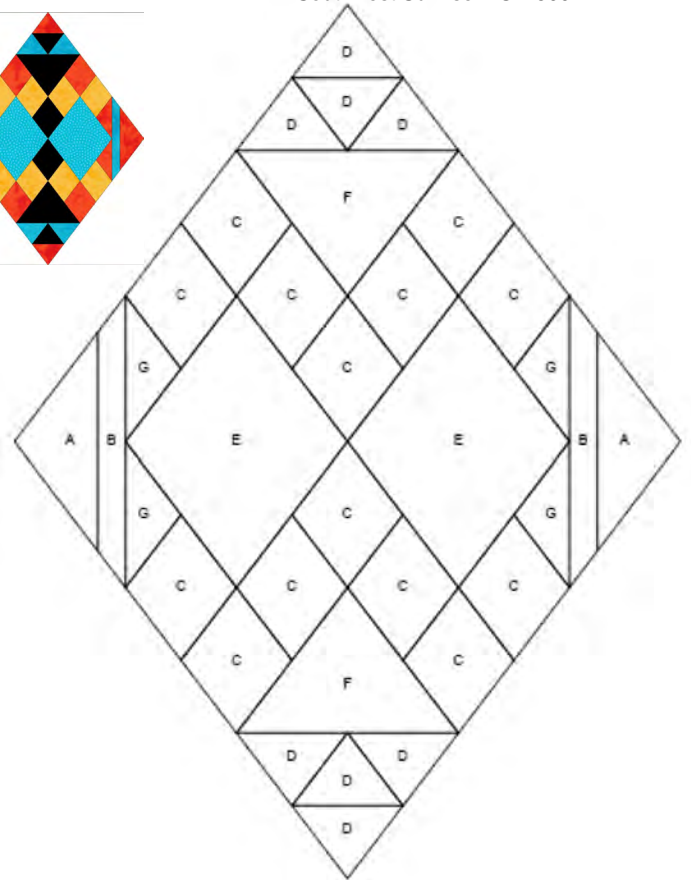


Block 2 (Make 8)	Size to cut	# to cut of each color
A	1-1/2" x 6"	16 coral
B	2" X 5"	16 turquoise
C	1-1/2" x 2-1/2"	64 gold 16 black 32 coral
D	2" x 3"	32 turquoise 16 black 16 coral
E	3" x 3-1/2"	16 turquoise
F	3" x 4"	16 black
G	2" x 4"	32 coral



Setting up your machine to paper piece:

1. Use cotton 60 wt or 80 wt thread in your machine and your bobbin.
2. Replace your needle with a 70/10 topstitch or sharp needle.
3. Decrease your stitch length so your stitches are shorter than normal.
4. Use a "starter scrap" to begin stitching and anchor your threads so you avoid snarls at the beginning of each seam.
5. Set up a small cutting mat, rotary cutter, small ruler, and a travel iron nearby. You will need to press and trim seams between each addition.
6. Add patches in the numerical order printed on the paper foundation.

Refer to the instructions & video for Block 8 for detailed instructions on paper piecing.

Piecing Block 1 (Fig. 2)

1. Block 1 is pieced in 4 sections. Section A and B are identical and are each pieced on a single foundation paper. (Fig 3) The foundation is color coded for easy color placement.
2. Add patches in the numerical order printed on the paper foundation. Press after adding each patch. Trim sections A and B on the outer cutting lines. Do not remove the paper. Make 4 each of Sections A and B.
3. Section C/D is composed of 2 sub sections. (Fig. 4) Piece sub-section C and subsection D. Trim on the outer cutting line. Join C and D matching the seam line. Remove paper from the seam allowance of the C/D seam.

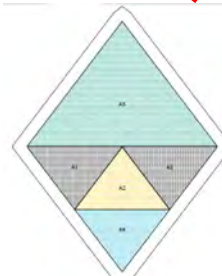

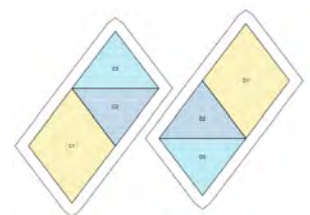
