Sacred Geometry Block of the Month

Welcome to this very unique project that explores the way we use numbers, shapes, color and images in quilting. Each block - along with full color instructions - will feature a story of the importance and significance of the block along with an inspiration drawing to nudge your own creativity.
To get started, here are the fabric requirements.

- 8 yards solid black (background)
- 4 yards black with white print (curve)
- 1 FQ each of the 12 colors in the colorwheel
- Assorted black \& white prints $1 / 8$ yard or so of each
- $1 / 2$ yard teal for the inner border
- 3/4 yards light blue violet
- 3/4 yard dark blue violet

- $1 / 2$ yard dark blue for binding
- $1 / 2$ yard bright yellow

The quilt is made in 3 parts based on the Fibonacci spiral ) shown at right) or the Golden Mean.

1. Part 1 (the small rectangle with the numbers 5,8 , 13) includes blocks 1,2 , and 3 .
2. Part 2 (the square with the number 21 ) includes the large signature mandala created to symbolize all the elements in the quilt.
3. Part 3 (the large square with the number 34 ) includes blocks 4-8, plus the flower of life block.

You will receive 1 pattern per month for 10 months. Some months will just be a block and some months will include portions of the background. It will make more sense - I hope- once we get started.
Your first block and story will arrive March 15.
