the foundation. Sew on the printed side of the foundation. (This assumes you know how to foundation piece. If you are new to foundation piecing, please watch one of the many excellent You Tube video demos on the technique before beginning. 5. Piece each foundation section, pressing as you go.
6. When all sections are pieced, trim the foundation on the outer cutting lines. You should have a 1/4" seam allowance on all sides from the inner sewing lines.
7. Join the foundations together on the sewing lines in three rows as shown below.

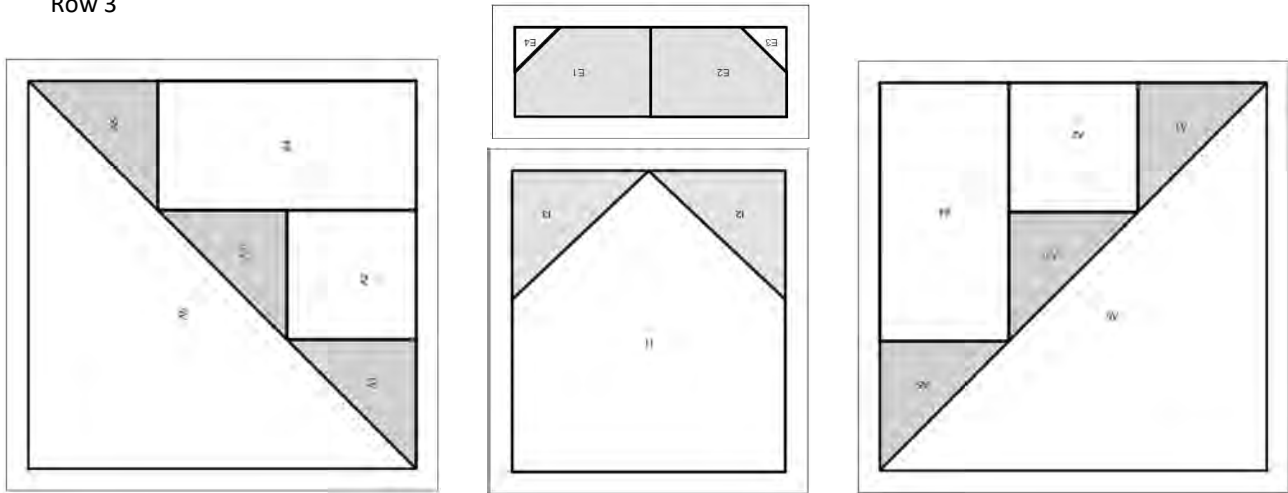

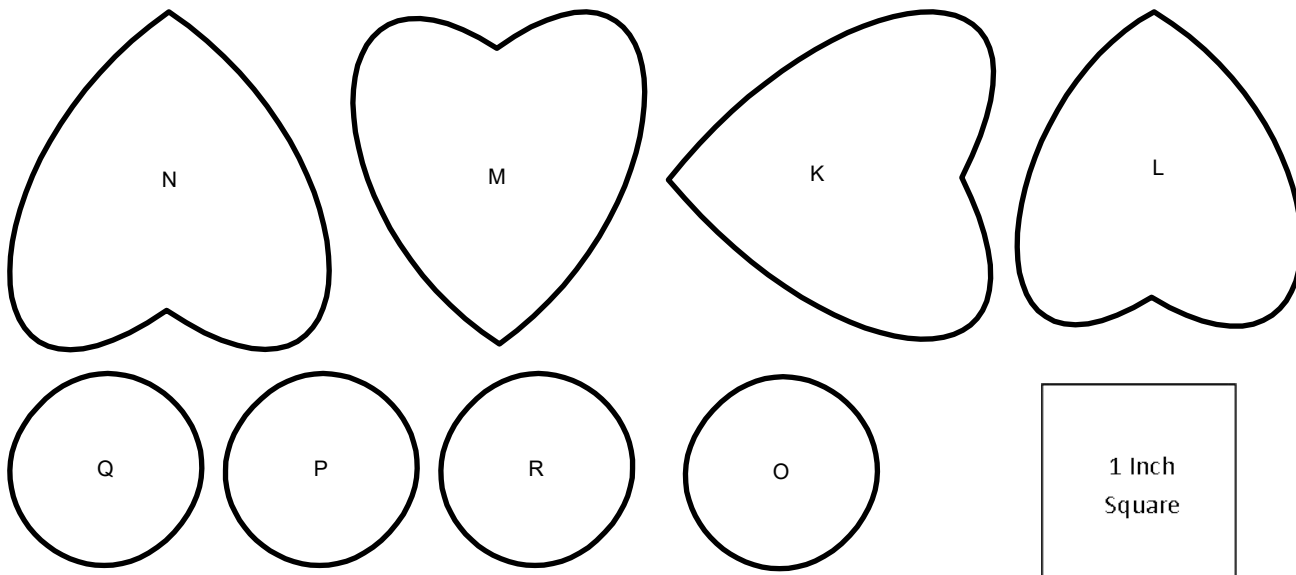
8. As you join the sections be sure to sew on the dark sewing lines. Press seams open.
9. When all sections are joined, carefully remove the paper by folding it back and forth and tearing along the seam lines. Remove any paper chards with tweezers.
10. Press the block with sizing or starch to restore its shape. If any seams loosened in the paper removal, resew them now.
11. Fuse prepared applique circles and hearts to the front of the block.
12. Pin light weight tear away or wash away stabilizer to the back of the block. Edge stitch the applique in place using matching thread and a machine blanket stitch or satin stitch.
13. Remove the stabilizer and repress the block.



