<b>Class Title</b>	<b>The Big Apple: Curved Piecing without Pins Piecing Template cut Apple Cores</b>
<b>Type of Class</b>	Hands-on cutting and piecing technique workshop
<b>Time needed</b>	3-4 hours
<b>Student Limit</b>	20
<b>Classroom Equipment</b>	Sewing machines with ¼ " presser feet, Design wall or foam board for pinning up samples
<b>Class Description</b>	Learn to piece those fabulous BIG apple core shapes using an easy pin-less technique. We will rotary cut these apple core shapes and piece them without pins. If you thought you could not do curves this workshop will change your mind, while you create a great big apple core crib or lap quilt project.

<b>Supplies Needed</b>	Basic sewing supplies, thin glass head pins, long bent-nose tweezers (available for sale in class), 1 layer cake ( 42 precut 10" squares) Rotating cutting mat and rotary cutter (45 mm blade)

<b>Kit Contents</b>	Large apple core acrylic template, Bent nose tweezers, 4 pre-cut practice apple cores, detailed piecing instructions, project pattern.

<b>Other considerations</b>	If using fabric from your stash, cut 42 - 8" x 10" rectangles. If there are less than 42 squares in your layer cake, bring an extra coordinating fat quarter.
