Class Title	Color Confidence for Quilters
Type of Class	Hands-on Workshop (no machines needed)
Time needed	2-3 hours
Student Limit	30
Classroom	Tables arranged in a U-shape for a smaller group or in rows
Equipment	for a larger group. 2 people to a table.
	Quilt rack for large quilt and an easel.
Class Description	This is not your traditional color class. Develop confidence in choosing colors that you love in fabrics that make you happy. Learn the vocabulary of color using the simple 12 hue color wheel, and the properties of color as applied to quilt fabrics and quilt design. Learn lots of tips and tricks in the process for making your next quilt radiant with the colors you love. You will become a color expert with the tools you need to make great color choices.