Fair Isles Winter Block 1 Chevron Hearts - Applique templates and placement guide. 12" block

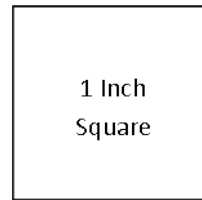
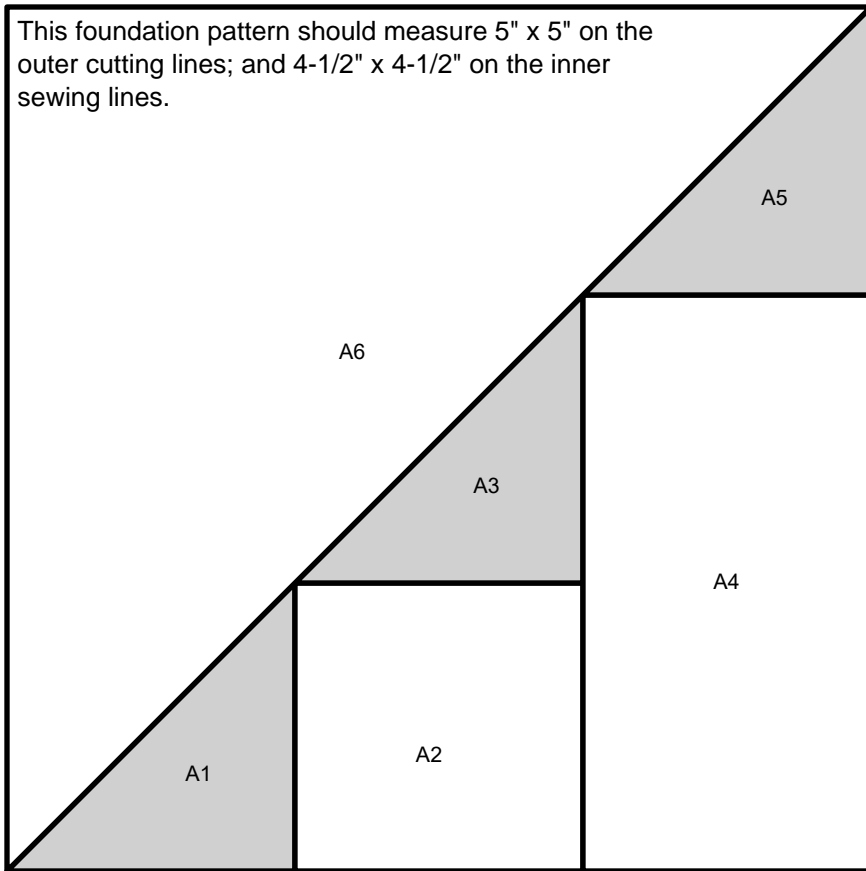


Trace one of each template onto the paper backing of your fusible web. Cut out around traced template.
 Fuse onto the back of your dark blue fabric. Cut out on the traced lines.
 Place applique on the completed pieced block and fuse in place.
 Edge stitch around each applique using matching thread and a machine blanket stitch or satin stitch.



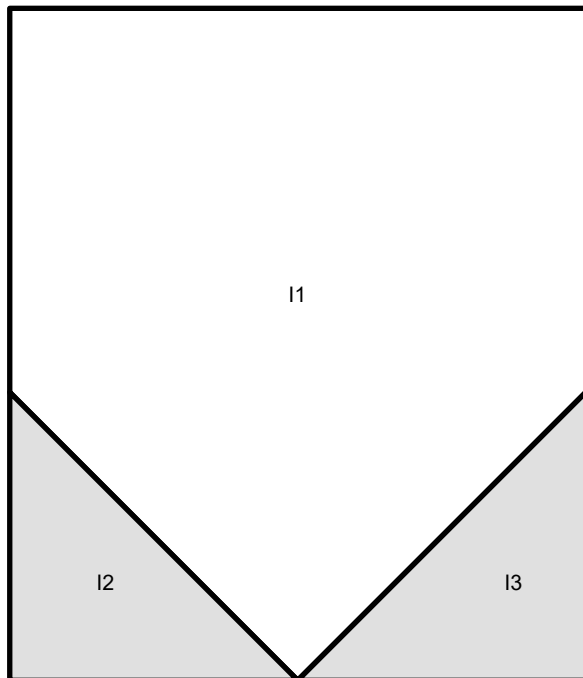
Fair Isles Winter Block 1 Chevron Hearts Foundation - 12" block

This foundation pattern should measure 5" x 5" on the outer cutting lines; and 4-1/2" x 4-1/2" on the inner sewing lines.

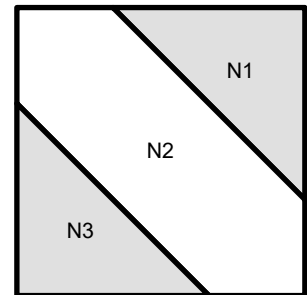


This test square should measure exactly one inch when printed.

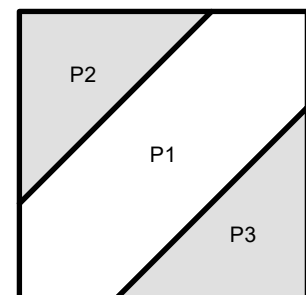
